1. Definition and Prohibition:

- b. Expert Guest Speakers: Guest speakers, including lawyers, counselors, or psychologists, will be invited to provide insights into the consequences of ragging and the importance of maintaining a ragging-free environment.
- c. **Information Dissemination:** Posters and notices highlighting the consequences of ragging will be prominently displayed within the college premises.
- d. **Pledge Ceremonies:** Pledge ceremonies will be organized to create a commitment among students and staff to prevent and eradicate ragging.
