
SWACHHTA ACTIVITIES FROM 1st-7th JANUARY AND 8th-14th JANUARY, 2021

The cadets participated in the cleanliness drive organized in the college campus and around its surroundings. They also conducted a webinar on cleanliness and segregation of waste.






