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
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GREEN CAMPUS INITIATIVES




Restricted Entry of Automobiles




Ban on plastic use




4. LANDSCAPING WITH TREES AND PLANTS






Cleanliness Drive on September 1, 2023






Poster Making Competition on Ozone Day on September 16, 2023



FIELD VISIT TO EXPLORE LOCAL FLORA AT JAKHU HILLS



Local flora exploration at Jakhu hills on September 25, 2023



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


World River Day celebration on September 25, 2023








Cleanliness Drive at Rani Jhansi Park and Navbahar on October 1, 2023

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


Intradepartmental Quiz on World Habitat Day on October 3, 2023




Essay and slogan writing competitions on World Habitat Day on October, 2023



Skit and Chart Demonstration at Govt. Primary School, Sanjauli on World Food Day Celebration on October 16, 2023








E-Waste Collection Drive conducted from October 16 to 21, 2023




EDUCATIONAL VISIT TO PANJAB UNIVERSITY, CHANDIGARH

NUKKAD NATAK ON TRANSITION TO SUSTAINABLE LIVING





The Department of Botany, St. Bede's College organized a guest lecture on "Traditional Ethnobotanical Knowledge of Native Plant Diversity from Himachal" on November 29, 2023, for postgraduate and Undergraduate students in the auditorium. The resource person for the guest lecture was Dr. Vaneet Jishtu, Scientist E, ICFRE, HFRI, Panthaghati, Shimla. During the session, Dr. Vaneet Jishtu imparted valuable information to the students about the diverse Ethnobotanical plants found in Himachal Pradesh and their potential applications for mankind. His presentation covered the multifaceted uses of these plants, including their roles as dyes, food sources, timber, medicinal resources, and other Non-Timber Forest Products.




