

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




## **Slow Learners**

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




Ms. Osheen Pirta and Ms. Sanskriti Sauhta were made Class Representatives for their respective classes which enhances self-worth and boosts confidence.

Every year advanced learners are identified from each class. In order to boost the creativity of such students, additional assignments are given to them.


Following initiatives were taken to encourage the advanced learners:




## **Slow Learners**

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

- Advanced learners are provided with extra books and study materials to add to their working skills.

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
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
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




## **Slow Learners**

- Advanced learners are asked to help the slow learners as and when required.



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
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
