Outcome: The rally served as a catalyst for community engagement and collaboration to address and combat drug abuse issues.





RALLY ON SUICIDE PREVENTION







Outcome: The celebration contributed to the preservation of traditional skills and promoted a sense of pride in the cultural heritage associated with khadi.




Date: December 18, 2023

Collaborating Agency: Govt. Primary School, Sanjauli, Shimla


No. of Participants: 38

WORLD RIVER DAY


Theme: "NANHE SNRAKSHAK"




NUKKAD NATAK: TRANSITION TO SUSTAINABLE LIVING


Objective: To promote sustainable living habits among the general public.





Outcome: The students successfully did the awareness campaign about HIV& AIDS.



Date: October 31, 2023






awareness and instilling a sense of responsibility among the student community.


Date: September 30, 2023

Outcomes: It was an attempt to inculcate the sense of responsibility among the college students. The enthusiasm and determination of the specially abled students was a source of inspiration for the college students





Theme: End Racism and Build Peace Collaborating agency: Community







Description: On 21st November 2022, an educational session was conducted with the objective of providing students with knowledge about malnutrition, methods of assessing nutritional status, and the importance of national programs in addressing this issue.
