



DEPARTMENT ACHIEVERS 2018-23 Session 2018-19

शिमला। हिमाचल प्रदेश विश्वविद्यालय ने बीए अंतिम वर्ष का परिणाम देर शाम घोषित कर दिया है। परीक्षा परिणाम 70 फीसदी रहा। बीए की जारी मेरिट में टॉप टेन में दस छात्राओं और मात्र एक छात्र ने स्थान पाया है।

डीएवी कांगड़ा की अंकिता शर्मा ने सर्वाधिक 9.31 सीजीपीए लेकर प्रदेश भर में टॉप किया है। जबकि राजधानी शिमला के सेंट बीड्स कॉलेज की छात्राओं ने दूसरे और तीसरा स्थान पाया है।

के एक माह पांच दिन के बाद विवि ने यह परिणाम घोषित किया है। इस परीक्षा में कुल 14,954 छात्र अपीयर हुए थे, इनमें से 10,504 ने परीक्षा उर्तीण की है। फाइनल ईंयर के 3,058 छात्र छात्राओं के परीक्षा परिणाम सेटल नहीं हो पाए हैं। जबकि इस कोर्स में सबसे अधिक 1,111 छात्र-छात्राओं की कंपार्टमेंट आई है और 281 फेल हुए हैं। डिग्री कॉलेज करसोग की छात्रा हेम लता ने 9.07 सीजीपीए के साथ चौथा, जवाहर लाल नेहरू हिए को भावना ने 9.03 सीजीपीए के साथ पांचवां स्थान पाया है।

डिग्री कॉलेज बंगाणा की रिया शर्मा ने 9.02 सीजीपीए के साथ छठा, करसोग कॉलेज के रोहन कपूर ने 8.99 सीजीपीए के साथ सातवां, डीएवी कांगड़ा की इंदु वाला ने 8.98 सीजीपीए के साथ आठवां जबिक धर्मशाला डिग्री कॉलेज की विशा थापा और राजधानी शिमला आरकेएमवी की सुष्मिता रॉय ने संयुक्त रूप से 8.97 सीजीपीए के साथ मेरिट में नवां स्थान पाया, जबिक डीएवी कांगड़ा की वैशाली ने 8.87 सीजीपीए के साथ दसवां स्थाना पाया।

➤ Angel Shan, B.A.III Economics


- Worked as an HR Associate with Comet Aid, a company dedicated to catalysing change and was commended by the CEO for her performance.
