




HAR GHAR TRIANGA CAMPAIGN

A TALK AND SCREENING OF A DOCUMENTARY ON HARI RAI TEMPLE

The Department of History arranged a talk and documentary screening on August 10, 2022, featuring Miss Mrinalini Marh, an alumnus of the department who produces documentaries on the history and culture of Chamba. The focus of the session was the Hari Rai Temple in Chamba, and it proved to be an informative and enlightening experience for the students. They gained valuable insights into the distinctive architectural characteristics of the Chaba style of temple architecture.





ORIENTATION PROGRAM
