### IDENTIFICATION OF ATTAINMENT GAPS

- PO1 (2.42) and PO5 (2.40) achieved attainment levels above the target (2.0).
- PO2 (1.66), PO3 (1.85), and PO4 (1.54) fell below the target, indicating gaps in:
  - Analytical and research skills (PO2, PO3).
  - Interdisciplinary and practical learning components (PO4).
- PO6 (0.97) was slightly below the target (1.0), reflecting the need for enhanced employability and professional skills.



- Gaps are mainly associated with:
  - Critical thinking and problem-solving skills.
  - Limited exposure to research, fieldwork, and industry-linked activities.
  - Need for improved digital and innovative teaching-learning practices.

## STRATEGIES FOR IMPROVEMENT

- **Curriculum Enrichment**
  - Introduce additional skill-based and value-added modules aligned with emerging trends.
  - Incorporate case studies, research projects, and problem-based learning approaches.
- **Strengthening Practical and Research Exposure**
  - Enhance laboratory-based experiments, fieldwork, and hands-on training.
  - Encourage participation in student research, seminars, and science exhibitions.
- **Capacity Building for Faculty**
  - Organize faculty development programs (FDPs) on innovative pedagogies, ICT integration, and research methodologies.
- **Industry and Interdisciplinary Linkages**
  - Conduct workshops, internships, and guest lectures involving industry experts and interdisciplinary collaborators.
- **Continuous Monitoring and Assessment**
  - Periodic review of CO-PO mapping and attainment data.

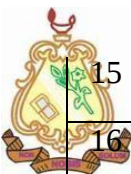
