The Science Faculty of St. Bede's College Shimla, in collaboration with Indian Association of Physics Teachers (IAPT) hosted a two days National Workshop entitled '*St. Bede's Science Theatre 2017: A Celebration of Science through Stage Shows, Lectures and Panel Discussions'* on 10-11, August 2017. Around 300 Science students of the college along with 150 students of various colleges and schools of Shimla attended it. These included Govt. Degree College, Sanjauli, R.K.M.V, Rajiv Gandhi Govt. Degree College, Chaura Maidan, Convent of Jesus and Mary, D.A.V School, New Shimla, D.A.V School, Lakkar bazaar, St. Edward's School, Loreto Convent, Tara Hall, Kendriya Vidalaya, Jakhu, Kendriya Vidalaya, Jatogh, Govt. School, Sanjauli, Monal Public School and Chapslee school.

The main objective of workshop was to enjoy the wonderful world of science, to satisfy the curiosity of young minds and to understand how or why certain things happen around us. Dr. (Sr.) Marina John, Manager St. Bede's College Shimla inaugurated the workshop. In her address she highlighted the importance of science in one's life. On 10th August, 2017 in the first technical session of the workshop, Prof. P.K.Ahluwalia delivered a lecture on the topic '*Graphene: The Queen of Flat Land of Crystals'*. He talked about the wonders of carbon and the properties of Graphene, its discovery and its application in the electronic industry. Second half of the day started with a stage show on Physics experiments by Prof. T.R. Ananthkrishnann, Head, Dept. of Physics & Research Centre, St. Pauls College Cochin and Visiting Faculty, International School of Photonics, Cochin, Kerala. He demonstrated the experiments of mechanics, optics and electricity and magnetism. The students showed a great enthusiasm and participated in the stage show and enjoyed it thoroughly.

On the second day, Prof. Nivedita Sharma delivered a lecture on the topic 'Wonder World of Science: Walk from Past to Future'. She stated that Science is a search of truth and knowledge and the application of knowledge is called technology. Her lecture elucidated the transition of science from the past to the modern day scenario and how the work of several leading scientists contributed to this transition. She emphasized on the various existing and the upcoming branches of science such as nanotechnology, genetic engineering, biotechnology, IPR etc., their phenomenon and the importance of these in our lives such as creating artificial skin and the 5 dimensional glass discs. To stimulate the science experimentation in learning among students and teachers both at school and college level

and to share and discuss issues relating to teaching/learning science more effectively particularly for students enrolled in undergraduate classes, there was a panel discussion on the topic **'Latest trends and opportunities in science'**. The emphasis was to remove myth that doing science means no career. The panel responded to the queries of the audience convincingly.

This was followed by a live demonstration of engaging low cost physics experiments which can be easily used in the class room to unveil physical phenomenon of nature in a most interesting and engaging manner by Prof. M.S. Marwaha, a renowned physicist and former Principal, Sri Guru Gobind Singh College, Chandigarh. His demonstrations were on the phenomena of Resonance, Propagation of waves, Duality of matter and waves, Reflection, Refraction and Faraday's Laws etc. These leading scientists and educators, engaged the participants in interactive presentations and demonstrated significant experiments to help students understand basic science principles and concepts clearly. After seeing these demonstrations students must have changed their views that Physics is a lot more than just derivations.

Tree Plantation Campaign

On 18th August 2017, N.S.S Unit of St. Bede's College Shimla in collaboration with Forest Department Himachal Pradesh Shimla organized a Tree Plantation Campaign at Five Benches, Jakhu Hills Shimla.
