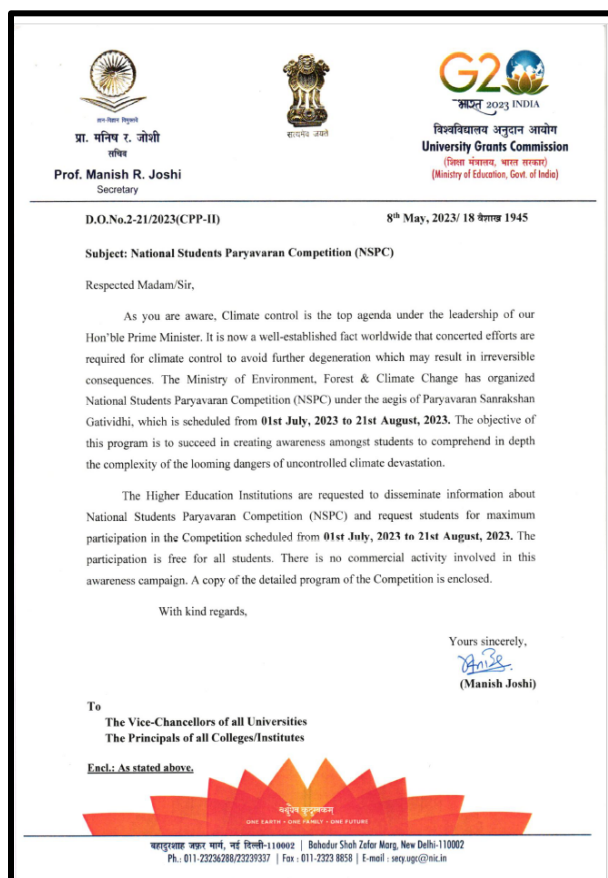
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National Students Paryavaran Competition

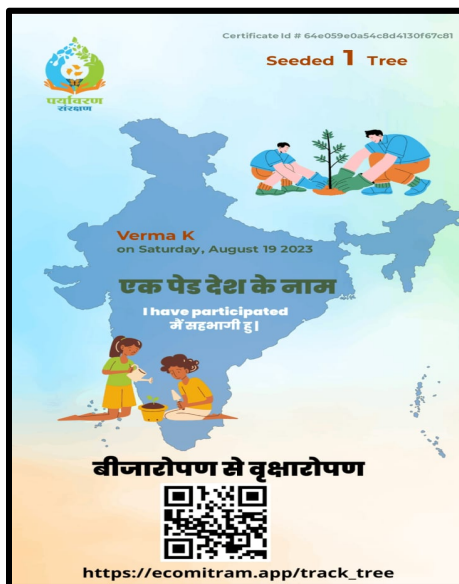

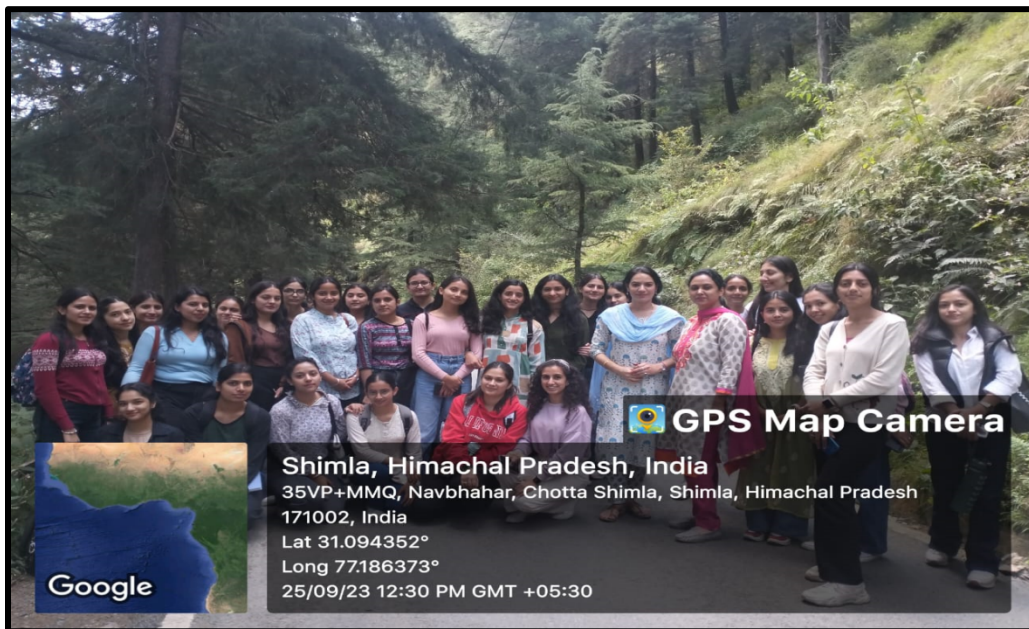


Field Visit to explore local flora at Jakhu Hills

Local flora exploration at Jakhu Hills on September 25, 2023

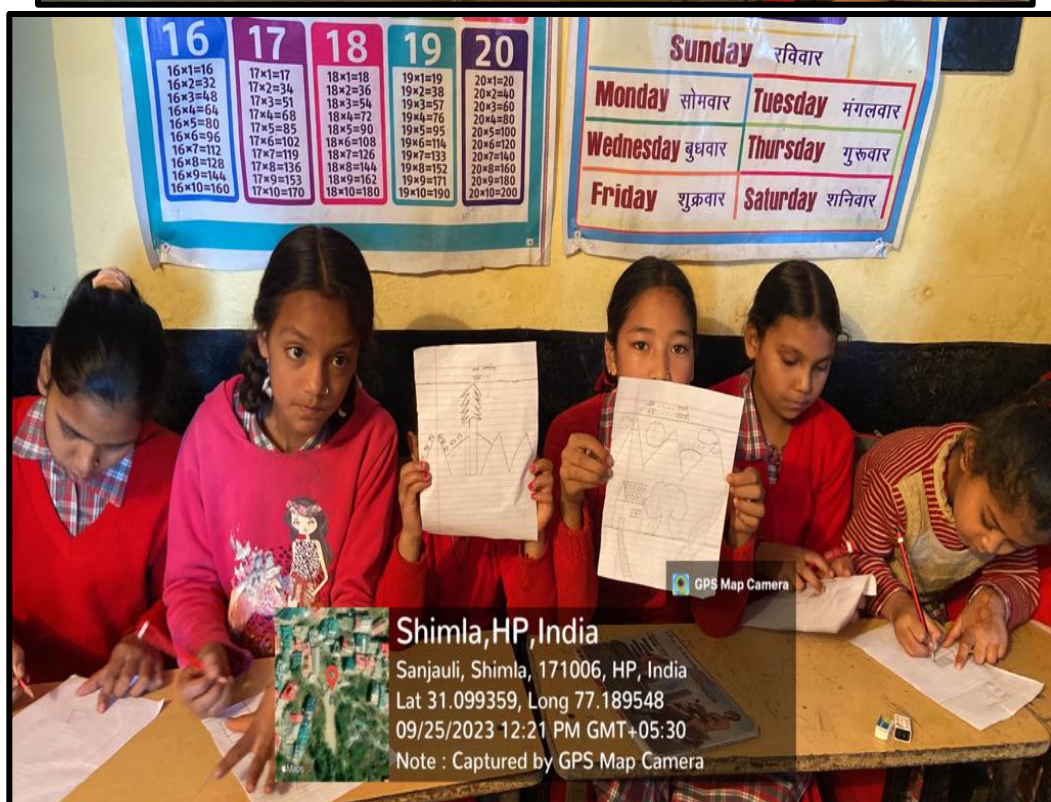


World River Day

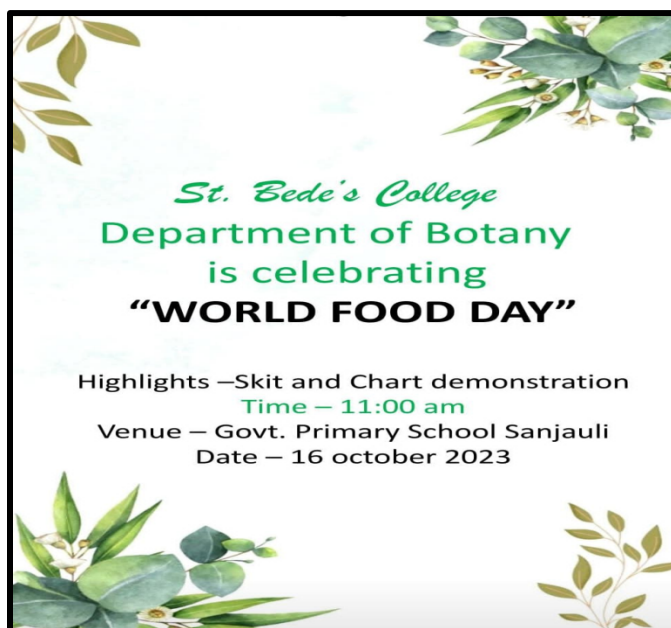


Cleanliness Drive at Rani Jhansi Park and Navbahar on October 1, 2023

 Subject: Organizing an E-Waste Collection cum Awareness drive from 16th to 21st October, 2023.

Sir/ Ma'am,

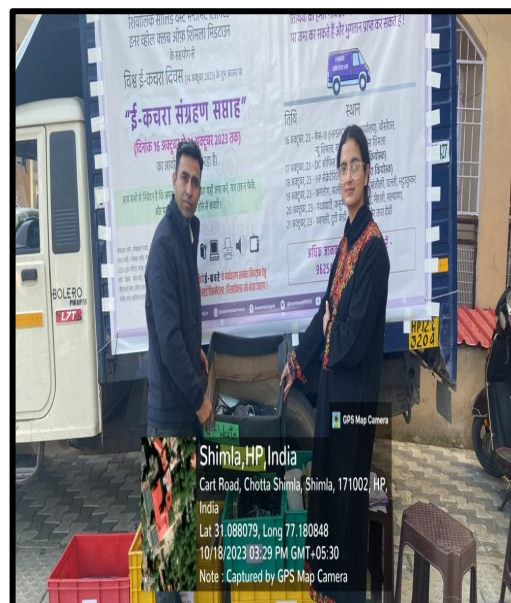
As you are aware, E-waste is one of the fastest-growing waste streams in the world. As our reliance on electronic devices continues to increase, so does the amount of e-waste generated. E-waste includes any electronic and electric device that is no longer in use or has reached the end of its life cycle. The increase in e-waste poses a significant threat to the environment, mainly due to the toxic materials used in the devices such as lead, cadmium, mercury and brominated flame retardants, which can cause significant damage to the environment and human health if not disposed of properly.

In order to ensure scientific management of E-Waste, the Ministry of Environment, Forests, and Climate Change notified the E-Waste Management Rules, 2022 on 2nd November, 2022 in supersession of the E-waste (Management) Rules, 2016.

Further, in order to raise awareness and facilitate actions to improve management of E-Waste, "International Electronic (E)-Waste Day" (IEWD) is commemorated on 14th October every year. The slogan for the occasion for this year is "You can recycle anything with a plug, battery or cable!"

Thus, in order to celebrate this IEWD, State Board has scheduled E-waste Week from 16th to 21st October, 2023 in order to address the problem and to make people more aware about E-waste management. In the week-long campaign, an awareness cum collection drive shall be conducted wherein a mobile van shall be deployed in Shimla City in collaboration with M/s Shivalik Solid Waste Management Ltd (a CPCB authorized recycling facility in Himachal Pradesh) and Inner Wheel Club of Shimla Midtown and incentives shall be given on disposition of the E-Waste. The proposed schedule of the collection drive shall be as follows:-

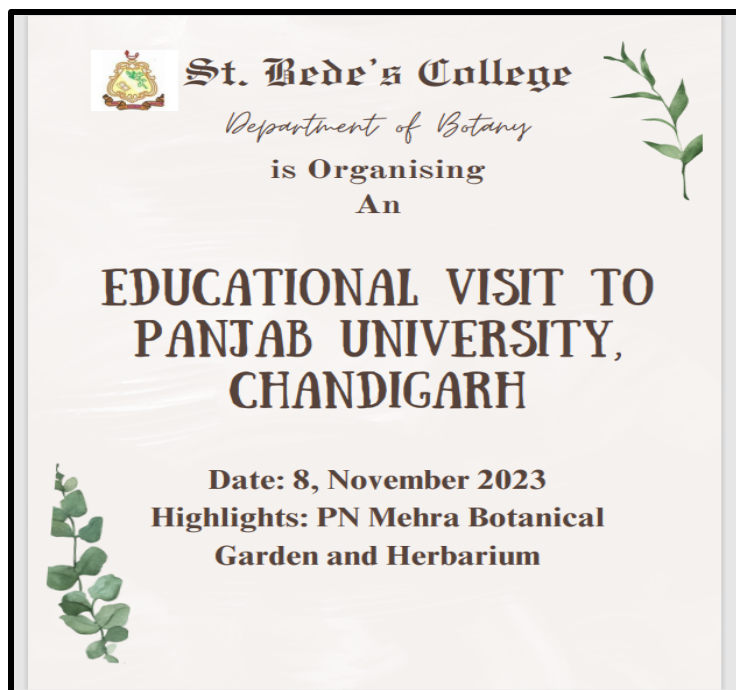

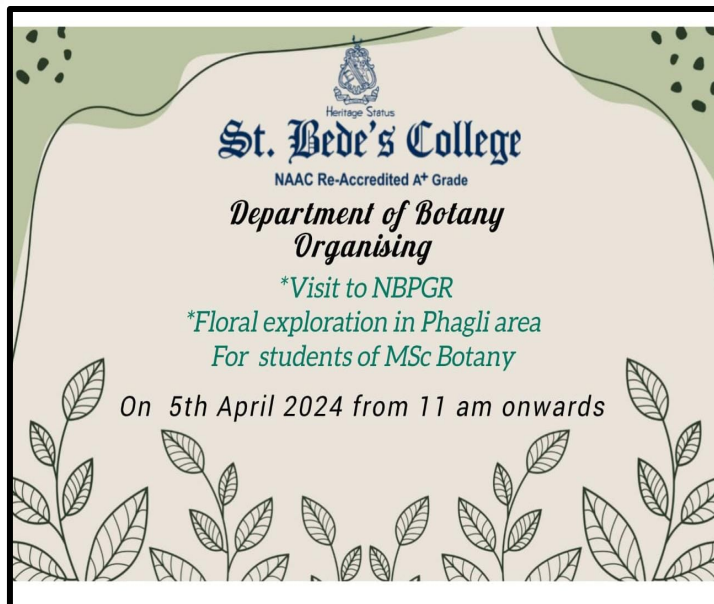


Educational visit to NBPGR (National Bureau of Plant Genetic Resource) Regional Station, Phagli, Shimla and Flora exploration
