Through this activity, the students found a platform for their self-expression among the public.

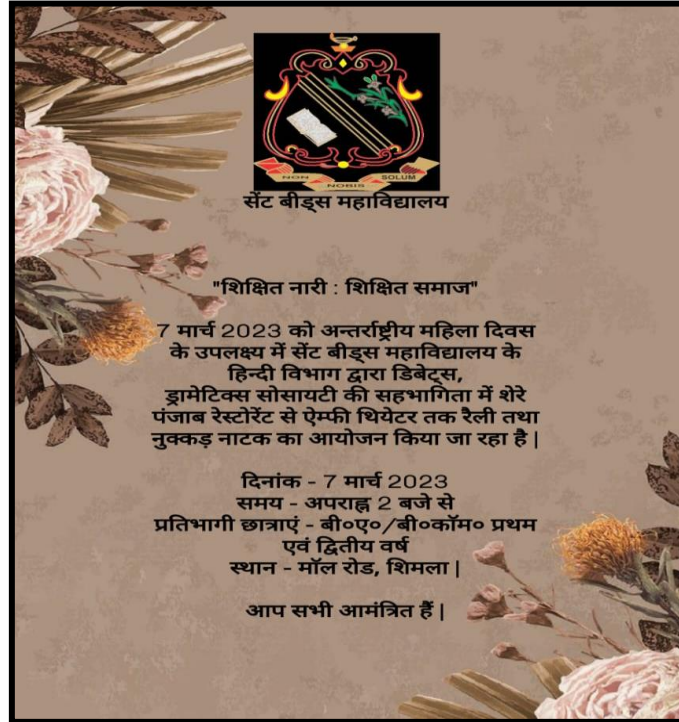
- Students spread awareness about the need to educate female children.
