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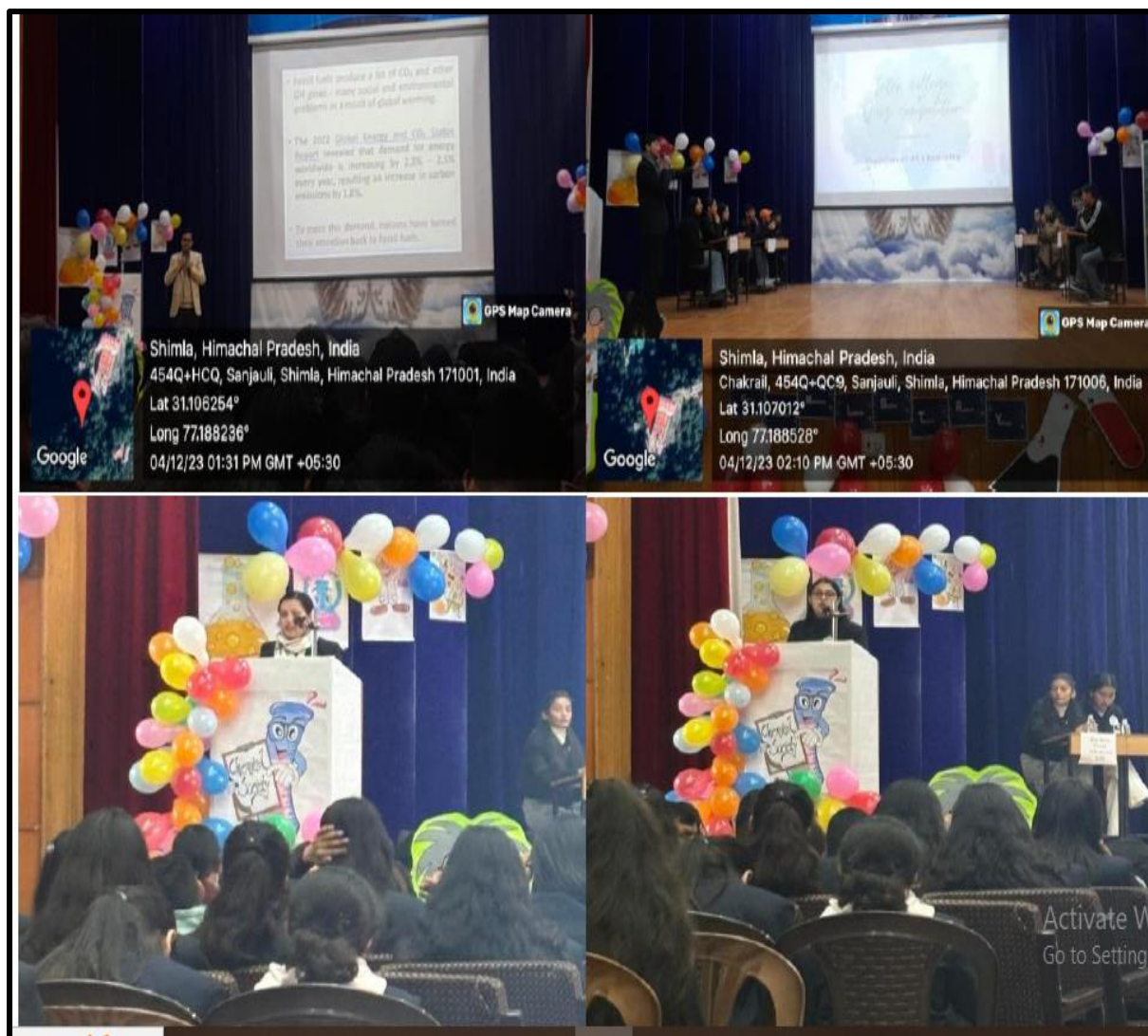
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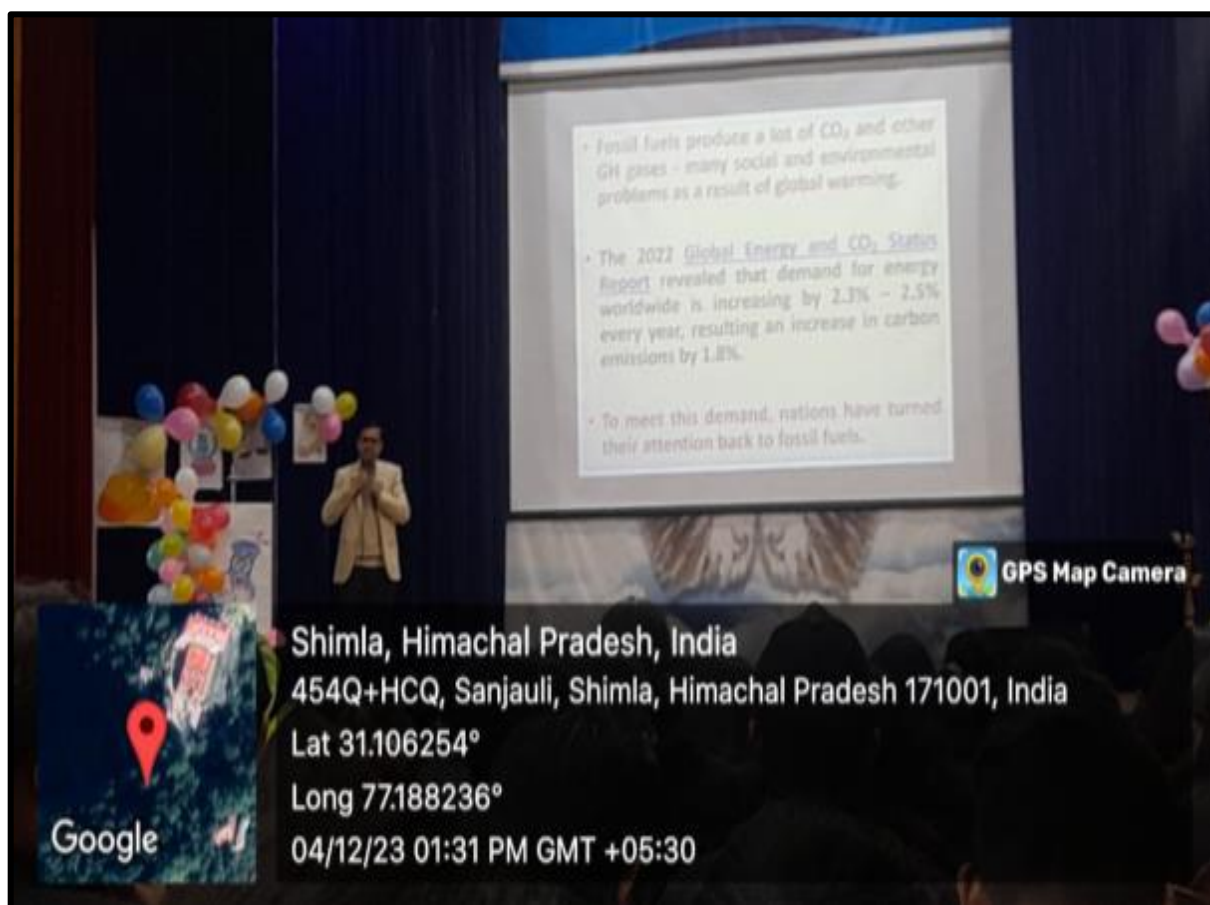

AWARENESS TALK ON “CYBER SECURITY AND AWARENESS”

On February 23, 2024, the Department of Computer Science of St. Bede's College organised an awareness talk on “**Cyber Security and Awareness**” in the college auditorium. Mr. Mohit Chawla, DIG, Cyber Crime (CID), HP, Shimla was the esteemed speaker. He was accompanied by his team- Mr. Yashwant Thakur, Inspector, Ms. Manu Sharma, Ms. Diksha Sharma and Mr. Kamlesh. The talk emphasised on the new risks and vulnerabilities, particularly in the realm of cybersecurity. 369 students of the college attended the awareness talk.

This event was held to sensitize students about the fundamental concepts of cybersecurity, its relevance, different types of cyber threats such as phishing, malware, ransomware and social engineering, best practices for staying safe online such as creating strong passwords, using two-factor authentication and avoiding suspicious links and the importance of data privacy, including how personal and sensitive information can be protected online. These objectives aimed to provide a comprehensive understanding of cybersecurity, equipping participants with the knowledge and skills they need to protect them and others in an increasingly digital world.

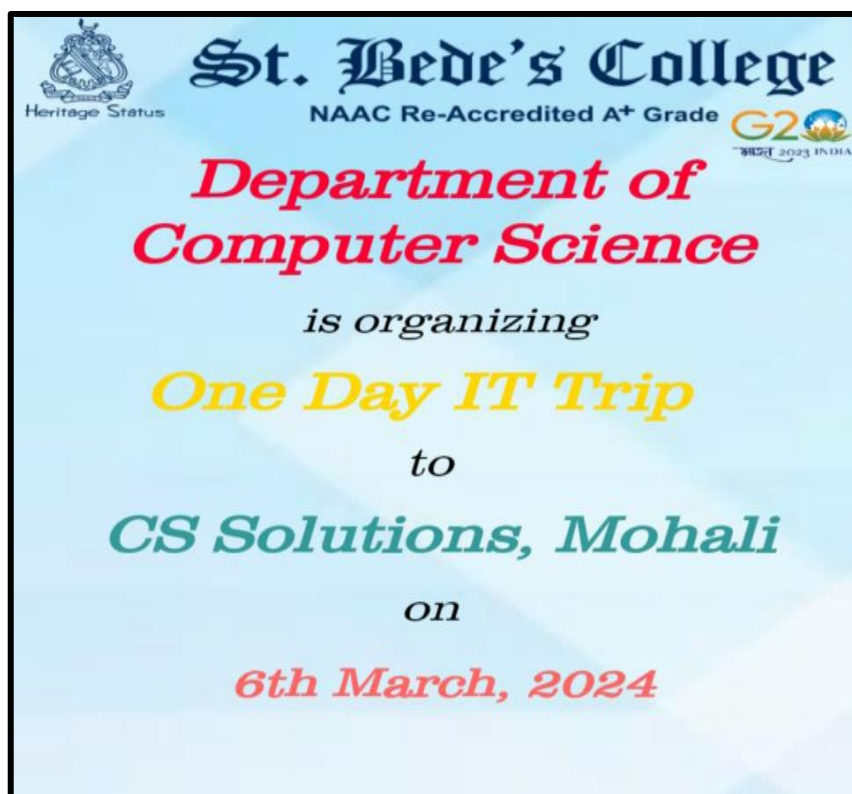

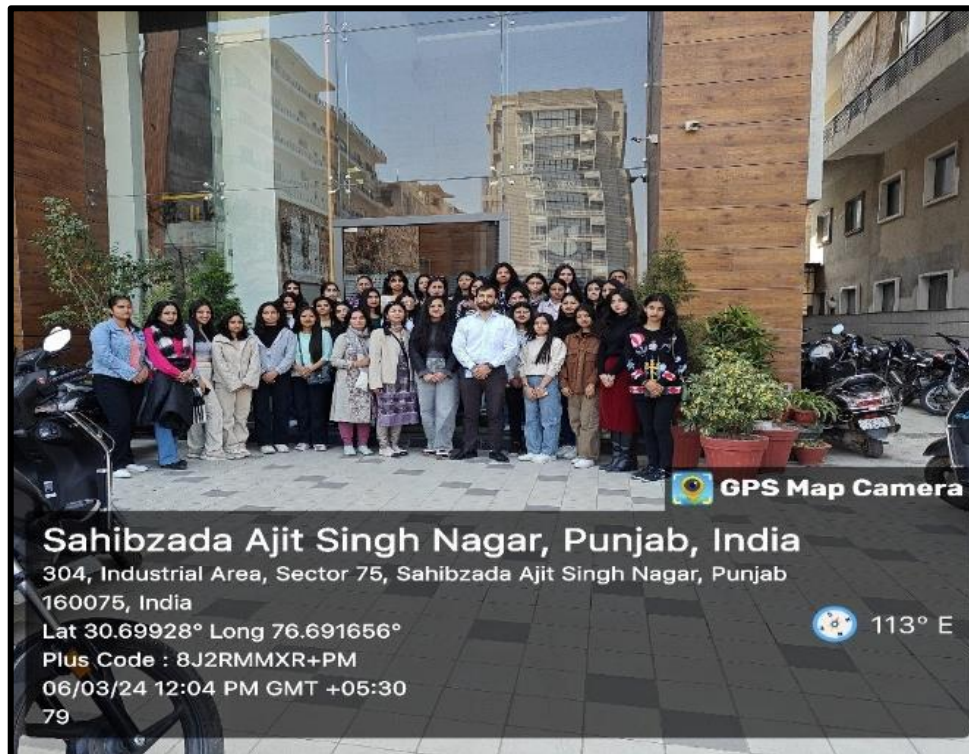
ONE DAY IT VISIT TO CS SOFT SOLUTIONS

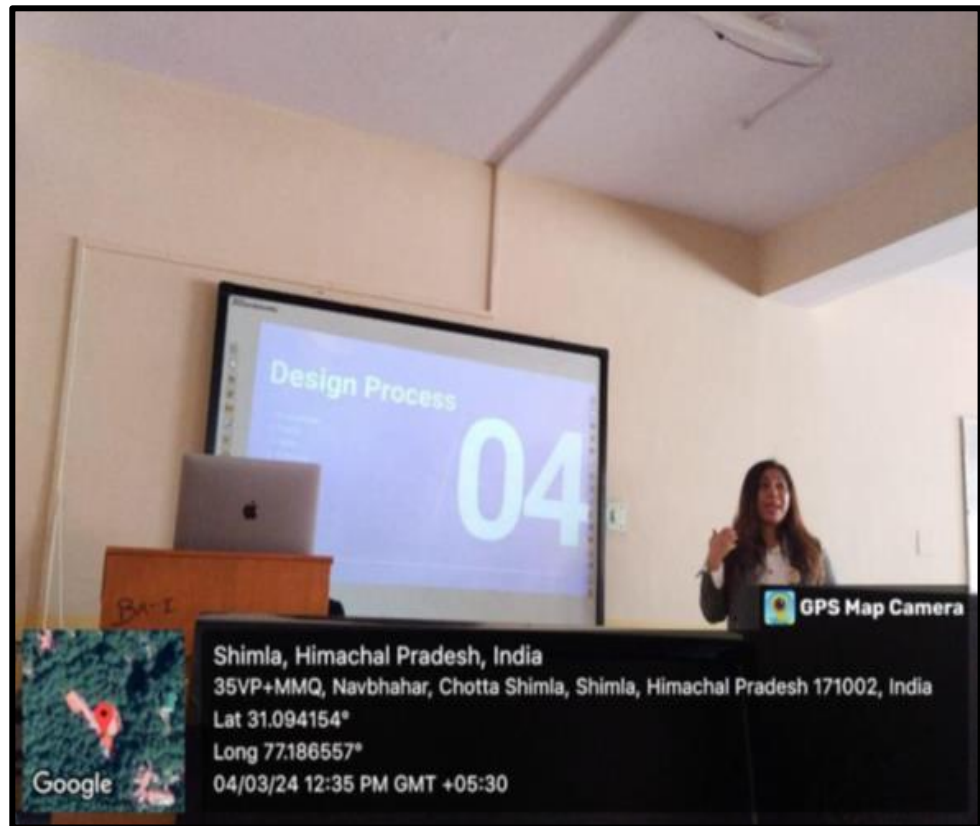


INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S DAY

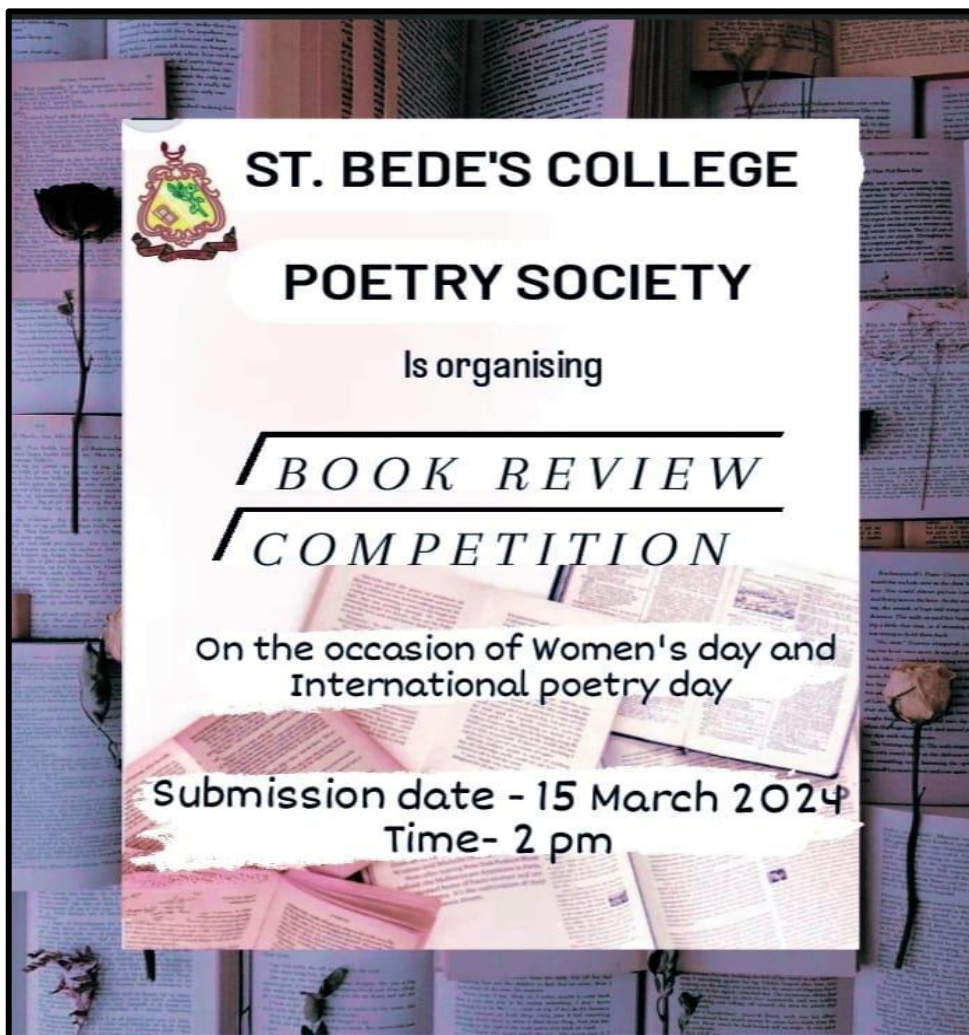

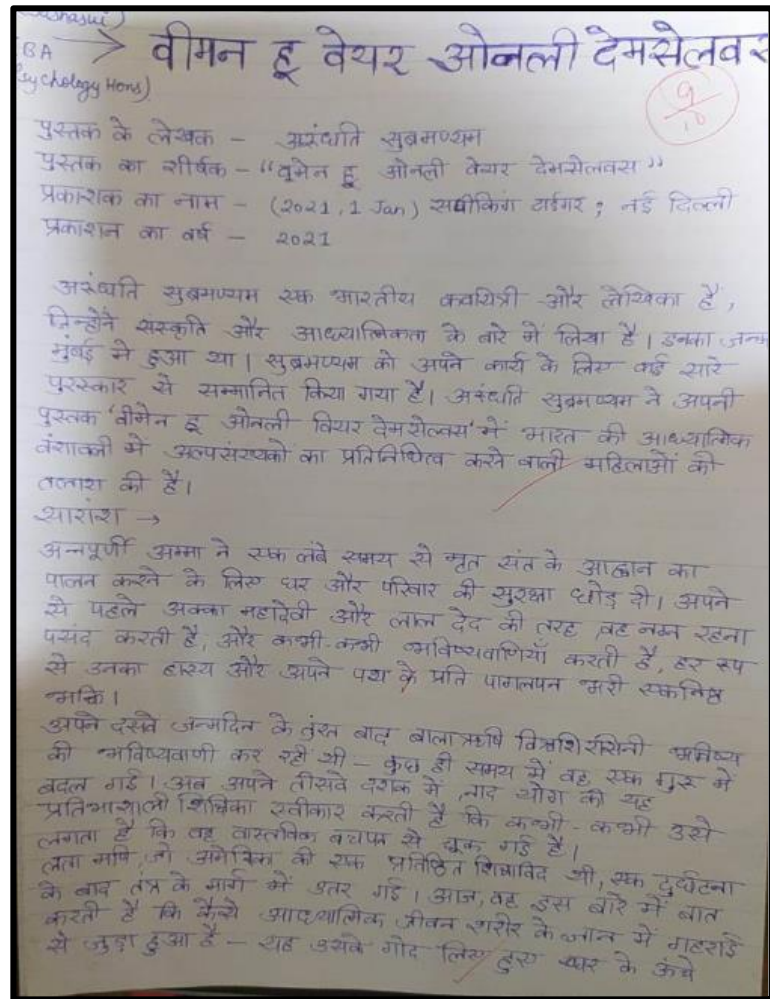
BOOK REVIEW WRITING COMPETITION

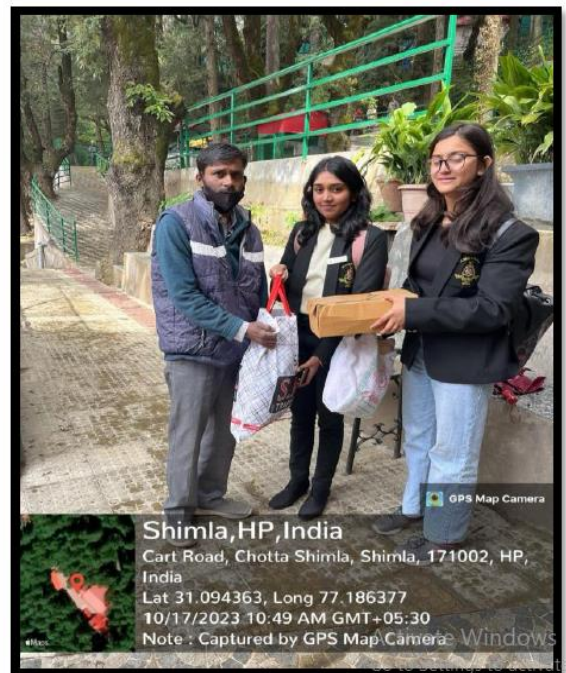
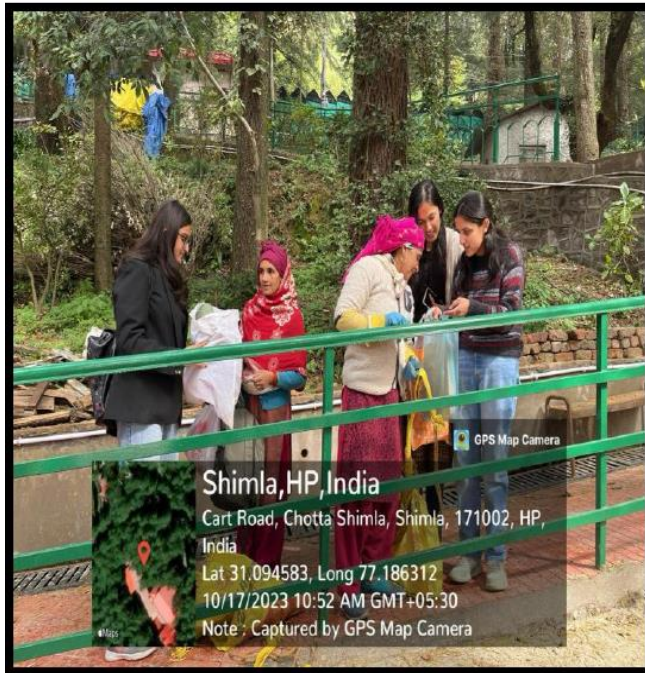


"GIFTS OF COMPASSION: ST. BEDE'S COLLEGE ECONOMICS DEPARTMENT DONATION DRIVE"

"SEEDS OF CHANGE: A CHARITABLE OUTREACH BY THE ECONOMICS DEPARTMENT"

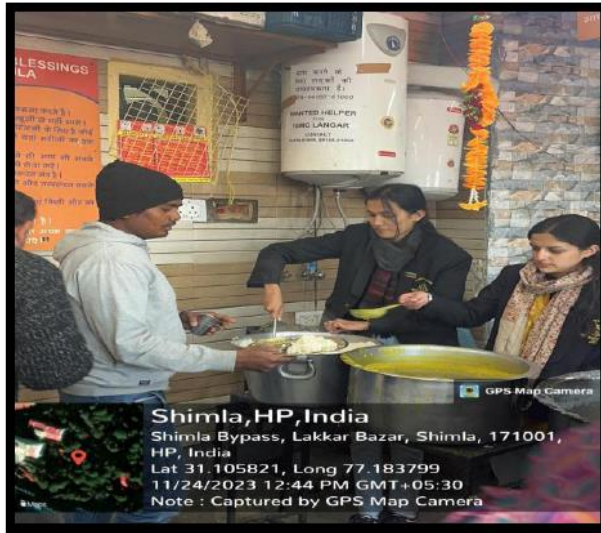

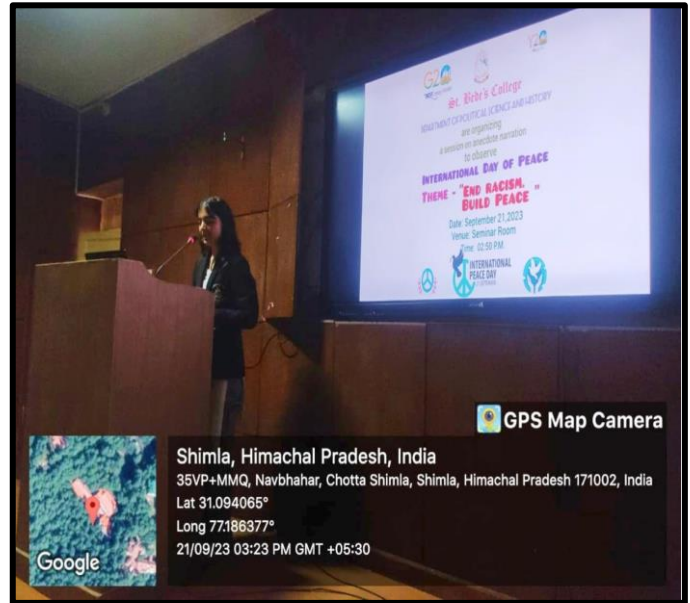
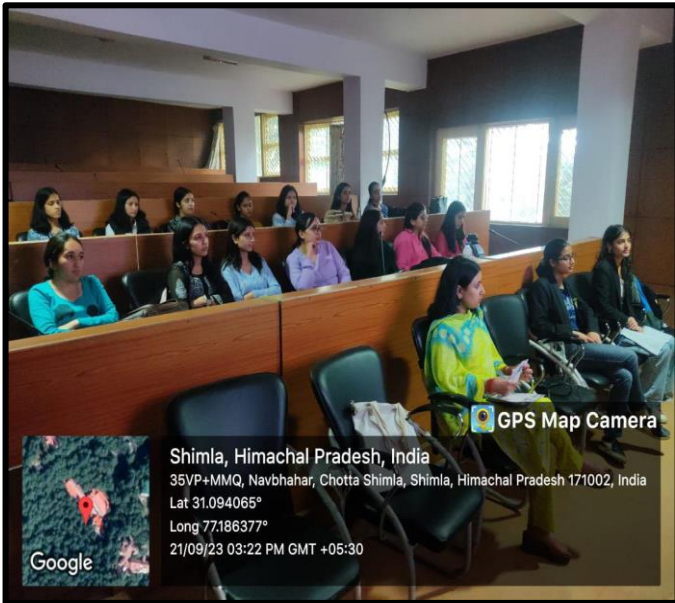

“EXPRESSION OF EMOTIONS” SURVEY

On the occasion of World Mental Health Day, the Department of Psychology of St. Bede's College organized a survey on October 6, 2023. The students and teachers of the college were the subjects for this study. Six basic emotions given by Psychologist, Paul Ekman, i.e. fear, anger, happiness, sadness, disgust and surprise, were used as the base for the survey. Six empty boxes were prepared and labelled as per the above given emotions and all the students were asked to pick up a blank slip of paper and place it in the box labelled with the current emotion felt by them. After analysing the results of the survey it was concluded that the most common emotion among the population was happiness, while surprise was the least expressed emotion. Thus, it was found that the majority of the college has a stable emotional expression. The results of the survey were also presented to the entire college, during the Mental Health Day celebrations on October 10, 2023. Through this survey, the Department of Psychology spread awareness about the importance of understanding one's own as well as others' present emotions and how they are related to an individual's mental health.

Participants gained a deeper understanding of the range of emotions they experience, including joy, anger, sadness, fear, and surprise. This increased awareness helped individuals recognize and name their emotions accurately.

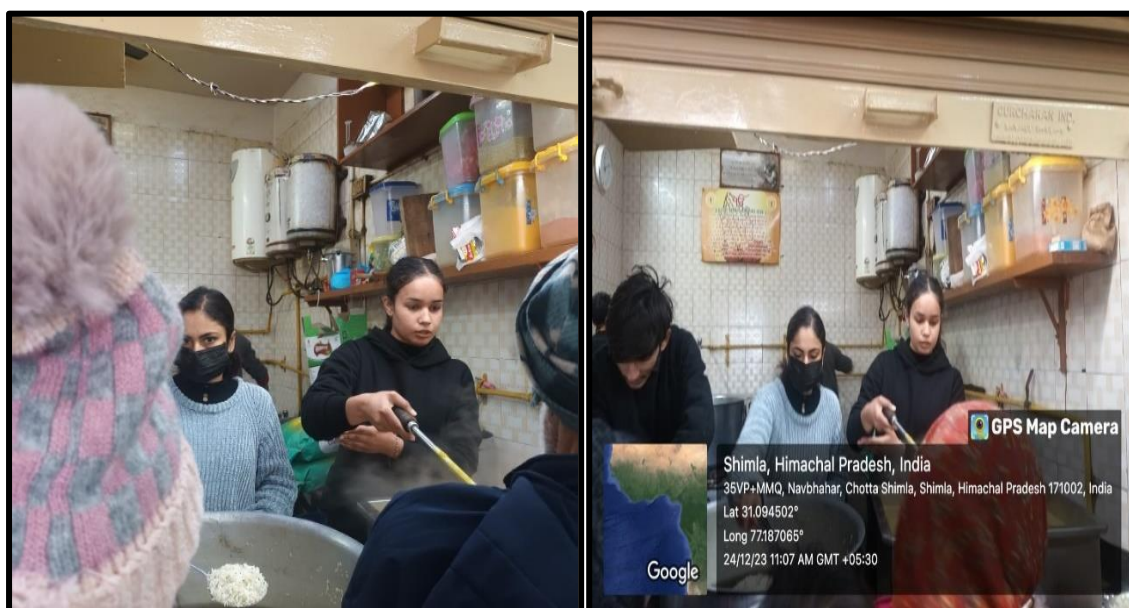

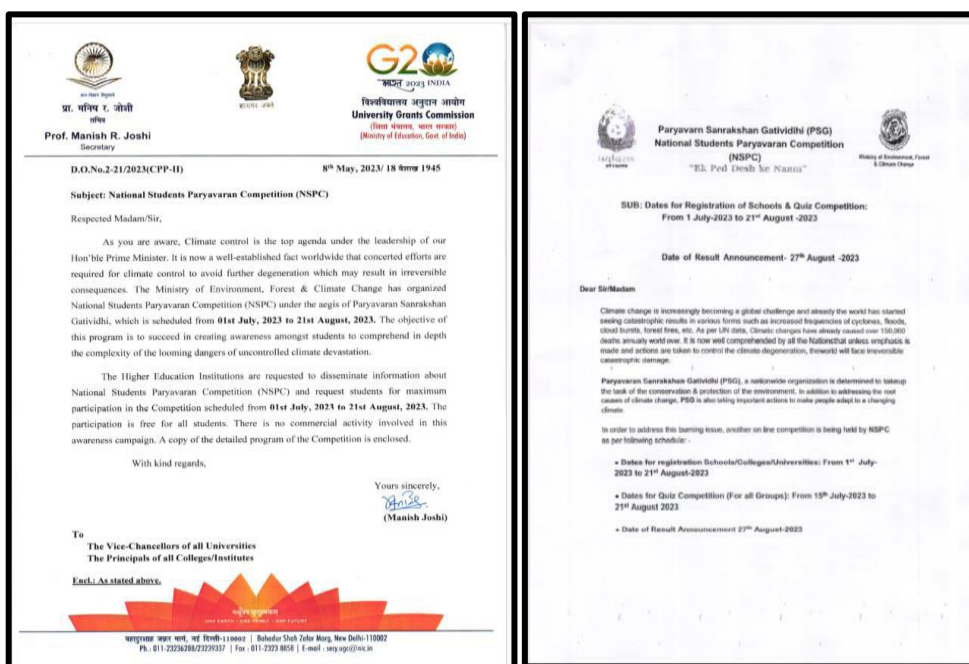

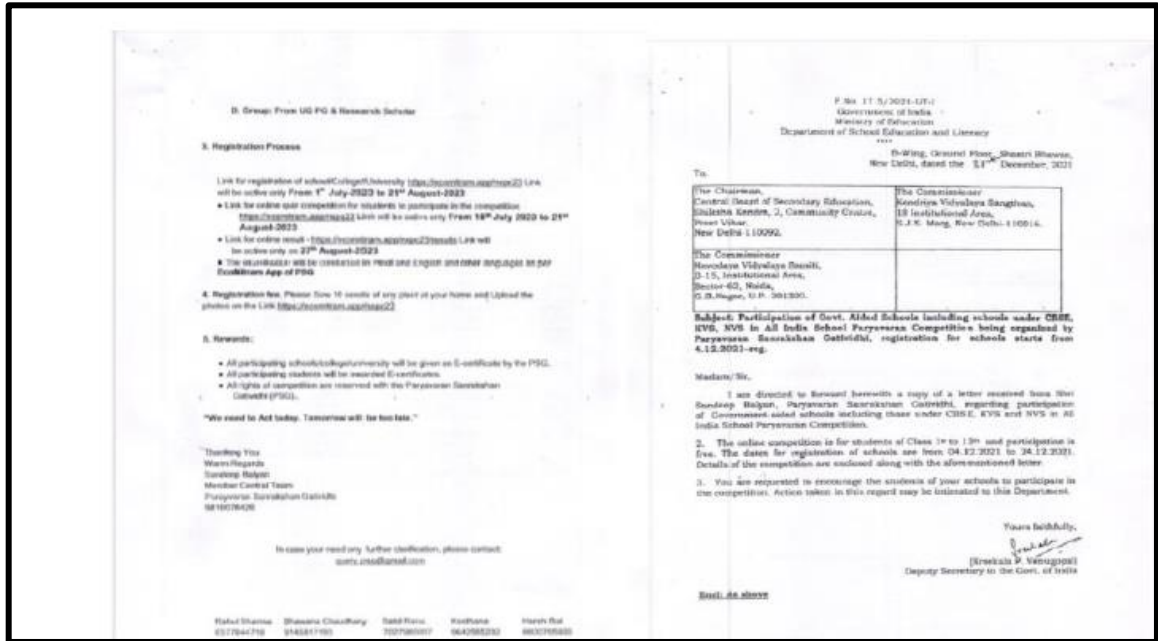
NATIONAL STUDENTS PARYAVARAN COMPETITION

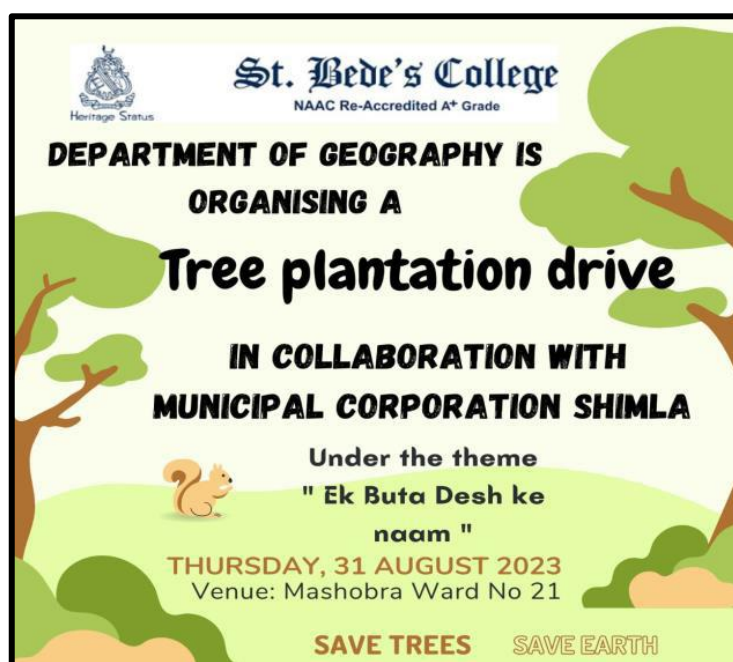
