CRYPTOCURRENCY

Cryptocurrency, the latest hot topic in the world of finance has not only proved to be revolutionary in making transactions but also an emerging challenge to the traditional financial banking system. Cryptocurrency is a type of safe digital money that is independent of Governments and Central banks. It makes use of a technology called block chain. Cryptocurrency, just like any other type of money can be purchased and traded and may also be kept in online wallets. A decentralized network of computers is used to verify and process transactions, eliminating the need for traditionally used intermediaries - banks.

There are a number of positive impacts of crypto on traditional banking practices, like, making them faster, more secure, and more efficient. Owing to its decentralized nature and no intermediaries, the transactions become cheaper, leading to cost cutting. In addition to this, since it is not subject to any government control, it enhances the chances of investment in those regions where it was earlier not possible, leading to economic growth of such regions. It is also an attractive option for international transaction as no remittance fee is incurred.



Though its advantages are abundant, there are some of its negative impacts on the traditional banking system as well. Firstly, due to the intense volatility of the digital currencies, it becomes an unreliable store of value. Since the price fluctuations are so unpredictable, it becomes difficult for investors to accurately predict their returns while investing. Secondly, since it is decentralized, it faces issues related to security. It is vulnerable to hacking and hence less secure as compared to other centralized banking program. Thirdly, since it is free from government control, any fraud faced by any individual is not subject to strict legal action.

In conclusion, it would be interesting to see if traditional banks adapt and incorporate cryptocurrency into their existing models.

APPLE VISION PRO

Apple vision pro is a mixed-reality headset developed by Apple Inc. It was announced on June 5, 2023, at Apple's Worldwide Developers Conference, and pre-orders began on January 19, 2024. It became available for purchase on February 2, 2024, in the United States. A worldwide launch has yet to be scheduled. Apple Vision Pro is Apple's first new major product category since the release of the Apple Watch in 2015.

Apple markets Apple Vision Pro as a "Spatial computer" where digital media is integrated with the real world. Physical inputs—such as motion gestures, eye tracking, and speech recognition—can be used to interact with the system. Apple has avoided marketing the device as a virtual reality handset when discussing the product in presentations and marketing. The device runs vision OS, a mixed-reality operating system derived from iOS frameworks using a 3D interface; it supports multitasking via windows that appear to float within the user's surroundings, as seen by cameras built into the headset.

The OS supports avatars (officially called "Personas"), which are generated by scanning the user's face; a screen on the front of the headset displays a rendering of the avatar's eyes ("Eyesight"), which are used to indicate the user's level of immersion to bystanders, and assist in communication.

• Anthropology: It is the study of human species in all its aspects including evolution, culture and population dynamics.

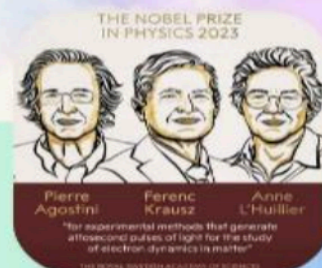

Noble Prizes



• The royal Swedish Academy of Sciences has decided to award the 2023 Nobel prize in physics to Pierre Agostini, Ferenc Krausz, Anne L'Huillier for experimental methods that generate attosecond pulses of light for the studies of electron dynamics in matter.



• The 2023 noble prize in physiology or medicine has been awarded to Katalin Karikó and Drew Weissman for their discoveries concerning nucleoside base modification that enabled the development of effective mRNA vaccines against COVID-19. During the early 1990s, when Katalin was an assistant professor at the university of Pennsylvania, she remained true to her vision of realising mRNA as a therapeutic despite encountering difficulties in project. A new colleague of Karikó at her University was the immunologist Drew Weissman. He was interested in dendritic cells which has important functions in immune surveillance and the activation of vaccine induced immune response.

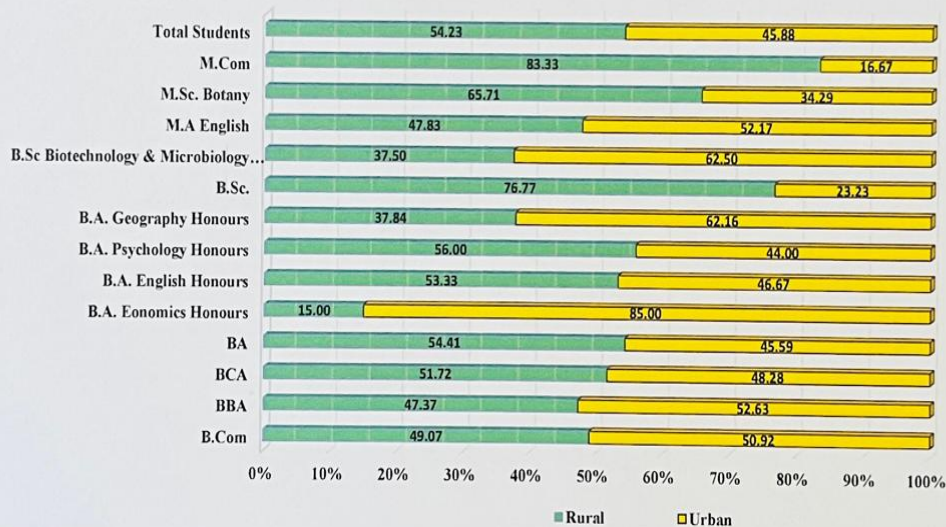
