






Three Day National Workshop on the Occasion of International Yoga Day from June 19-21, 2023




International Yoga Day celebrated on June 21, 2023




International Workshop on the occasion of International Olympic Day on June 26, 2023






INTERNATIONAL YOUTH DAY






Celebration of International Youth Day on August 12, 2023






WORLD LITERACY DAY

Self Defense Training on the Occasion of International Day of the Girl Child from October 10-14, 2023










World Food Day celebrated on October 16, 2023

NATIONAL UNITY DAY






WORLD HERITAGE WEEK



INDIAN ARMY DAY CELEBRATION





Celebration of National Voters' Day on January 25, 2024




REPUBLIC DAY CELEBRATION



NATIONAL SCIENCE DAY




