❖ WILDLIFE WEEK CELEBRATION







❖ WEBINAR ON ENTREPRENEURSHIP

Department of Zoology, St. Bede's College organised a webinar on Entrepreneurship Skills in Insect Farming and Livestock management on March 2, 2023. The resource persons for the webinar were Prof. V.K. Mattu (Emeritus) Himachal Pradesh University and Dr. Moneesh Thakur, Veterinary Officer Veterinary Hospital Harchakian Kangra Himachal Pradesh. They enriched the knowledge of students, farmers and made them aware about entrepreneurship and employment opportunities in beekeeping and livestock management. Around 80 participants which included farmers and students from various colleges attended the webinar. 




