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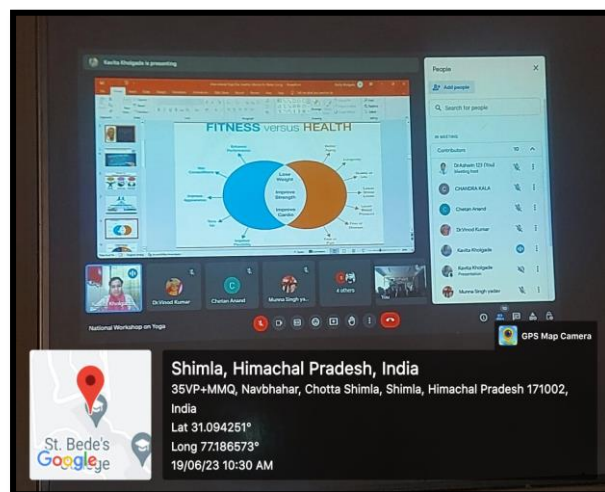
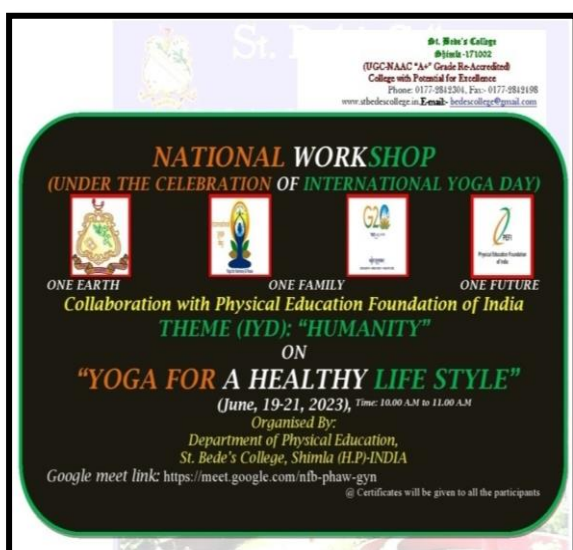
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## INTERNATIONAL DAY OF YOGA

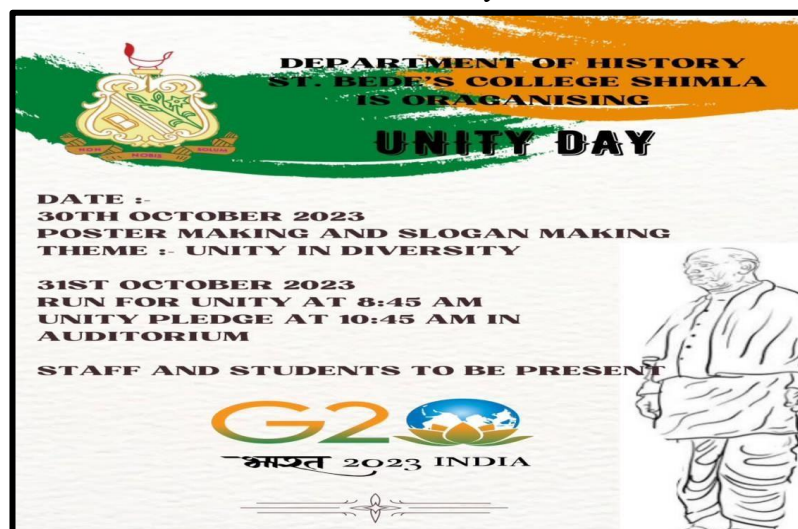
## NATIONAL UNITY DAY

## INDIAN ARMY DAY CELEBRATION

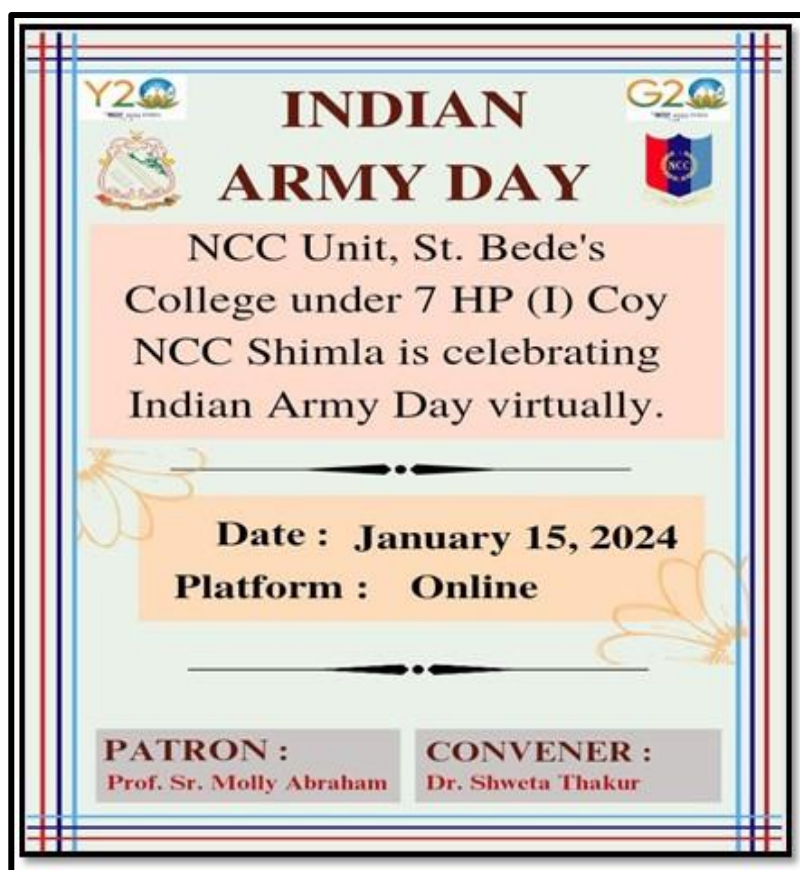

## REPUBLIC DAY CELEBRATION

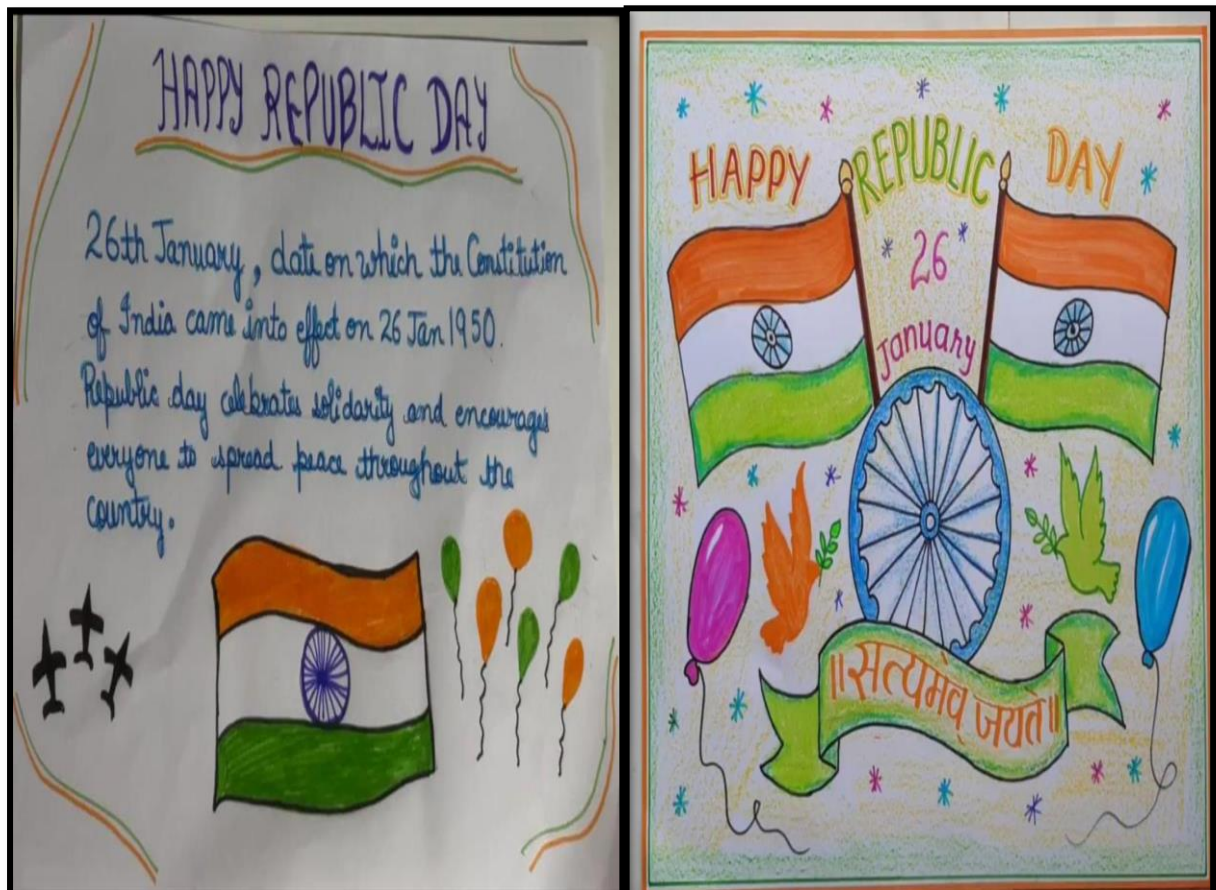

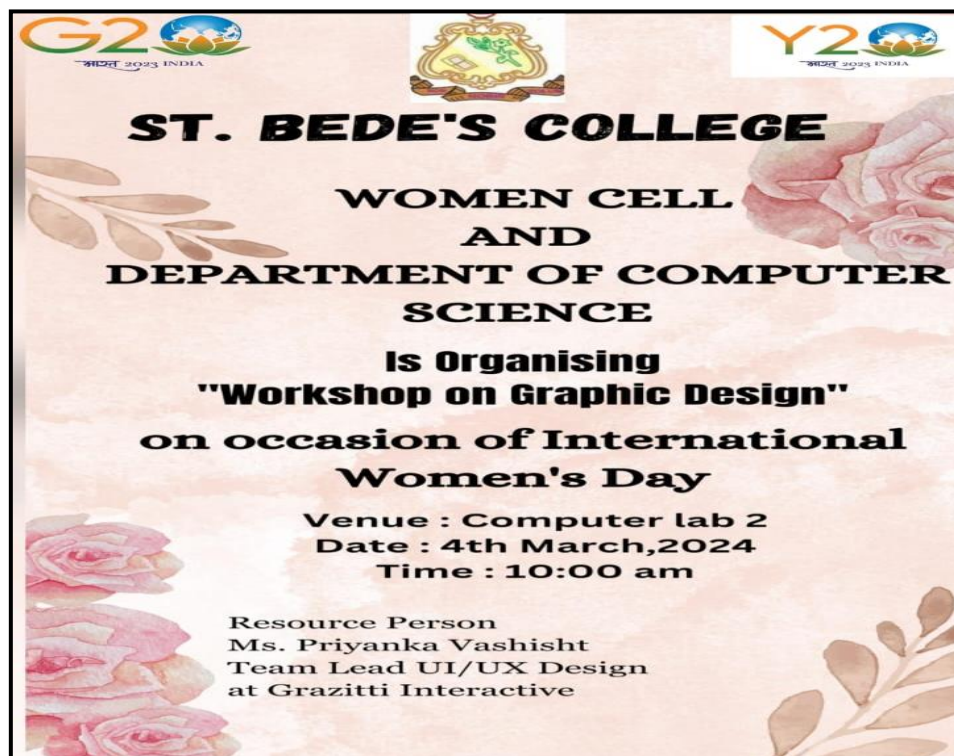
