




International Women's Day: "Blood donation- DOs and DON'Ts" on March 8, 2022

Blood Group Database

The department of Zoology in collaboration with NCC unit created a database of blood groups of students to donate blood as and when required. A total of 552 blood samples were analyzed out of which maximum blood group was B⁺ (219 students), followed by blood group A⁺ (131 students), O⁺ (86 students), AB⁺ (81 students), O⁻ (16 students), B⁻ (09 students), A⁻ (07 students), and least number of students with AB⁻ (03 students). The data generated was shared with NGO and IGMC, Department of Immunohematology and Blood Transfusion Shimla. Shimla for donating blood during emergency.





On October 4, 2021, the Psychology department organised a declamation competition on the topic "Mental Health in an Unequal World".






Declamation Competition on 'Mental Health In An Unequal World' October 4, 2021

❖ Fit India Campaign


On August 12, 2021, 7HP (I) Coy NCC Shimla cadets participated in the Fit India Campaign virtually and performed various asanas and pranayamas.


