



ACTION TAKEN REPORT OF PARENTS' FEEDBACK ANALYSIS (2024–25)

Based on the Parents' Feedback report, there is high satisfaction across most areas. However, in the spirit of continuous improvement and excellence in institutional quality, even minor gaps should be addressed strategically. Below is an identified shortcoming and the corresponding action plan for the next academic session (2025–26).

Identified Shortcoming

While most parameters were rated as “Good” or “Excellent,” the feedback indicates specific areas requiring focused enhancement:

Sports and Recreational Facilities

Rated as “Good” by most parents, but it did not reach the “Excellent” level as frequently as other areas.

This suggests potential for infrastructure upgrades, wider access, or program enrichment.
