



Eligibility Criteria for Enrolling in NCC

BEE Certificate

The time period for NCC BEE certificate is 2 years.

Eligibility criteria for the NCC BEE certificate:

1. The candidate should complete their primary education.
2. Candidate should not be convicted in any of the police cases.
3. Candidate should not be married.
4. You have to fill the application and submit it.
5. Must have attended one Annual Training Camp/NIC/COC/RDC/Attachment with Regular Army/Navy/Air Force.
6. The examination pattern is:
 - a) written exam
 - b) drill test
 - c) practical & viva

If you qualify in all the exam then you will get a BEE Certificate.

7. Cadets possessing Certificate A will be awarded 10 bonus marks.

CEE Certificate

Eligibility criteria for the NCC CEE certificate:

1. The cadet must be in possession of Certificate BEE.
2. The cadet must be in third year of Senior Division/Senior Wing NCC Training.
3. The cadet must have attended a minimum of 75% of the periods of 3rd year syllabus during the academic session.
4. Break in the NCC Training Tenure of the cadet SD/SW prior to appearing in the Exam should not exceed more than 18 months at one time after her discharge to count her previous tenure for Certificate CEE examination.
5. In case the break exceeds 18 months the following procedure will be adopted:-
 - a) If the cadet had been on the unit rolls for a minimum of two years before her discharge and attended 75% of the total period during her NCC Tenure she will need another 30 periods of training to become eligible for certificate CEE examination.
 - b) In other cases where above conditions are not fulfilled, the cadet must attend a minimum of 75% periods of the third year of training.
6. Must have attended one ATC and in addition one of the following in a three year tenure:-
 - a. Annual Training Camp (This is in addition to one mentioned above).
 - b. Republic Day Camp at Delhi (RDC).

- c. Centrally Organized Camp (COC). Ordered by HQ DGNCC Para Training Camp (PTC).
 - d. Para Training Camp (PTC).
 - e. National Integration Camp (NIC) (When applicable for SD/ SW Cadets).
 - f. All India Trekking Expedition (HQ DGNCC Organized).
 - g. All India Mountaineering Expedition (HQ DGNCC Organized).
 - h. Attachment Training with any one of the following:-
 - Army Unit.
 - Air Force Station.
 - Naval Base/ Establishment/ Ship/ Sea Training.
 - Service Hospital.
 - i. Any one of the following Adventure Courses:-
 - Mountaineering Basic Course.
 - Mountaineering Advance Course.
 - Water Skiing/Snow Skiing Courses.
 - Snow & Ice (Condensed) Course.
 - j. Sailing expedition with actual sailing exceeding 10 days, duly approved by HQ DGNCC.
 - k. Participated in NRAI matches as part of HQ DGNCC/Directorate team.
 - l. Scuba Diving Course.
 - m. Youth Exchange Programme.
 - n. Foreign cruise (Navy or Coast Guard).
7. Cadets will be allowed to appear for Certificate CEE examination only after one year of passing Certificate BEE examination.
8. Air Wing Cadets should have flown minimum four Sorties in Micro light air craft.
