**Objective:** Fostering leadership skills, teamwork, community engagement and personal development among students


#### **Description:**

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#### Hindustan Scouts and Guides Praveshika Camp

#### Date: September 04-06, 2023

**Objective:** The objectives of the Hindustan Scouts and Guides Praveshika camp for students were to instill leadership skills, promote teamwork, and foster personal growth through outdoor activities, emphasizing values, and community service.

#### **Description:**

Three days **Praveshika Camp** of The Hindustan Scouts and Guides was conducted in St. Bede's College, Shimla from September 04-06, 2023. Over forty students from various disciplines participated and each day of the camp featured a distinct set of activities designed for the comprehensive development of students' personalities.

#### Day-1

On the morning of September 4, 2023, the camp commenced with the assembly of all volunteers in the college compound. Mr. Manmohan Kumar and Mr. Pushapraj, the instructors, briefed the volunteers on the Scouts and Guides specifications, demonstrating the correct technique for flag hoisting. The honorable Principal, Prof. (Sr.) Molly Abraham, hoisted the flag, followed by an on-the-spot cultural event. #### Day-2

On the second day of the camp, September 5, 2023, activities commenced at 9:30 AM with light exercises. Leaders were selected from each "toli/patrol," and the first patrol leader unfurled the flag. Volunteers were instructed on tent setup procedures, and food stall requirements were noted. The students were taught various first-aid methods for assisting injured mates, including two-hand seat carry, stretcher use, and the drag method.

#### Day-3

On the final day of the camp, volunteers initiated the setup of tents and food stalls representing various states. A diverse array of dishes from states like Himachal, Kerala, Gujarat, Punjab, Haryana, etc., were showcased. Subsequently, the principal and staff observed cultural performances, visited food counters, and assessed the preparations. The principal offered motivating words to the teams, and certificates were distributed. The program concluded at 4:00 PM in the evening.


#### **Outcome:**


### National Unity Day Awareness Program Date: October 31, 2023




The colorful display of traditional Indian dresses served as a reminder of the cultural threads that


