- Student Feedback and Peer Team Visit

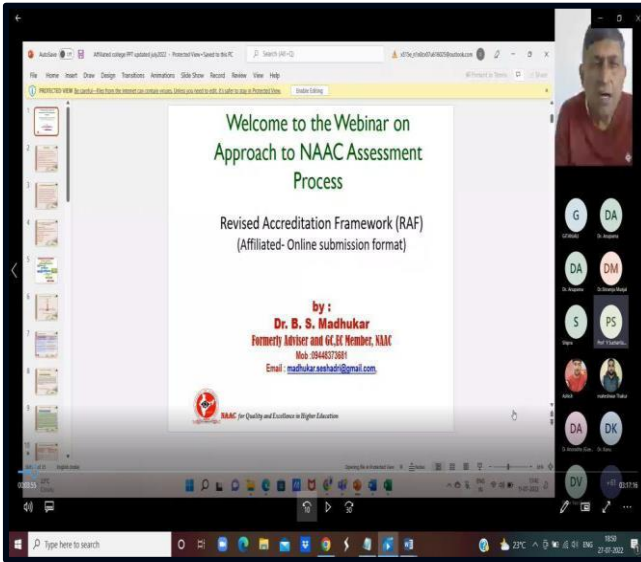

Dr. Alok John, Dean of NICCS Patna Women’s College, discussed the role of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) in institutionalizing a quality culture. Dr. Madhukar B.S., former Adviser & General Council Executive Committee Member NAAC, focused on the preparation of the Self-Study Report (SSR) and the data validation and verification process of the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC). Dr. Surya Rashmi Rawat, Deputy Director IQAC, Himachal Pradesh University, Shimla, spoke about the preparation of the Institutional Information for Quality Assessment (IIQA) and highlighted the core values of NAAC. The webinar also addressed the importance of student feedback and peer team visits, with Dr. Alok John providing insights on these topics. The Chief Guest, Prof. Arvind Kumar Bhatt, Dean of Planning and Teachers Matters at Himachal Pradesh University, emphasized the college's collaboration with stakeholders to maintain its status as a pioneering institute in India.

IPR AWARENESS PROGRAMME

On September 23, 2022, an online Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) awareness program was conducted by the Department of Biotechnology at St. Bede's College, in association with The Patent Office in Kolkata under the Department for Promotion of Industry & Internal Trade (DPIIT), Ministry of Commerce & Industry. The webinar was conducted by Shri Suman Sil, an Examiner of Patents & Designs (Gr. 'A' Gazetted) who engaged the students and faculty in an informative discussion about the importance of IPR and its various forms. The webinar was attended by students, faculty, and staff from the college, as well as from other colleges and institutions.

Objective- The objective of the session was:

- To introduce the students to the basics of intellectual property rights and patent filing.
- To provide knowledge of different forms of intellectual property protection and their key differences and similarities.
- To raise awareness about filing applications for patents and other IPR.

During the webinar, Shri Suman Sil provided an overview of IPR and its importance in today's world. He elaborated on the various forms of IPR protection, including patents, trademarks, copyrights, and trade secrets, and explained their key differences and similarities.

He also emphasized the need for proper documentation, filing, and maintenance of IPR, and shared some examples of how IPR can be used to protect and commercialize innovations and creative works.

Moreover, he discussed the procedures and requirements for filing applications for patents and other forms of IPR, and provided valuable insights into the legal and regulatory aspects of IPR.

The webinar was interactive, with students and faculty asking questions and sharing their views on various aspects of IPR. Shri Suman Sil provided detailed answers and shared his knowledge and experience, making the session informative and engaging for everyone.

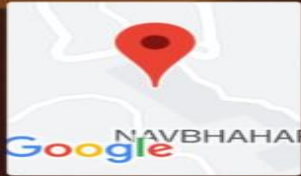

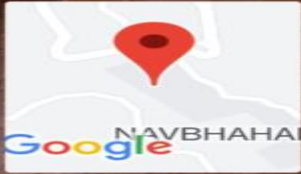

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WORKSHOP ON THE MLA-STYLE SHEET

On the 14th and 15th of October 2022, the Department of English at St. Bede's College, Shimla, organised a workshop for their M.A. students on the MLA style sheet.

Objective-The workshop aimed to help the students understand the format and citing sources according to the MLA Handbook (9th edition). The workshop was conducted by the faculty, Ms Annette James.

Session Overview: Ms Annette James started the session by introducing the MLA style sheet and its importance in academic writing. She explained how the MLA Handbook, released by the Modern Language Association, helps researchers present their work in a standard and understandable design while allowing researchers to indulge in their research flexibly.

Ms James then focused on the format of academic writing and how to cite sources according to the MLA style sheet. She shared some examples of correct citations and how to make references to avoid plagiarism. She also explained the importance of acknowledging sources and the consequences of not doing so.

The students were given handouts with tips for following the style sheet and academic writing. They were then guided step-by-step to cite sources, make references, and format their academic assignments according to the MLA style sheet. The students were encouraged to adopt the format to write their assignments to prepare them well for research writing when pursuing further studies.

Interactive Session: After the presentation, the session was opened up for an interactive discussion, where students were encouraged to ask questions and share their views. 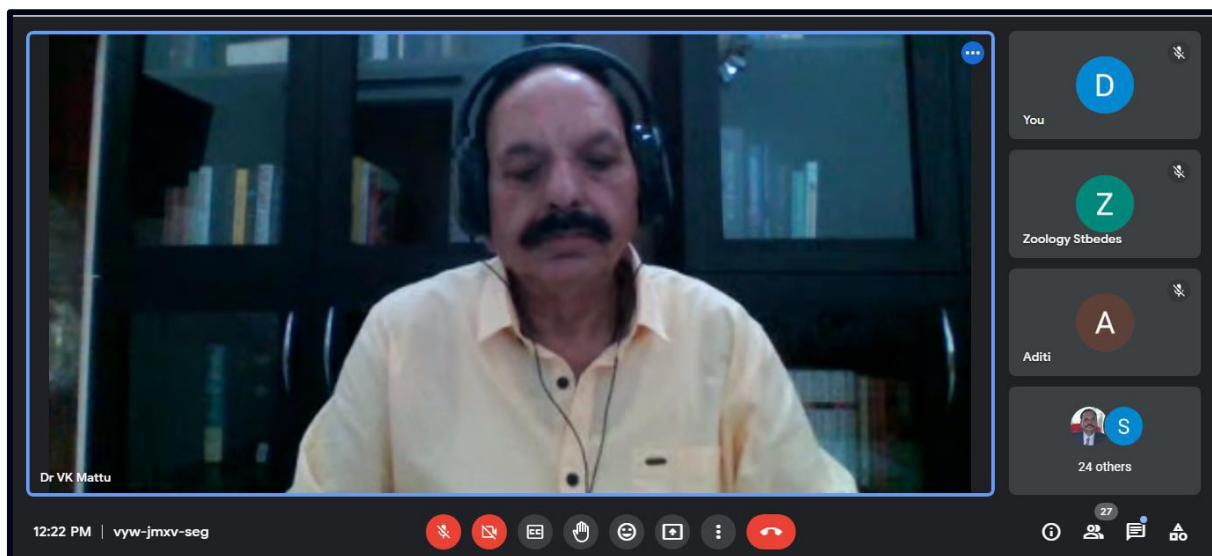


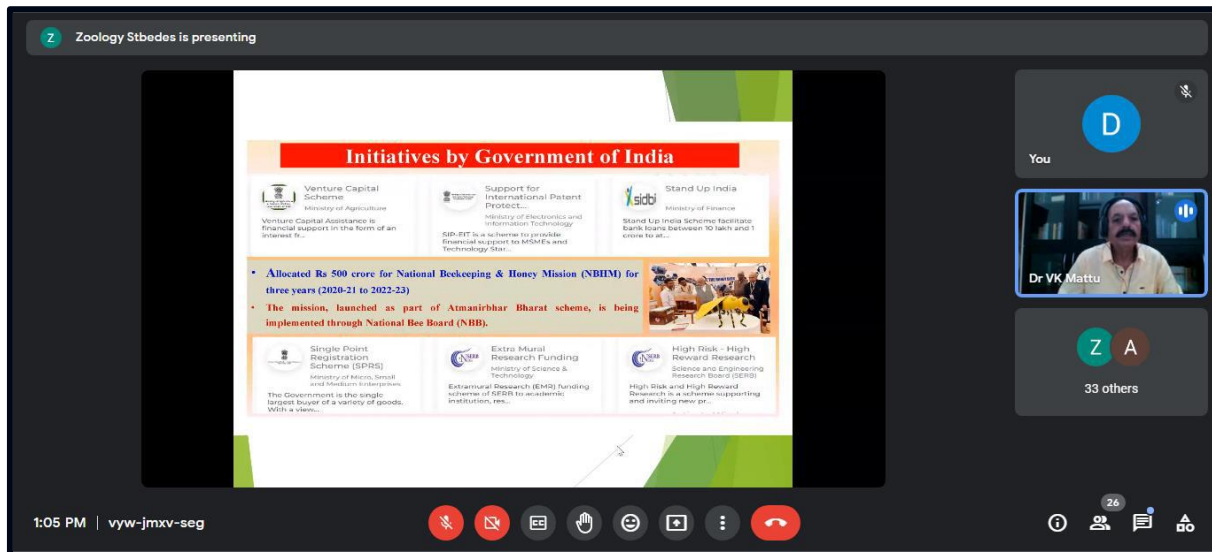
role of insect farming in sustainable agriculture, and the regulatory barriers and public perception challenges associated with insect farming.

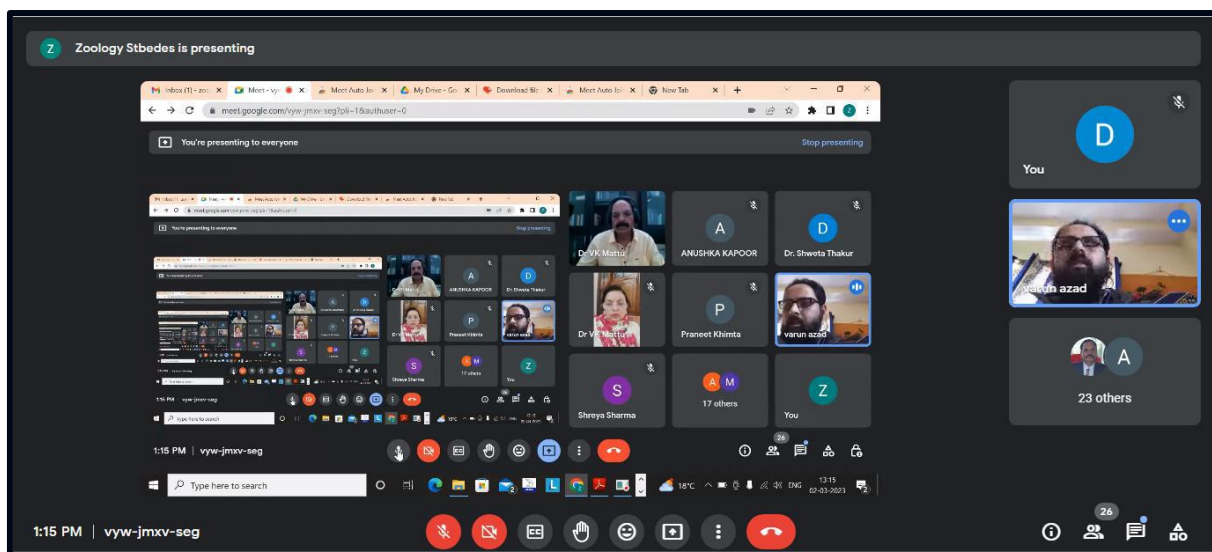


Talk on Livestock Entrepreneurship management by Dr. Moneesh Thakur, Veterinary Officer

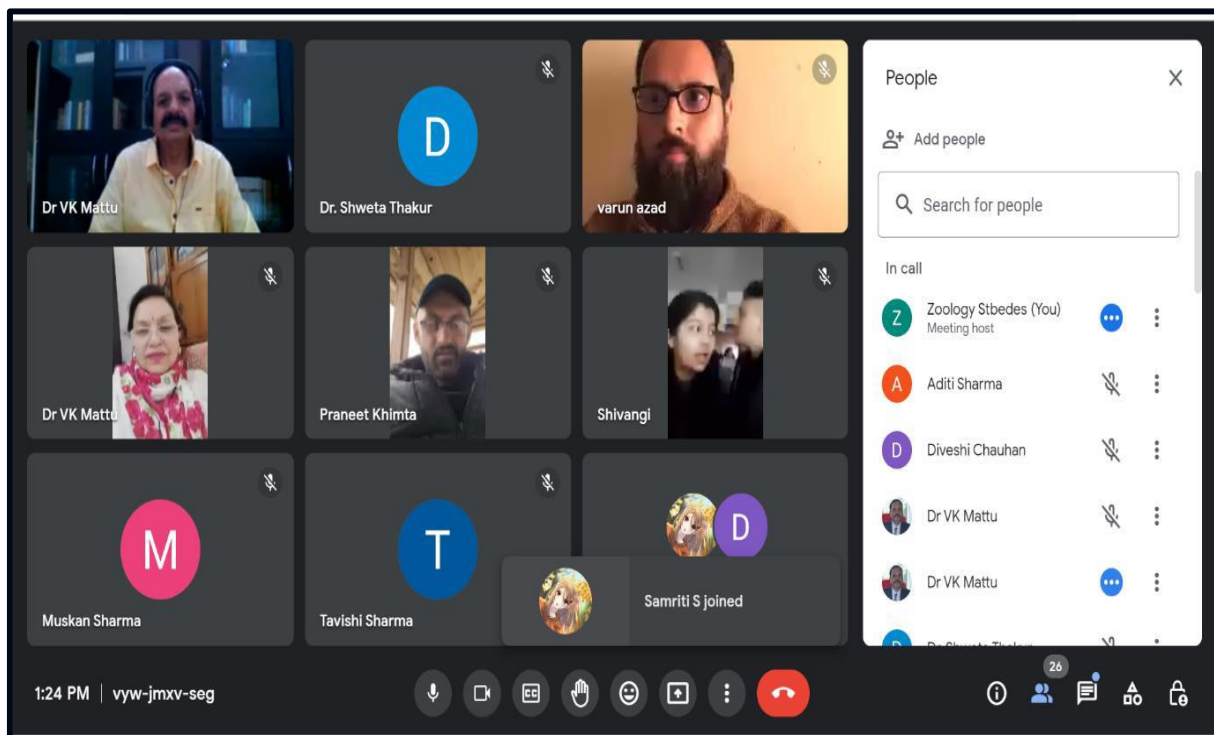

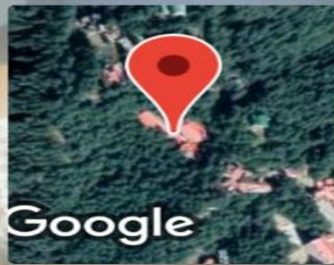

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WEBINAR ON “ROADMAP TO RBI GRADE B OFFICER”
