

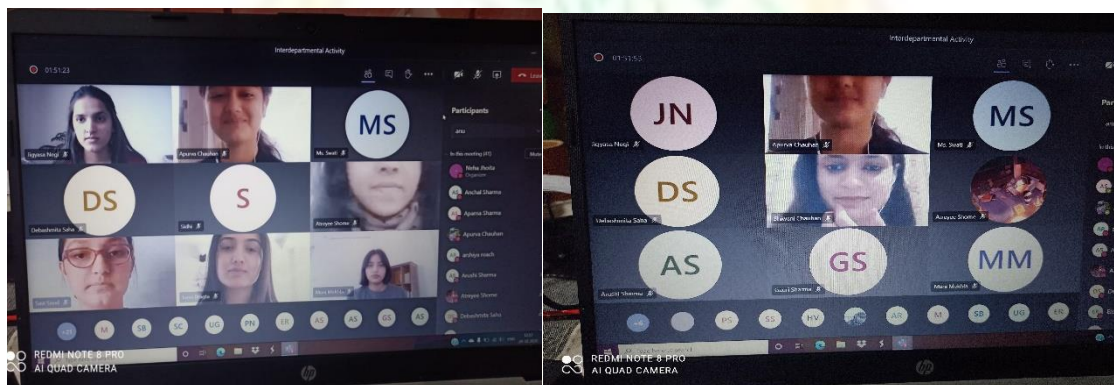


## ACTIVITIES FOR THE SESSION 2020-21

**Dated:** 29th October 2020.

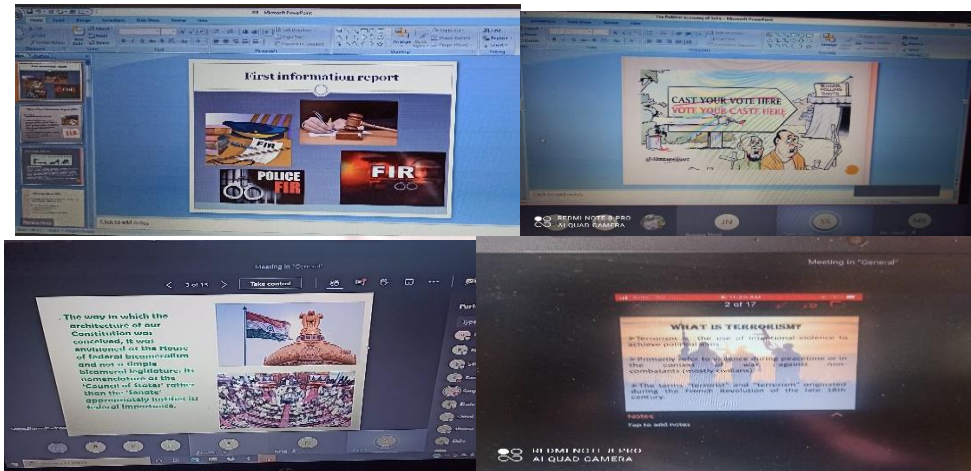
