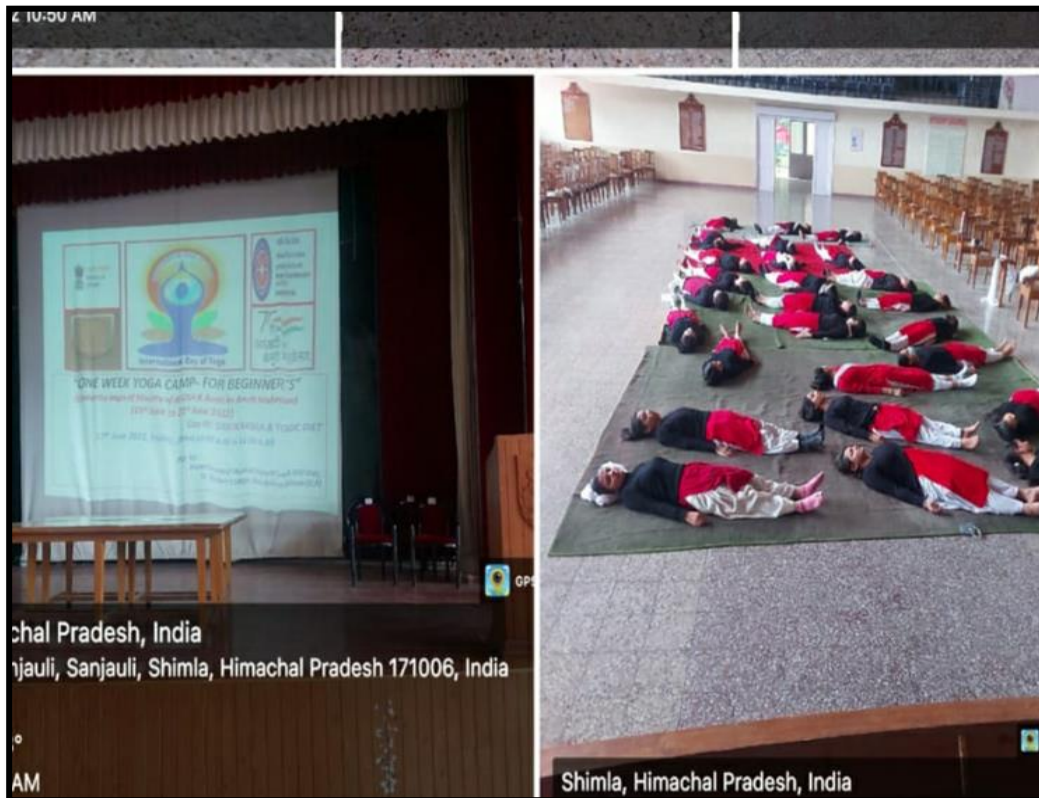

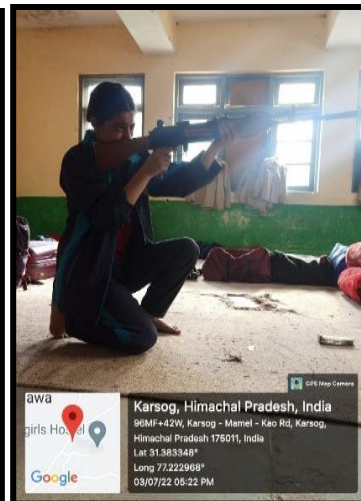

COMBINED ANNUAL TRAINING CAMP

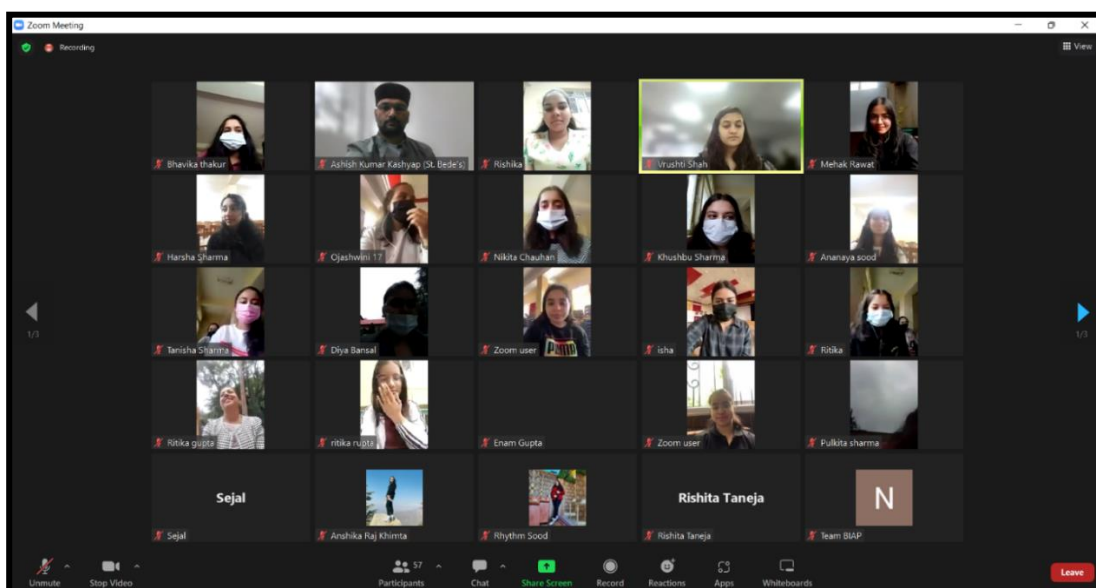

BOOK REVIEW COMPETITION

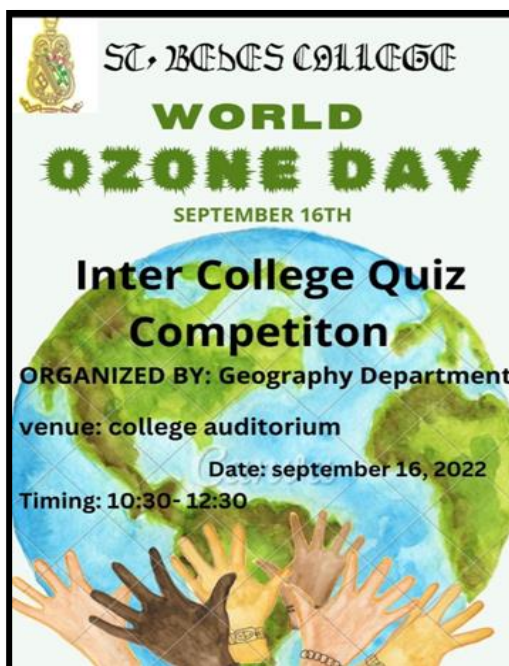

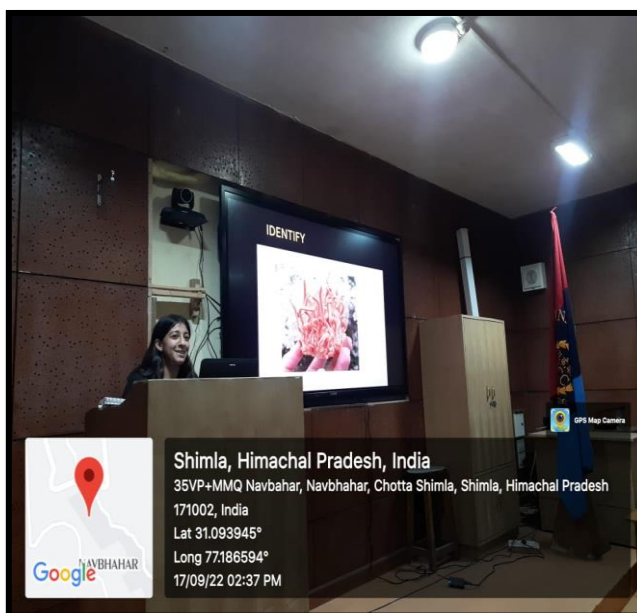
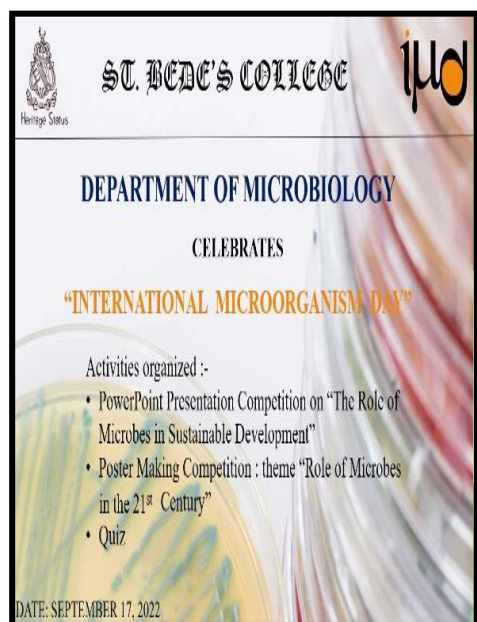

H.P.U YOUTH FESTIVAL

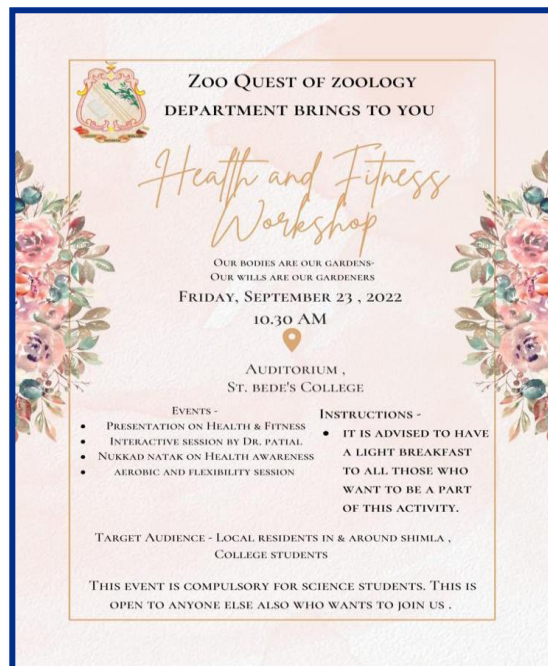

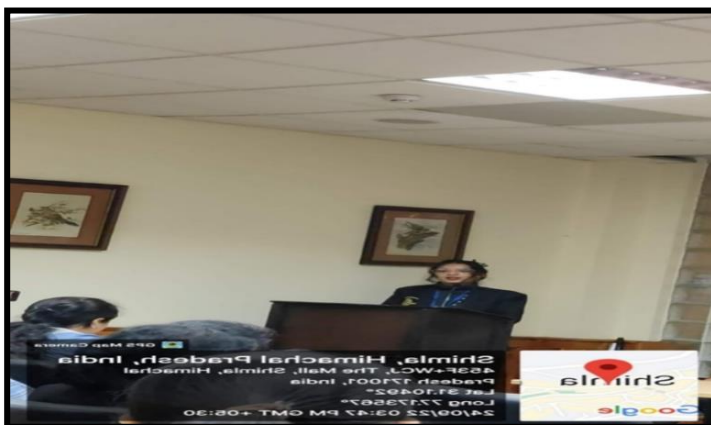
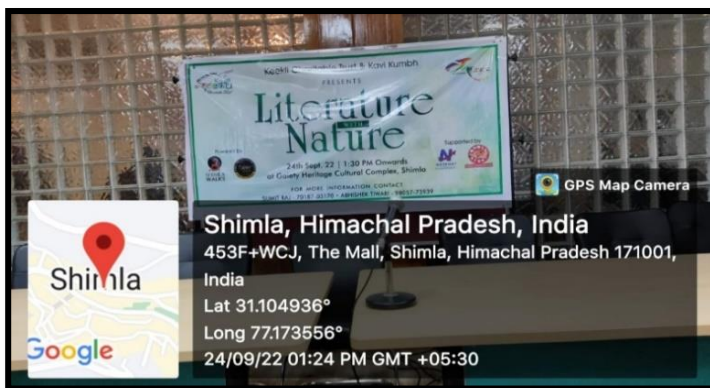

NSS DAY

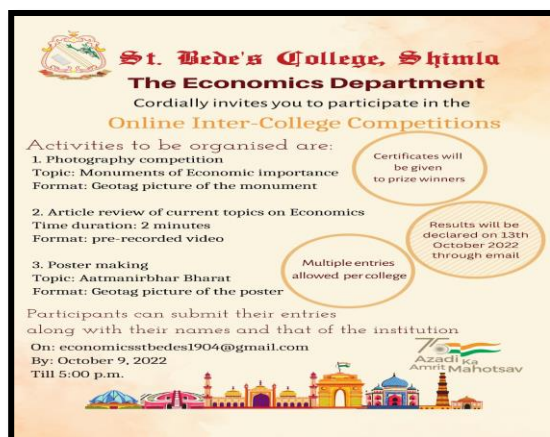

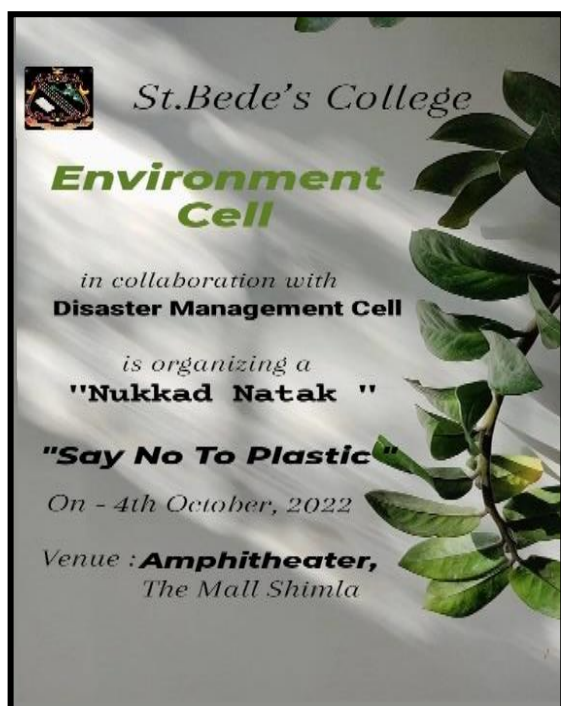


01-10-2022- 09-10-2022: Intercollege competition by Economics

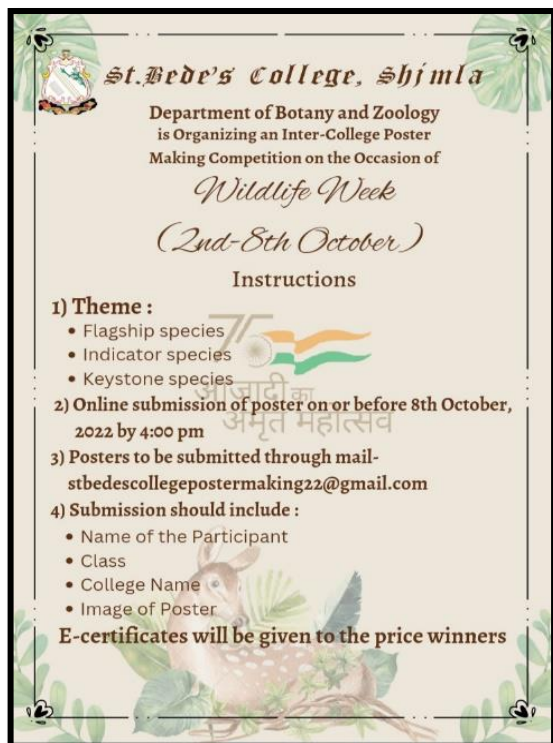


04-10-2022: Nukkad Natak on Harmful effects of Plastic

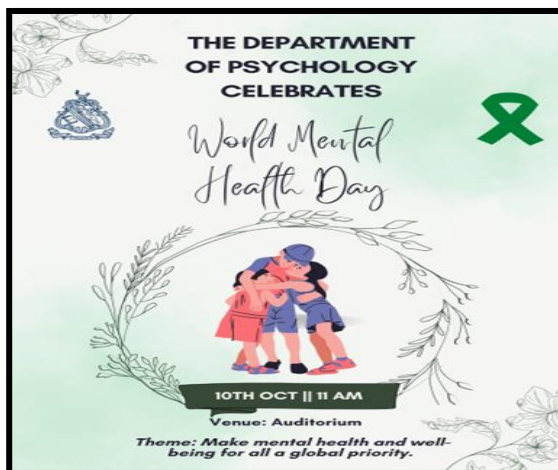

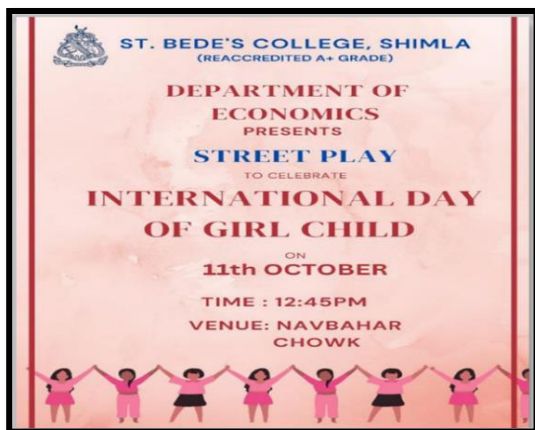

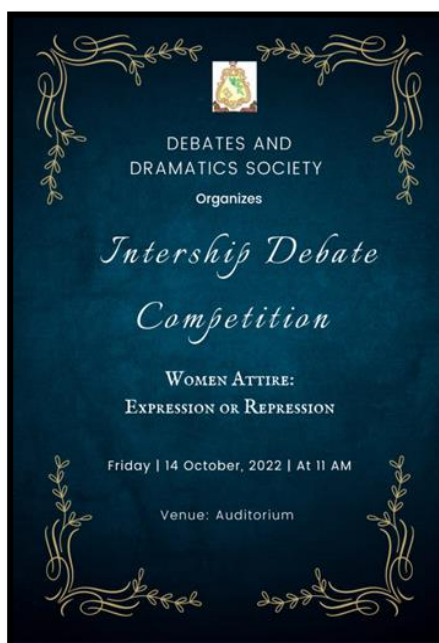


12-10-2022: Celebrating Festivals with Creativity and Joy

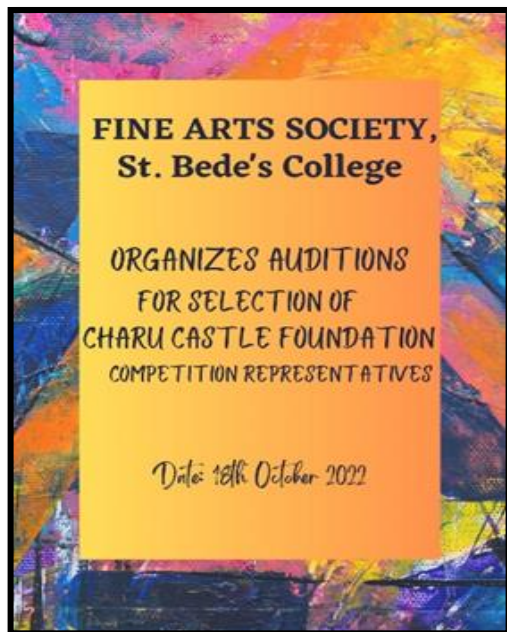


15-10-2022: Slogan Writing Competition

NUKKAD NATAK ON BLOOD DONATION

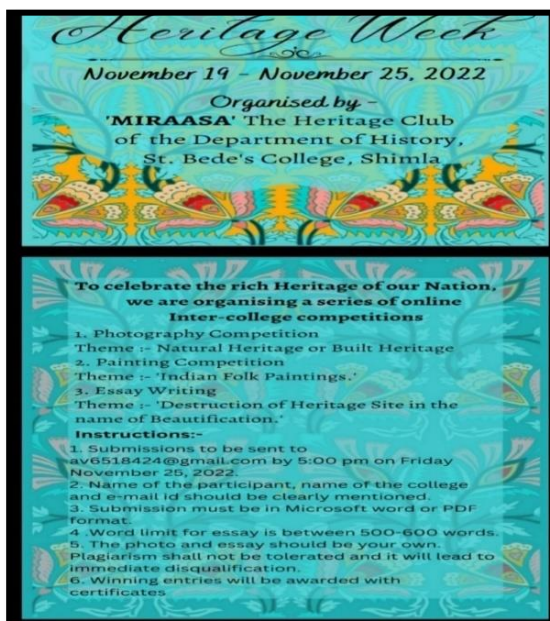

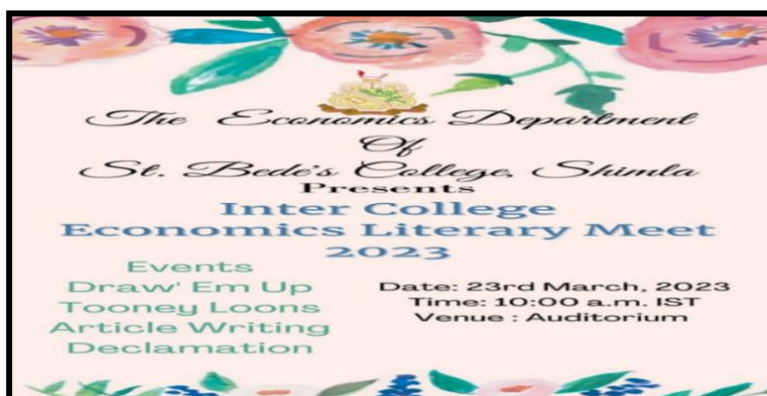
