




## INTERNATIONAL DAY OF YOGA


#### NCC FELICITATION CEREMONY








World River's Day celebration at Government Primary School in Sanjauli, Shimla, 25 September 2023


#### NSS DAY CELEBRATIONS












## INTERNATIONAL WORKSHOP ON THE CELEBRATION OF INTERNATIONAL OLYMPIC DAY




## INTERNATIONAL DAY OF PEACE






Classes for School Children, September 29, 2023




# INTER COLLEGE NATIONAL SCIENCE WEEK CELEBRATION ATGOVT. COLLEGE SANJAULI
