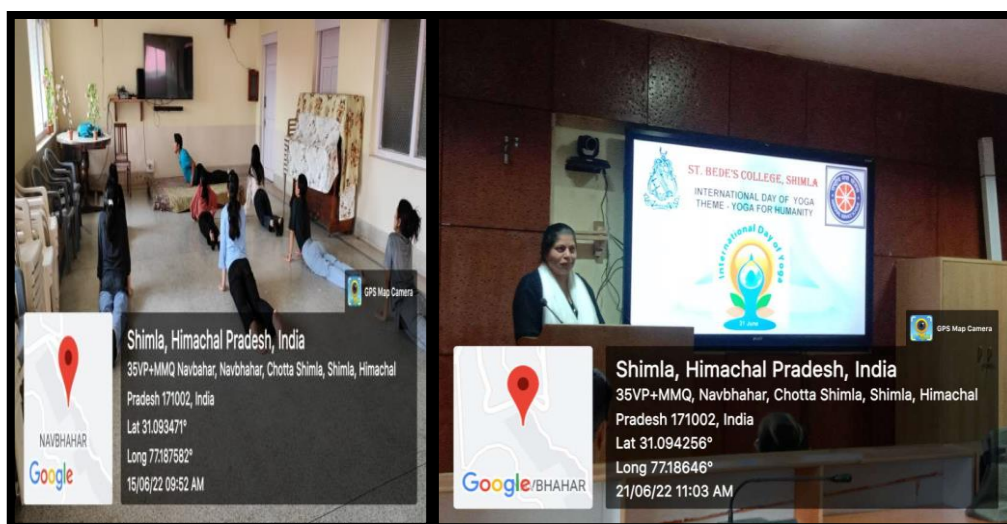


INTERNATIONAL DAY OF YOGA June 21, 2022.

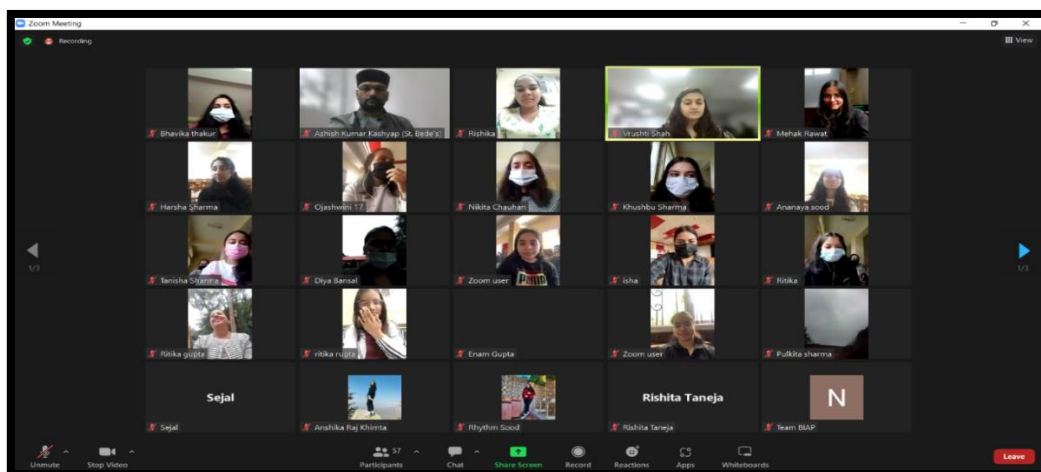
VISIT TO THE STATE MUSEUM August 6, 2022

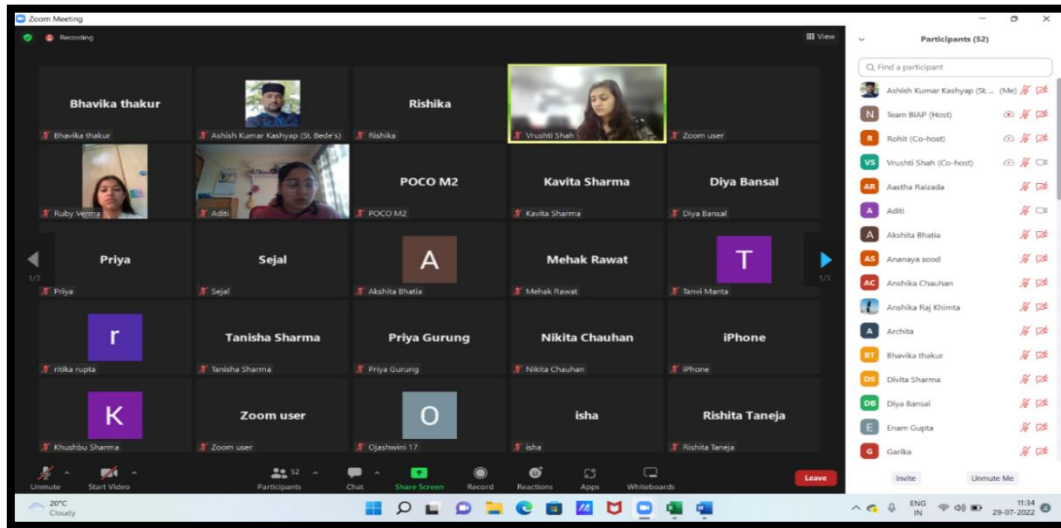

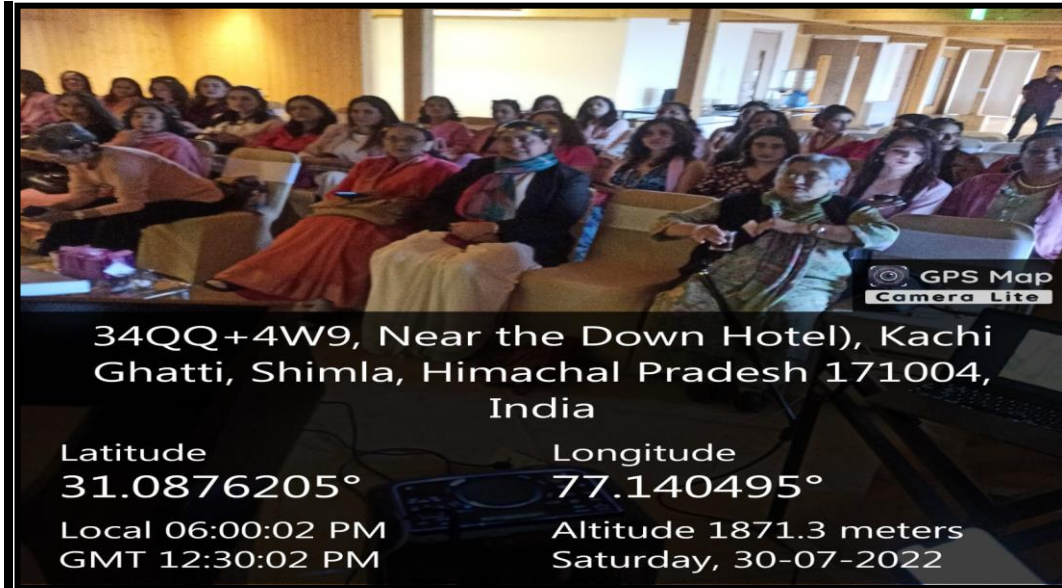




EX- BEDEIAN MEET July 30, 2022

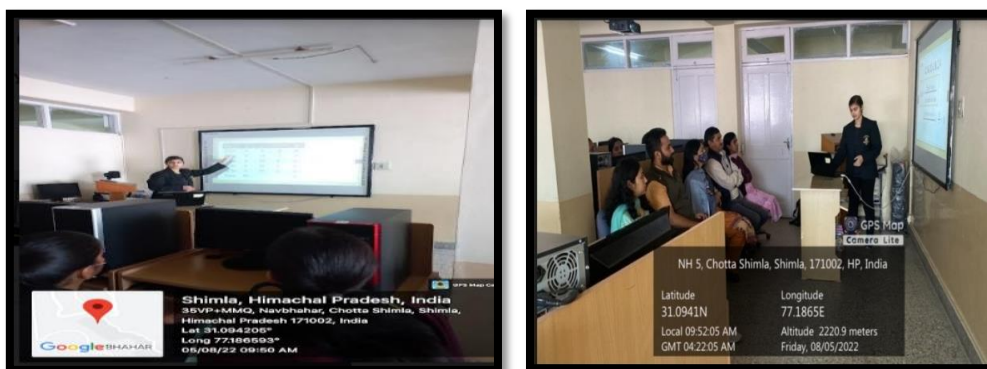




INTERDEPARTMENTAL ACTIVITY

The purpose of the visit was to show the students the electron microscope and other machines used in the institute, and to brief them about the history, working, and achievements of the CPRI.





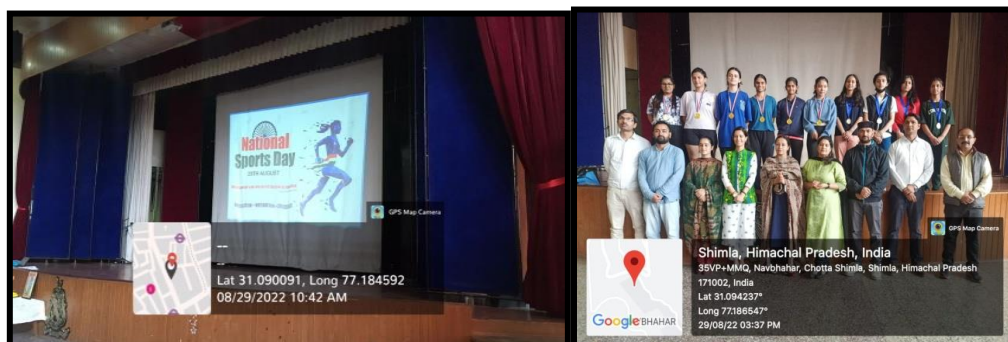
HIV PREVENTION AND AWARENESS CAMPAIGN August 26, 2022

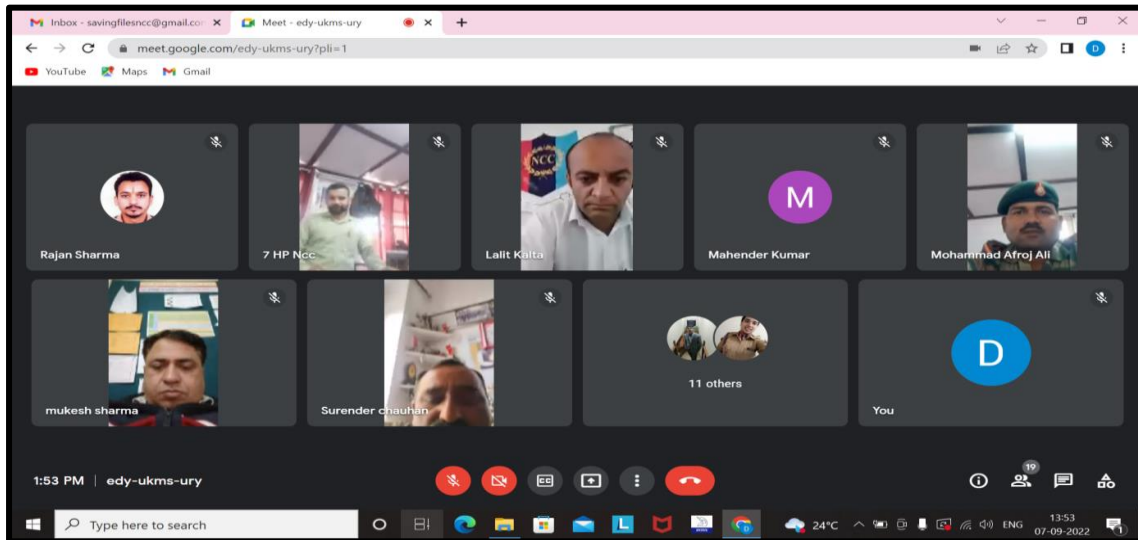

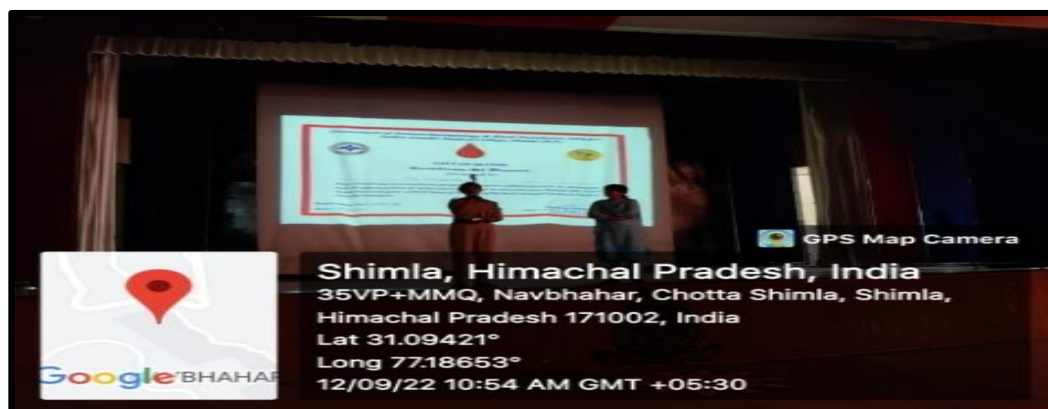




VOLUNTARY BLOOD DONATION INITIATIVE ON INTERNATIONAL DAY OF CHARITY

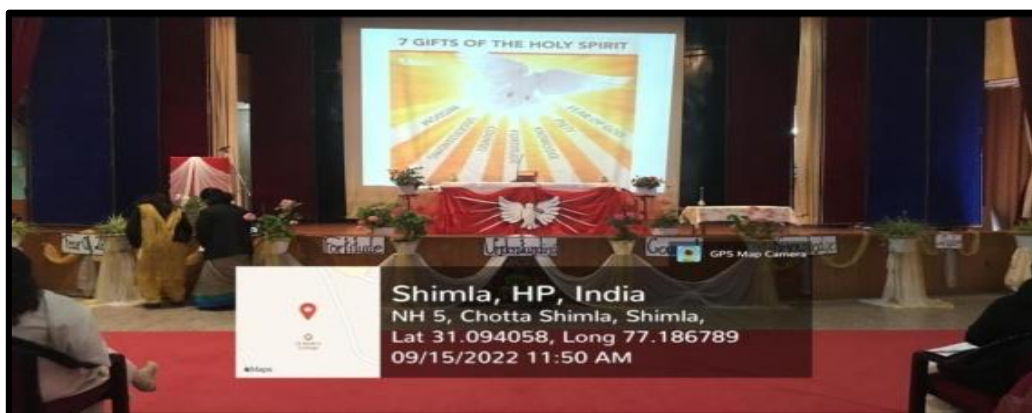
BOOK REVIEW COMPETITION September 15, 2022

September 16, 2022

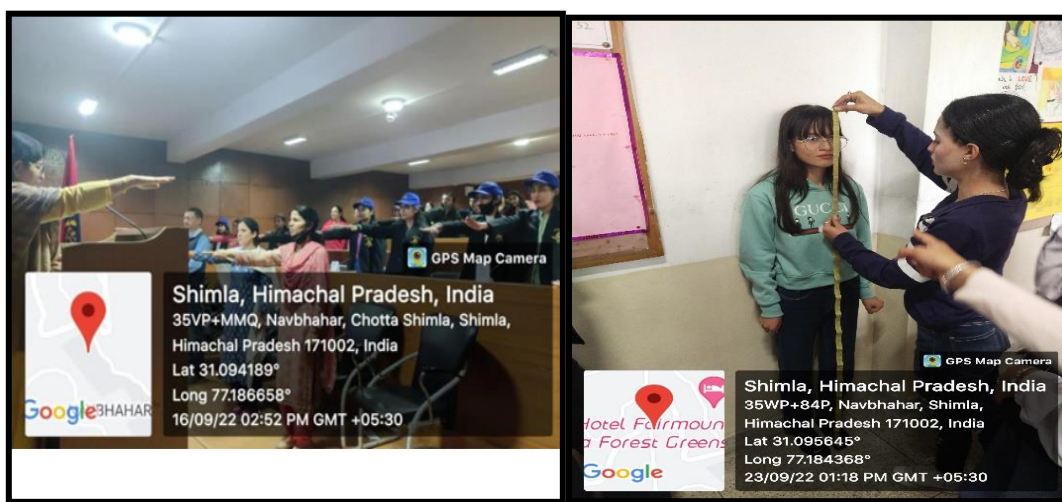

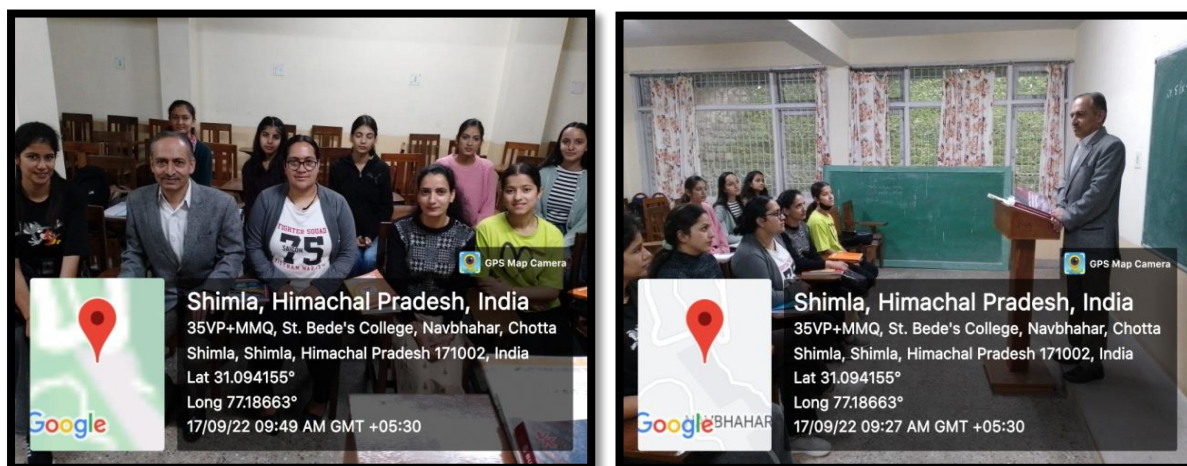
PRESENTATION ON OBESITY MANAGEMENT September 17, 2022

GUEST LECTURE ON RESEARCH METHODOLOGY September 17, 2022

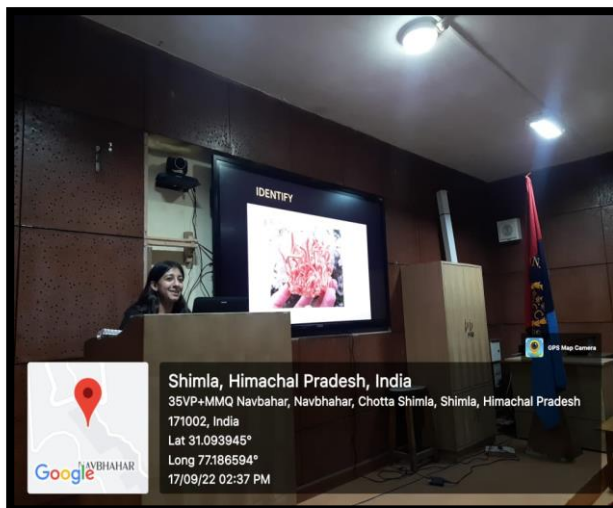
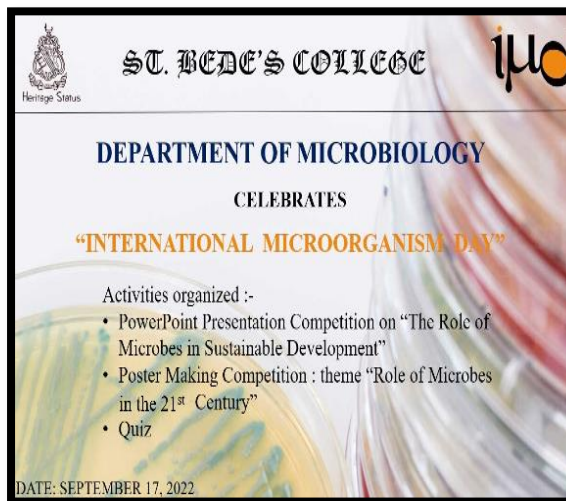

UTILITY OF NATIONAL EDUCATION POLICY

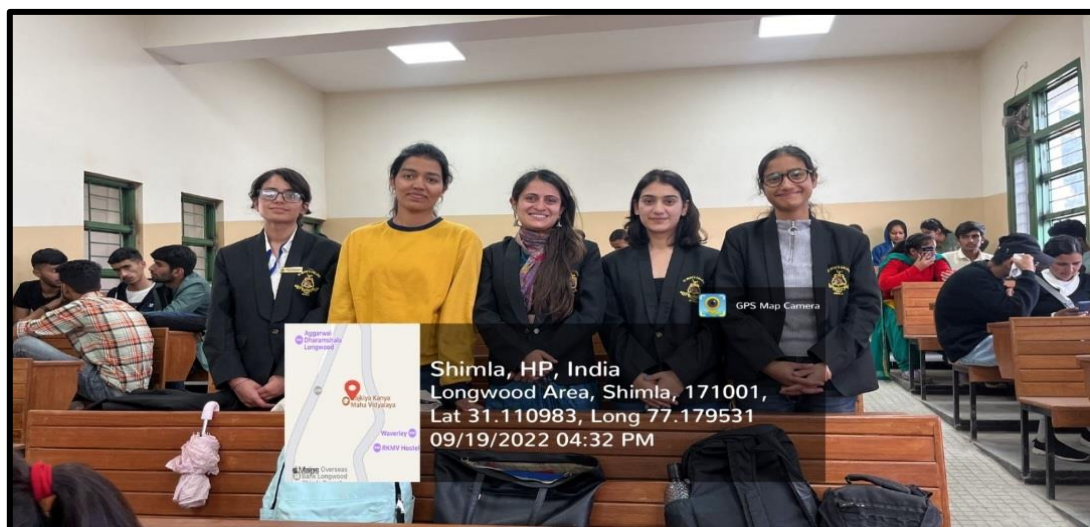
September 19-20, 2022

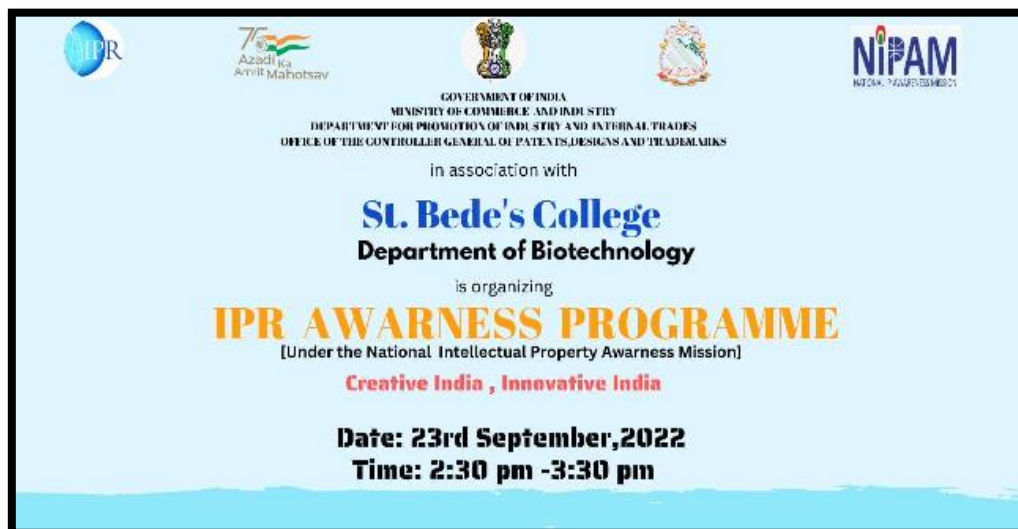




IPR AWARENESS PROGRAMME September 23, 2022

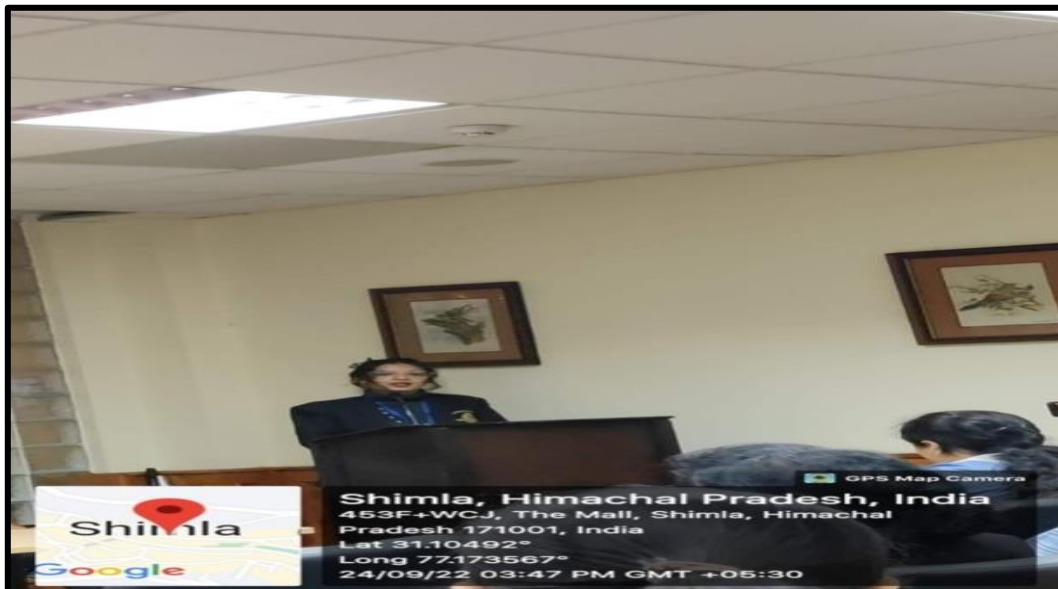
REDUCE, REUSE, RECYCLE **September 24, 2022**

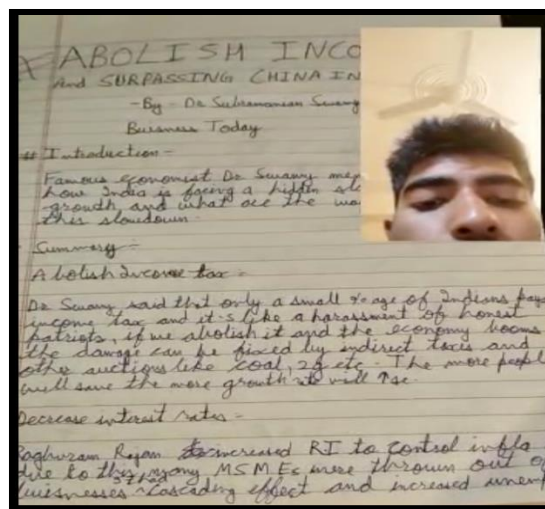
FRESHERS' WELCOME October 1, 2022

Theme: Raising awareness on Biodiversity Conservation

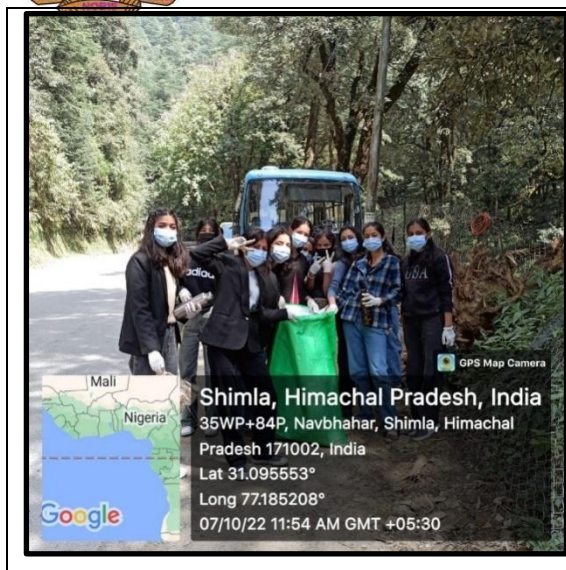

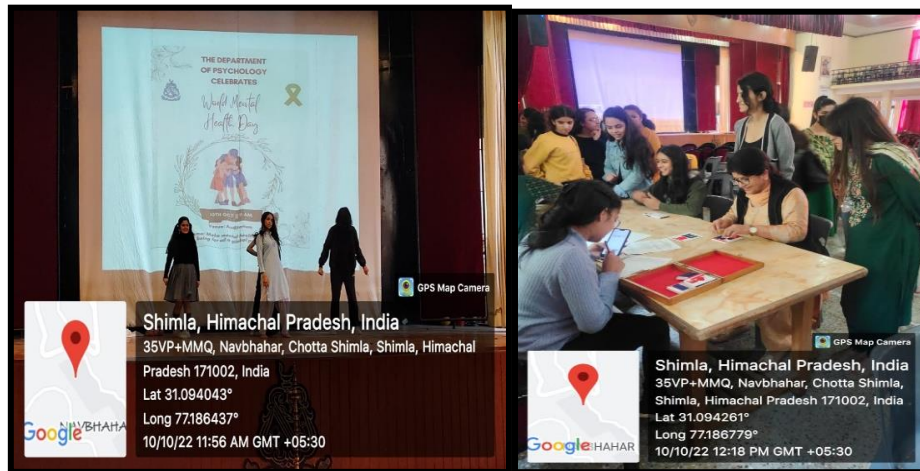


WORLD MENTAL HEALTH DAY October 10, 2022

INTERNATIONAL PEACE DAY October 12, 2022

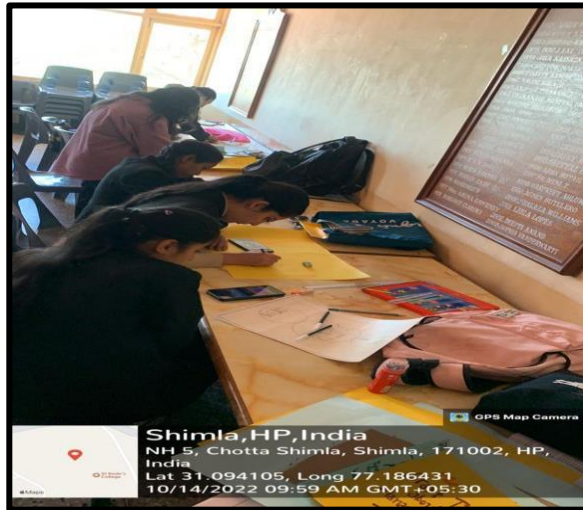

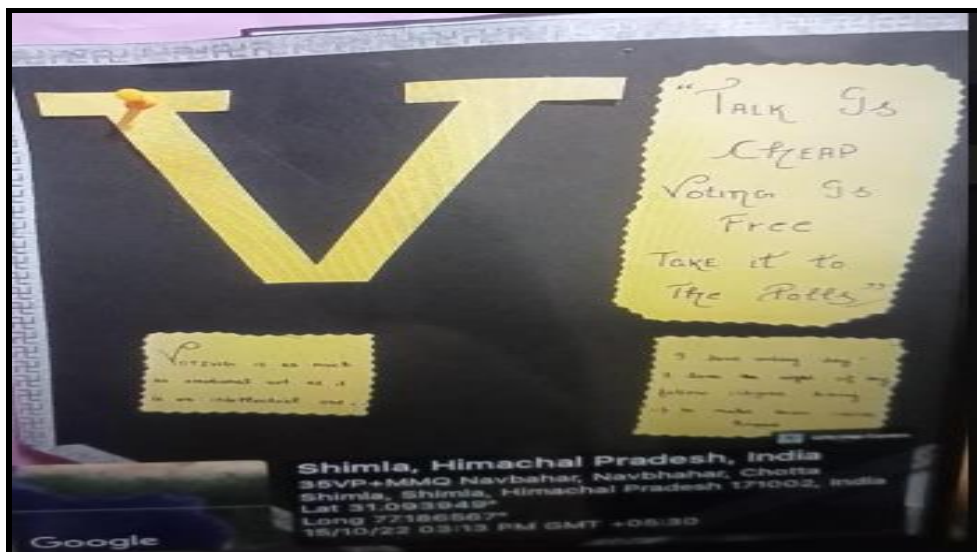


SLOGAN WRITING COMPETITION

FINANCIAL LAB CUM INCUBATION CENTRE EXHIBITION-I October 19, 2022

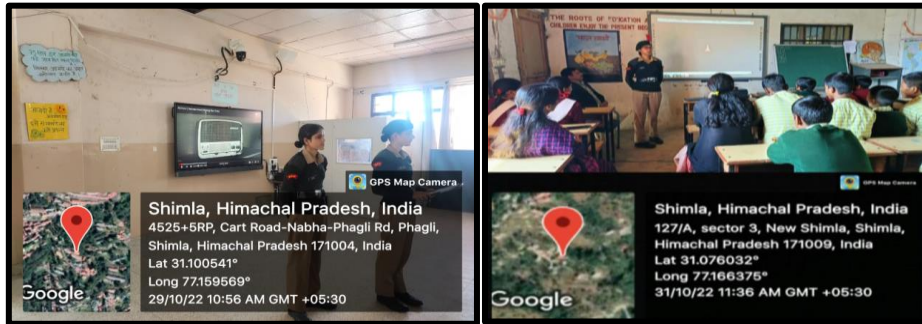

November 4, 2022**

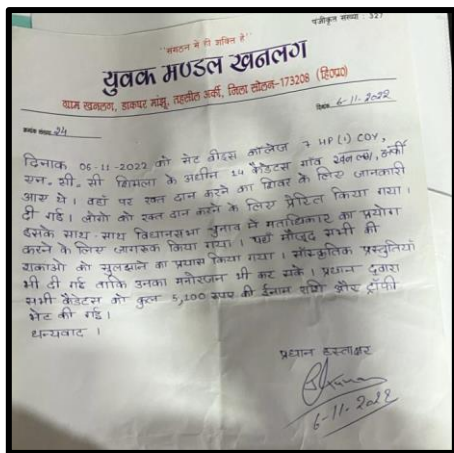

PARTICIPATION IN ENVISION- HPU FEST November 9-11, 2022

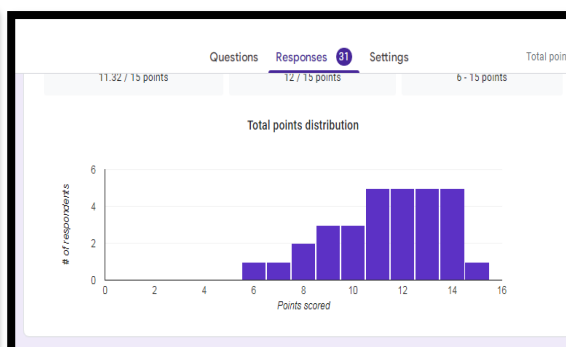

INTERNATIONAL YEAR OF GLASS November 16, 2022

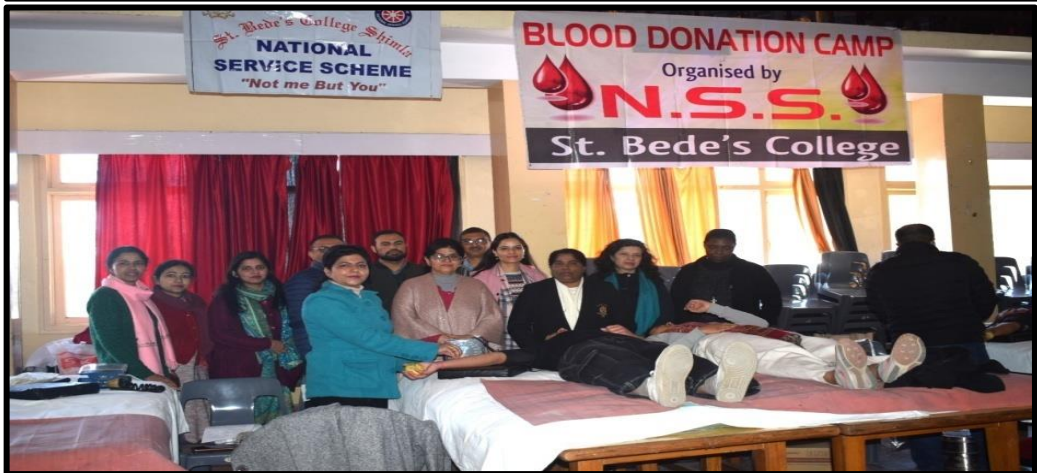

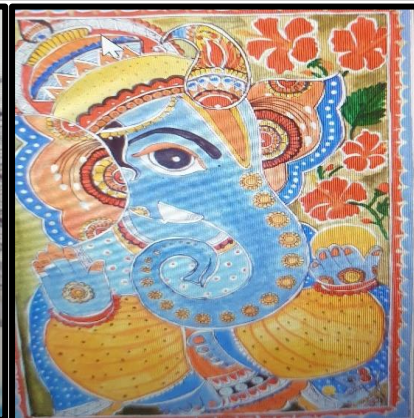


**HERITAGE WEEK

November 24, 2022

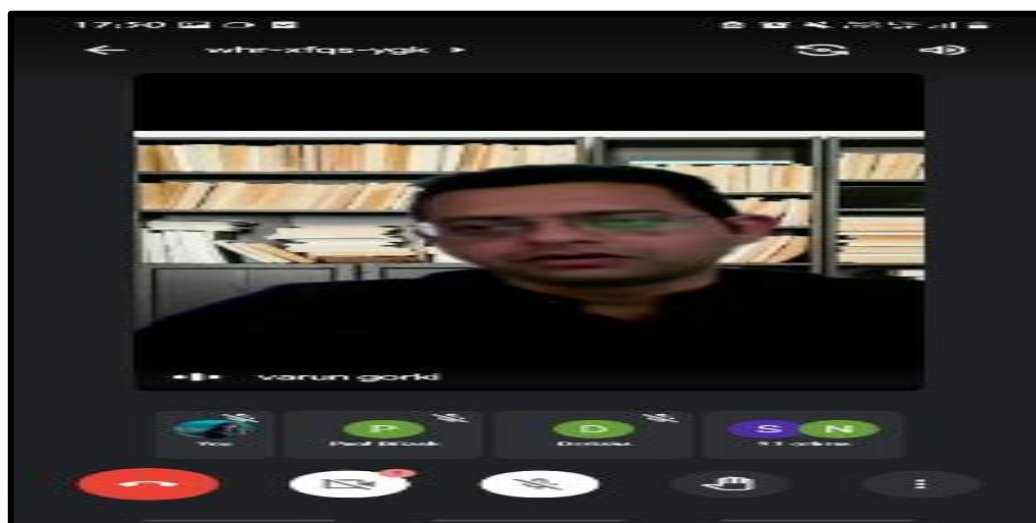

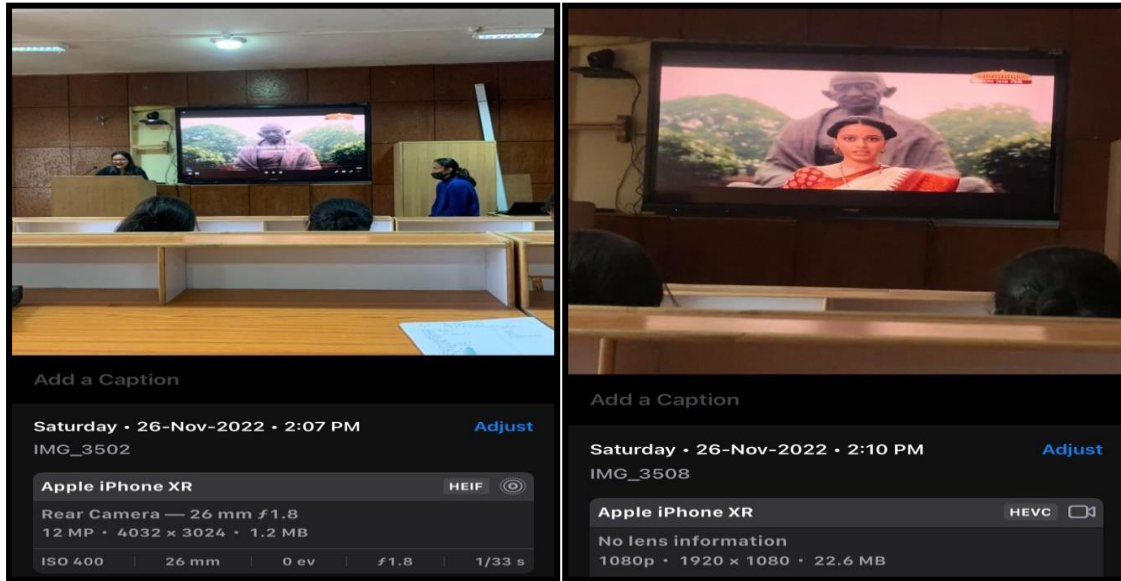


REEL THE VERSE 'NATIONAL CONSTITUTION DAY'

NATIONAL CONFERENCE ON ‘NOVEL PROGRESSIONS IN SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY’

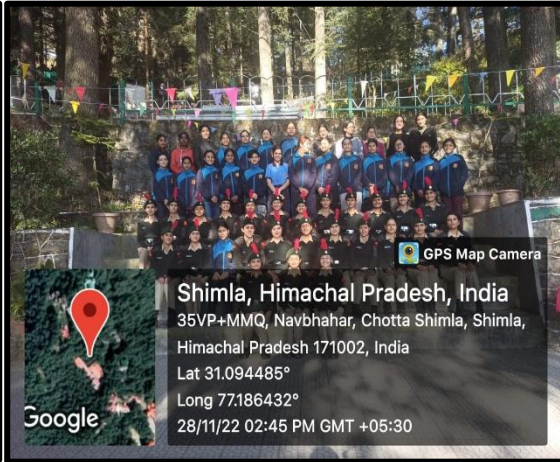
November 28-29, 2022

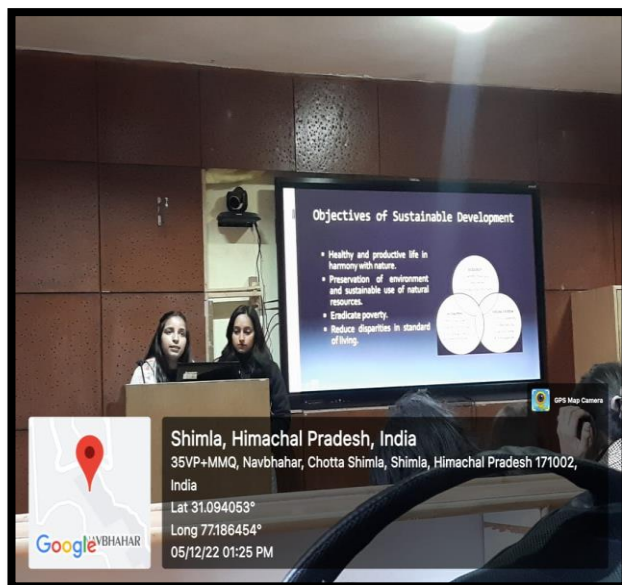
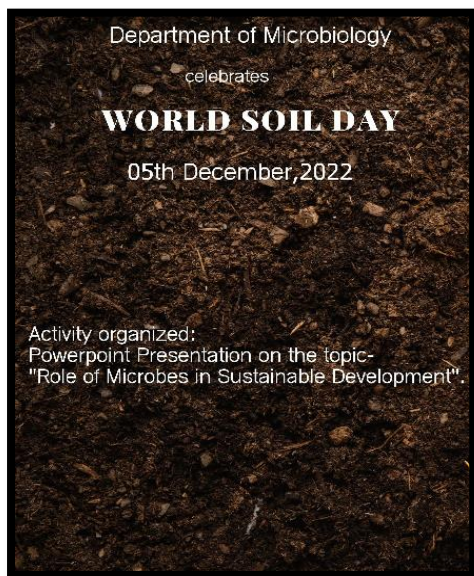
TECHNOLOGY WEEK December 1-5, 2022

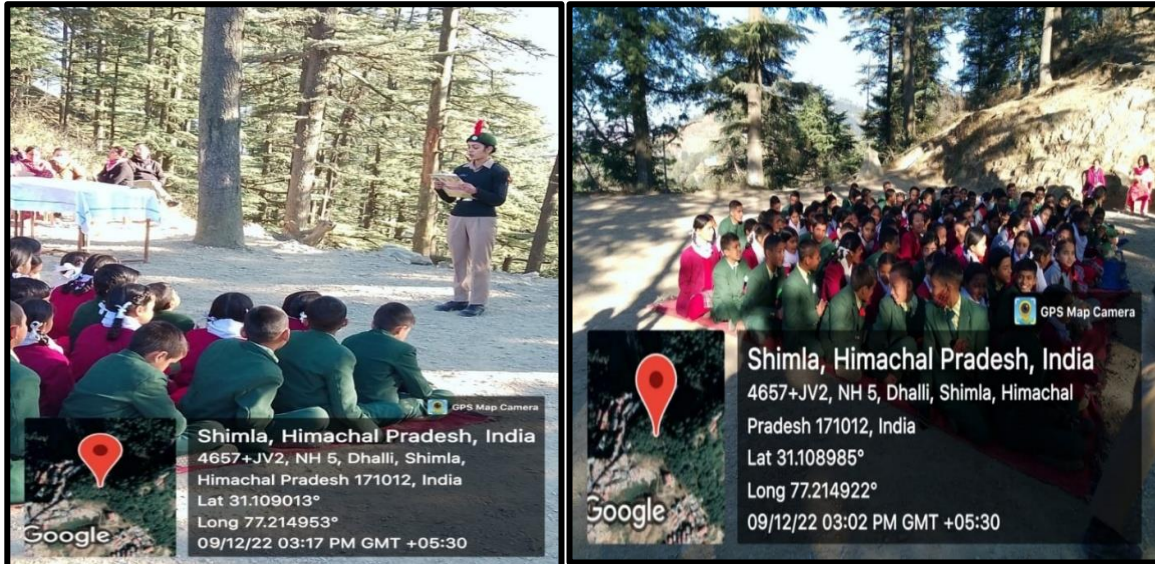

From December 15 – 22, CATC-131 PRE RDC-2 camp was conducted at NCC academy, Rupnagar, Punjab.



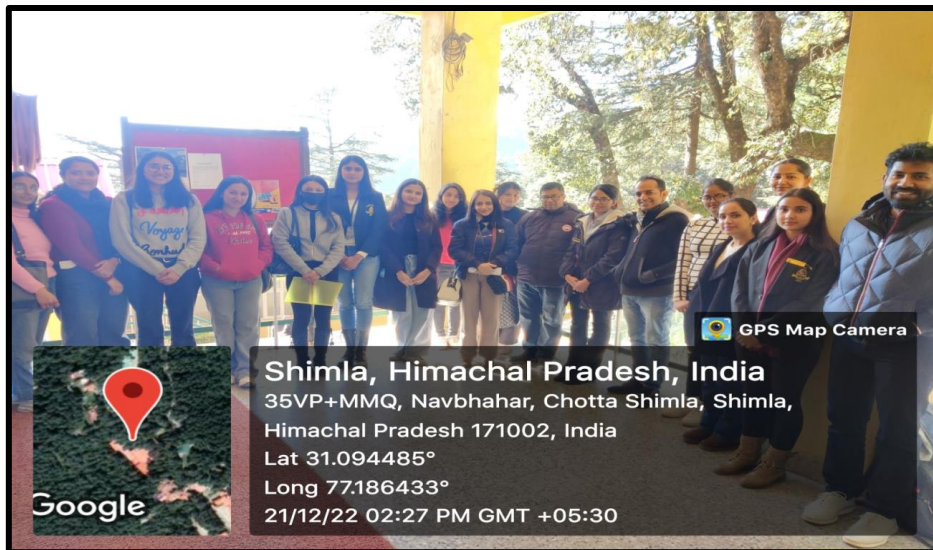
PLACEMENT CUM INTERNSHIP DRIVE BY TOMMY HILFIGER

December 22, 2022

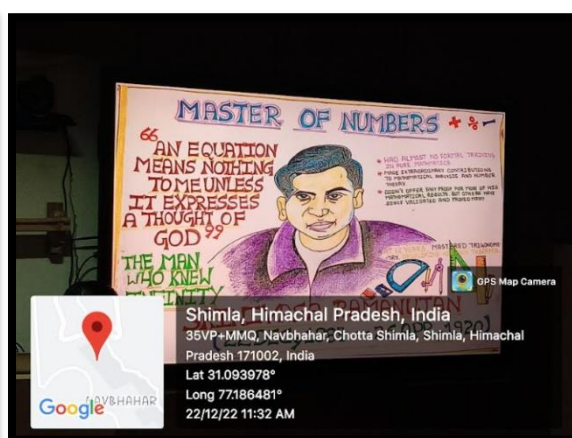
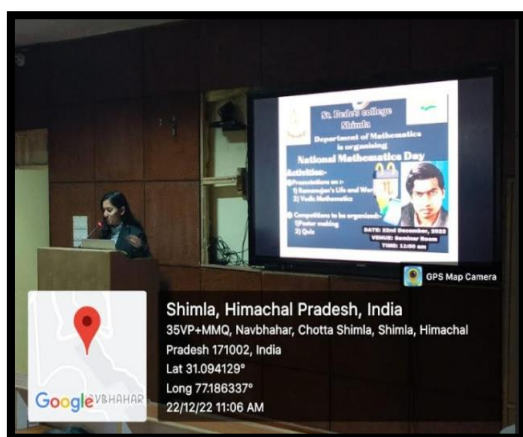

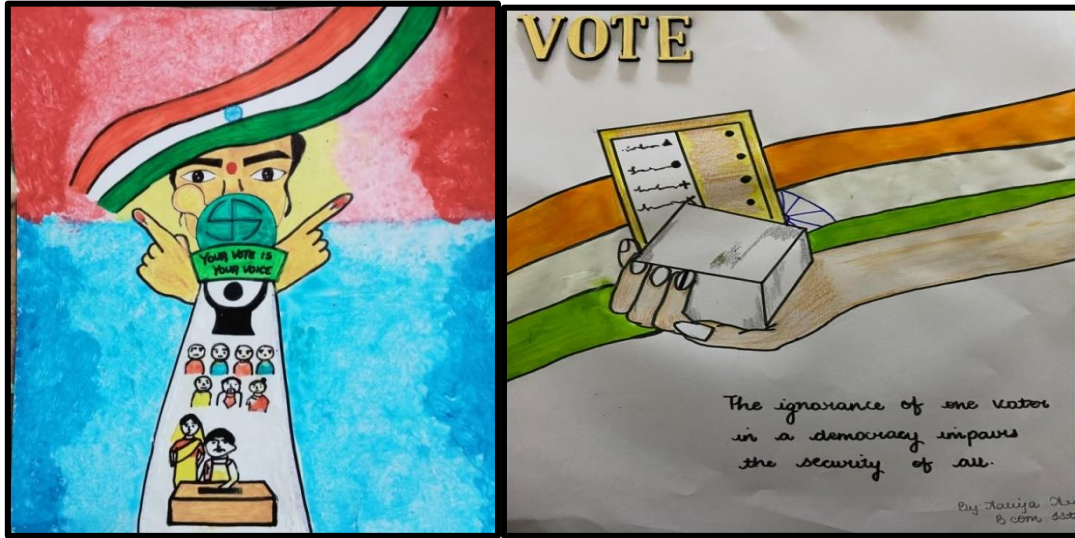
NATIONAL YOUTH DAY

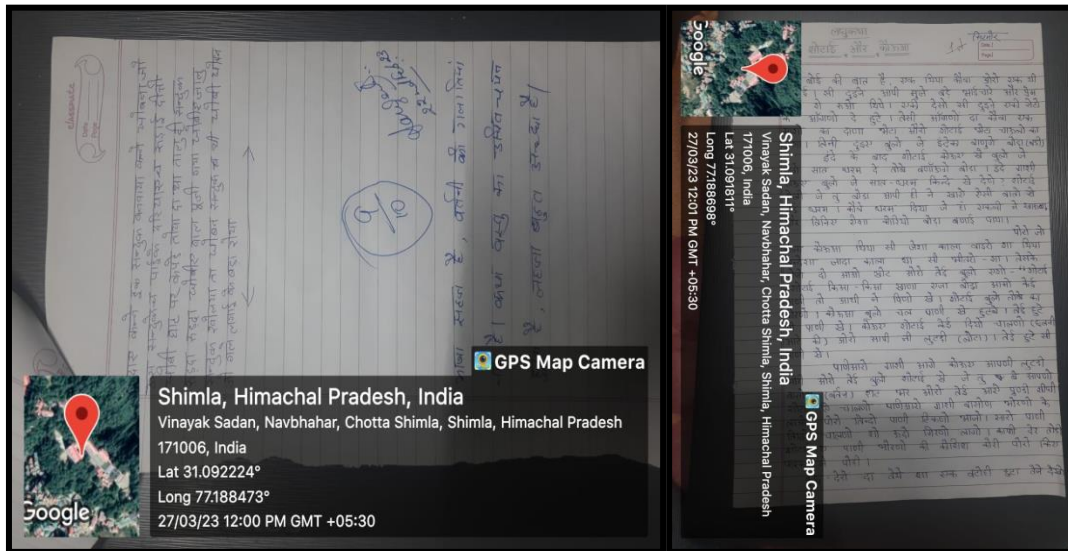
अंतरराष्ट्रीय मातृ भाषा दिवस का आयोजन

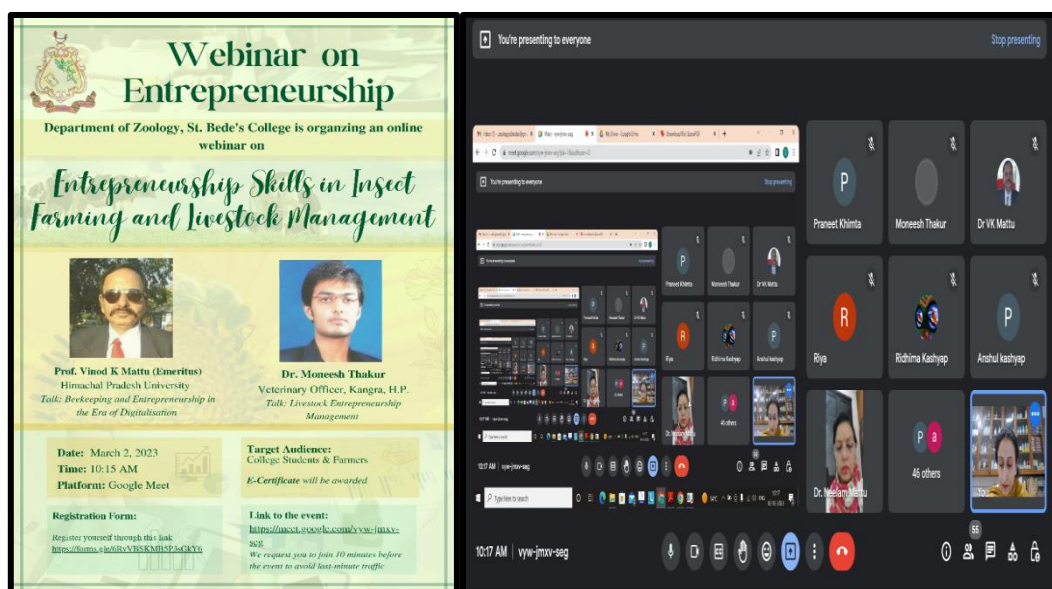




WEBINAR ON ENTREPRENEURSHIP

INTERNATIONAL WOMENS' DAY CELEBRATION 2023

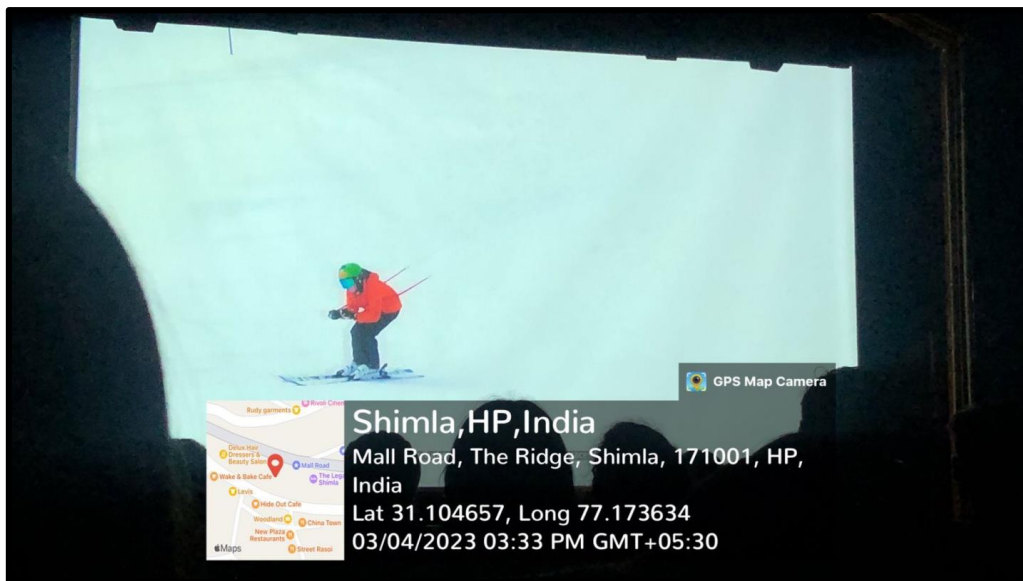
March 03, 2023

March 3, 2023

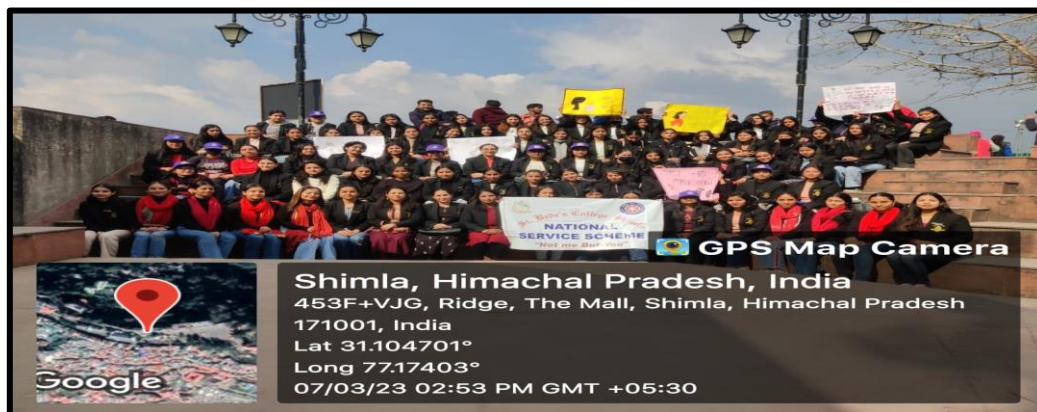

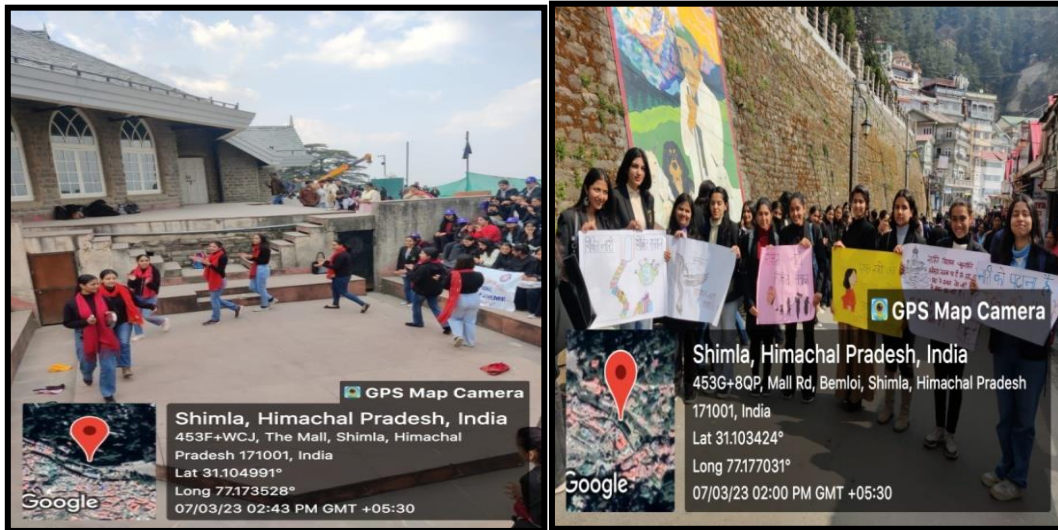


SHIKSHIT NARI, SHIKSHIT SAMAJ

INTER-SHIP POETRY WRITING COMPETITION

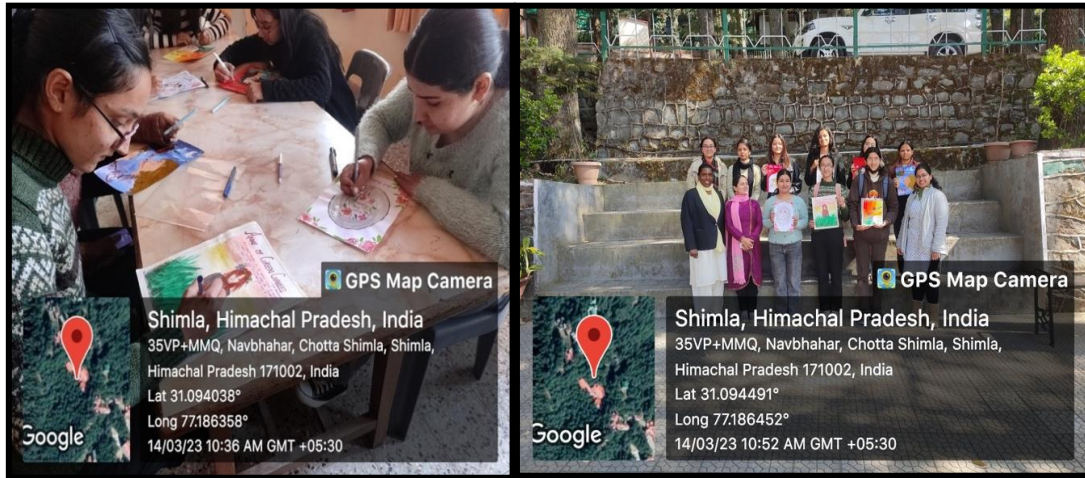
March 09, 2023

BOOK COVER PAINTING COMPETITION ON WOMEN'S WRITING

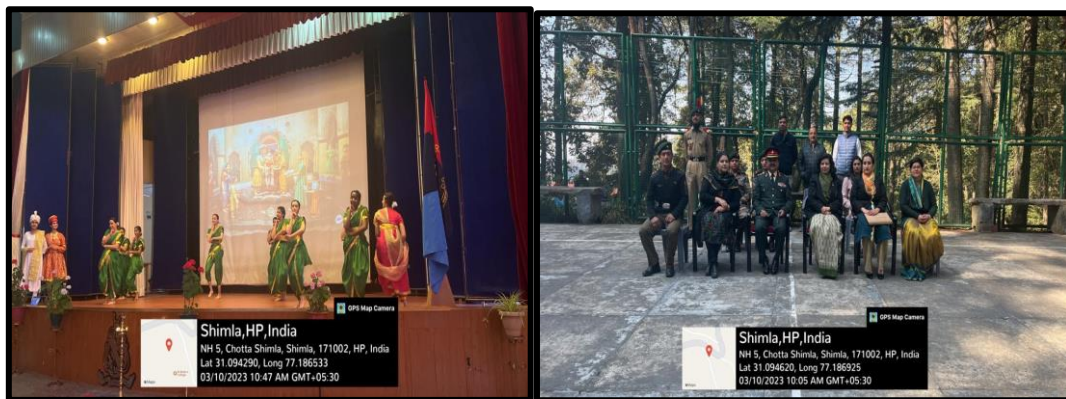
March 9, 2023

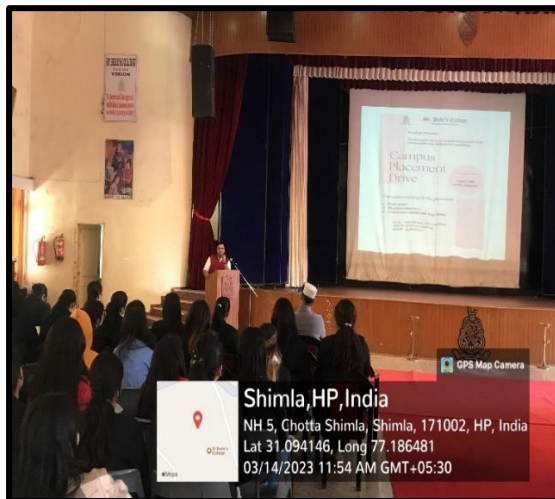


CAMPUS PLACEMENT DRIVE

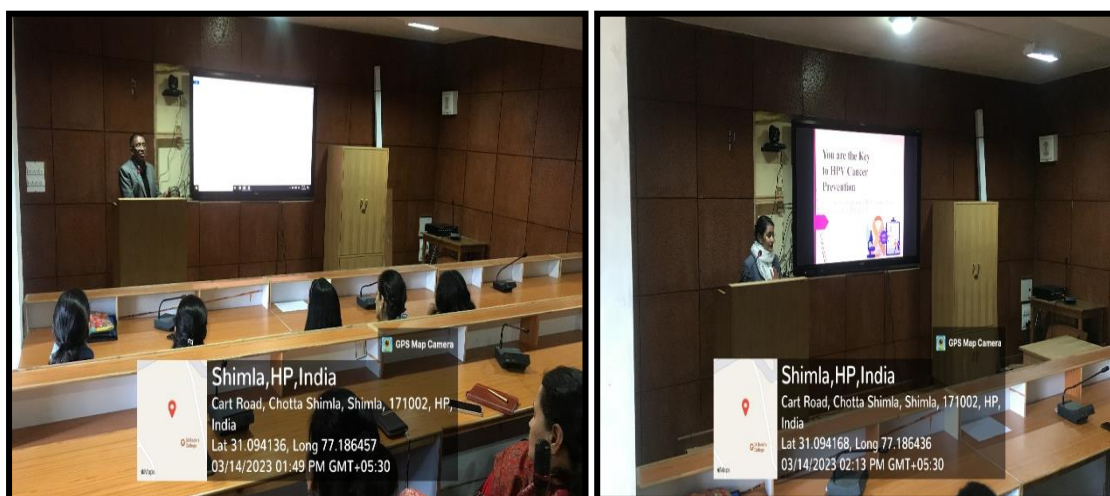




AWARENESS TALK ON CERVICAL CANCER

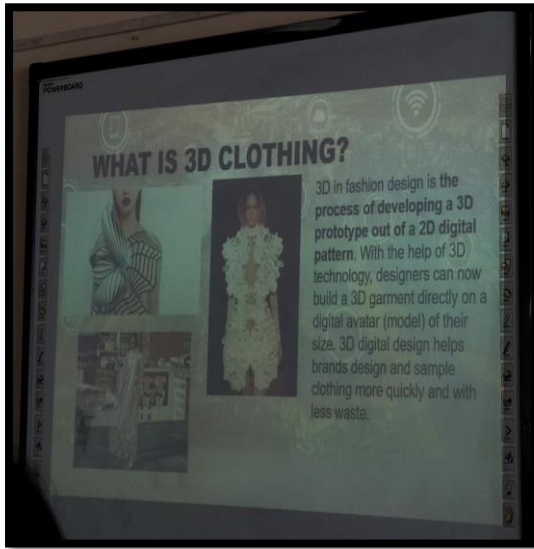

INTER COLLEGE ECONOMICS LITERARY MEET March 23, 2023

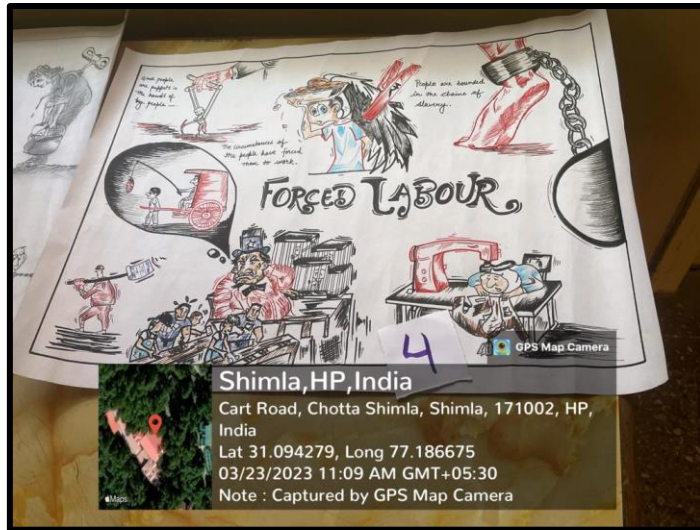

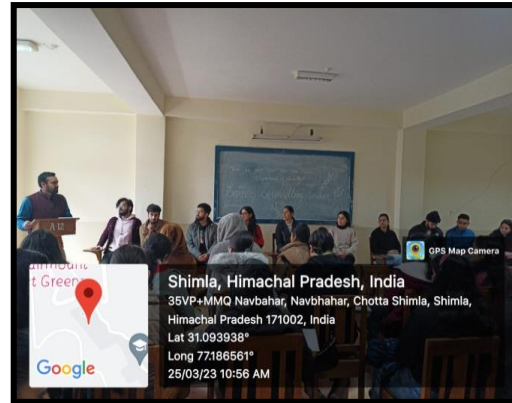

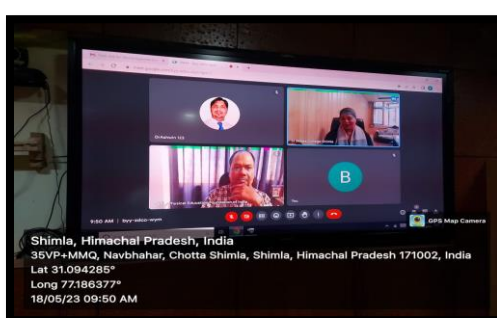
**DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM ON ‘WORK ETHICS’ FOR THE NON-TEACHING STAFF
