The conference had a total of five technical sessions, where five eminent speakers delivered their talks on their areas of expertise. The speakers for the sessions were Dr. Lakhveer Singh, Prof. Ashish Arora, Prof. Pradeep Kumar, Dr. Manoj Kumar Sharma, and Dr. Tarun Sharma. Each session was chaired by a different person, namely Dr. Sandeep Chauhan, Dr. Kanu Mehta, Prof. Sunil Thakur, Dr. Sunil Kumar, and Dr. Balvir Patiyal.
