

## Orientation Programme

The college organized an online orientation programme for the newly admitted first year students on 3<sup>rd</sup> September to give an overview of college life and familiarize them with the social environment. The event started with the welcome speech by the Principal, Prof. Sr Molly Abraham, Principal who talked about importance of ethics and moral values in life and encouraged the students to imbibe a sense of commitment and responsibility for a strong character development. It was followed by a session conducted by staff advisors who briefed the students about the academic aspects of the courses, rules and regulations, various societies, clubs and cells of the college. Once the pandemic was over and the classes started in the offline mode, the third-year students at the college helped the first-year students to get acquainted with the college campus by dividing them into groups and giving them a college tour.
