GUEST LECTURE ON “TRADITIONAL ETHNOBOTANICAL KNOWLEDGE OF NATIVE PLANT DIVERSITY FROM HIMACHAL

Objectives:

- To provide insights into the ethnobotanical knowledge of indigenous communities of H.P. regarding native plant species, their uses, cultural significance, and conservation practices.
- To provide important educational experience for students based on real life experiences of resource person.

Description:

The Department of Botany, St. Bede's College organized a guest lecture on “Traditional Ethnobotanical Knowledge of Native Plant Diversity from Himachal “on 29th November, 2023 for Post Graduate and Under Graduate students in the auditorium. The resource person for the guest lecture was Dr. Vaneet Jishtu, Scientist E, ICFRE, HFRI, Panthaghati, Shimla. During the session, Dr. Jishtu imparted valuable information to the students about the diverse Ethnobotanical plants found in Himachal Pradesh and their potential applications for mankind. His presentation covered the multifaceted uses of these plants, including their roles as dyes, food sources, timber, medicinal resources, and other Non-Timber Forest Products.

Dr. Jishtu underscored the significance of hands-on experiences such as field visits and interactions with ethnic communities in the realm of Ethnobotany. This emphasis on practical exposure highlighted the importance of connecting theoretical knowledge with real-world applications. Overall, the session proved to be insightful and enriched the students with comprehensive insights into the field of Ethnobotany

Outcomes:

- Students gained knowledge about the native plant diversity of Himachal Pradesh.
- Lecture also imparted deeper understanding of the importance of traditional ethnobotanical knowledge and its role in preserving native plant diversity.
