INTERDEPARTMENTAL ACTIVITY

A two-day interdepartmental activity was organized on August 5-6, 2022 in Computer Lab-II at St. Bede's College Shimla. The activity was aimed at creating awareness among the students about the relevance of mathematics and computing and emphasizing the practical applications of mathematical theories through programming. The event involved the participation of students from BCA and BA/BSc programs, with mathematics students explaining the concepts and computer students implementing them using C++ and Python languages. Around 50 students and 5 faculty members attended the activity.




TALK ON COMPUTER AWARENESS AT GOVT. SENOIR SECONDARY SCHOOL PORTMORE SHIMLA, HIMACHAL PRADESH

On September 22nd, 2022, St. Bede's College Shimla organized a talk on computer awareness at Govt. Senior Secondary School Portmore in Shimla, Himachal Pradesh. The event was organized by the Department of Computer Science and Mathematics. Students from BCA and BSc-NM (Computer Science) went to the school to educate around 160 8th-grade girls about the basics of computers, their scope, and importance in mathematics.

During the one-hour session, the students provided basic knowledge about computers, followed by their relation to mathematics. They also demonstrated how one can use basic math in computers, with an example of the mean. The session was highly interactive and ended with a 15-minute quiz session. A student from Portmore gave a summary speech to conclude the event.





7-DAY ORIENTATION PROGRAM

The mathematics department of St. Bede's College Shimla organized a 7-day orientation program from 19th to 26th September 2022, called "Real world applications on table of numbers or data". Students from BSc. (non-medical), BA, BCom, and BCA participated in the program. The main objective of the program was to teach students about basic concepts of matrices, its applications in day-to-day life, and working methods of matrices to boost their confidence. This orientation program was a great experience for both teachers and students as they got the opportunity to learn and teach simultaneously.

The session started with an introduction by the HOD of the Mathematics department, who explained the importance of matrices and its applications in real life by giving examples. He also highlighted the significance of matrices in other fields. After that, Aastha Raizada and




NATIONAL SCIENCE DAY
