Outcome: It contributed to the ongoing promotion of mindfulness and stress reduction on a global scale.








Felicitation Ceremony (August 12, 2023)

On August 12, 2023 the NCC Unit, St. Bede's College Shimla organized an Orientation ceremony for the First-year students for NCC. The orientation began with a warm welcome to all the attendees followed by an introduction to the NCC and its significance in fostering leadership skills discipline and national awareness. An overview of the NCC's organizational structure ranks and the roles and responsibilities of various positions within the corps was provided. The orientation concluded with a summary of the day's activities reiterating the importance of commitment discipline and dedication in the NCC.


Outcome: It included a smoother integration of individuals into the new setting, increased understanding of organizational culture, and improved clarity on expectations.

Outcome: The celebration contributed to the preservation of traditional skills and promoted a sense of pride in the cultural heritage associated with khadi.





The carnival left an indelible mark in the hearts of all attendees reinforcing the values of discipline and dedication upheld by the NCC.


Outcome: The carnival provided an opportunity for cadets to showcase their abilities while fostering a sense of pride and community within the NCC.

Objective: The objective of the substance abuse session was to provide education, support, and intervention for individuals dealing with or at risk of drug abuse.


On December 6, 2023 NCC Unit, St. Bede's College under 7 HP (I) COY NCC SHIMLA in collaboration with the Health Club organised a session on substance use (drug) prevention.

The Resource Persons were Ms. Arunima Sharma, Major Vikas Kadsholi and Mr. Kulpreet Singh. The session was conducted by the Non profit – Vyaktitva Foundation under the initiative "Udaan."

The session was an interactive session which explained the ways to combat and prevent substance abuse. The session also included a presentation which included all the topics that were discussed such as causes of substance abuse, ways to combat substance abuse, etc. The presentation also included a short film which portrayed how someone can get addicted and various aspects of drug abuse. Major Vikas Kadsholi also talked about the importance of having an aim and the track that will lead to successfully achieving that aim. The students actively participated by answering and asking questions.



Outcome: The outcome of the substance abuse session included improved knowledge about the risks associated with drug abuse, increased motivation for individuals to make positive changes, and potentially a reduced likelihood of continued or future substance abuse.

Outcome: The outcome involved increased cross cultural understanding, improved language skills, and a deeper appreciation for diversity among participants and the broader community.






