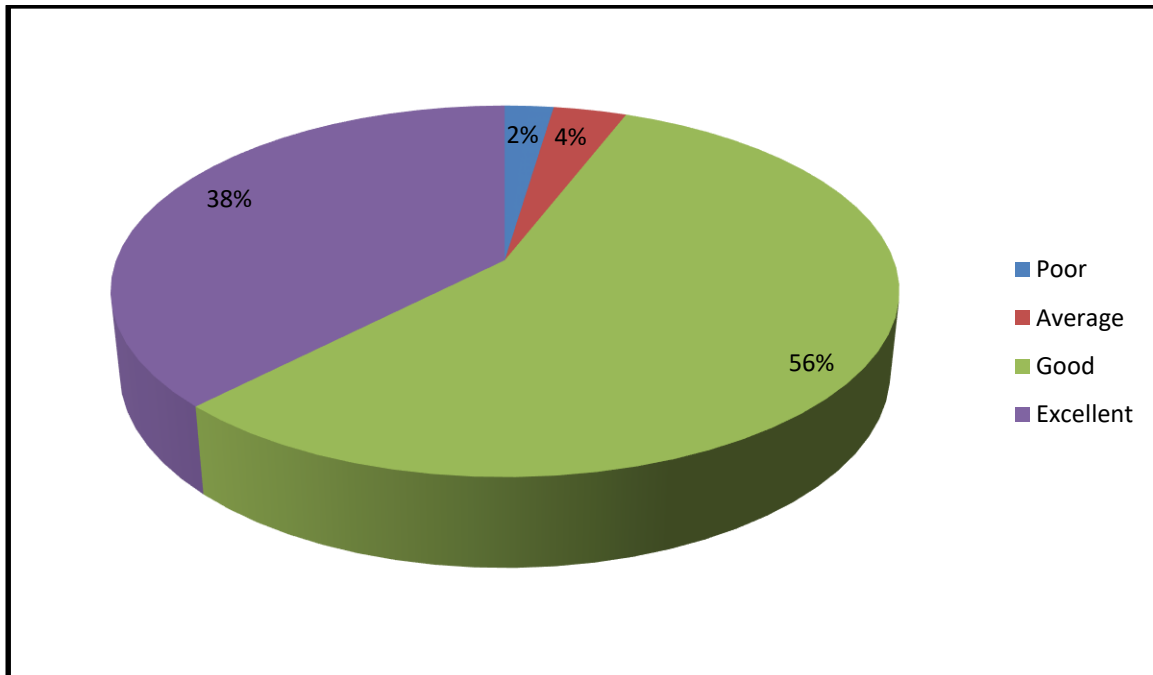


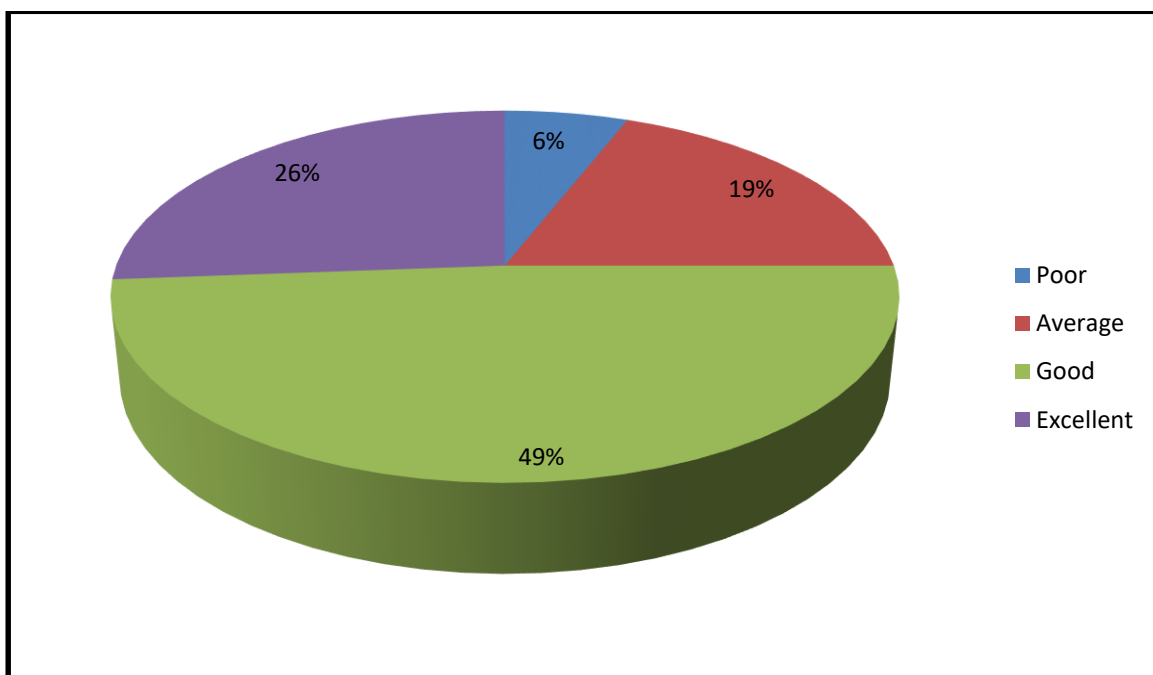

1. How would you rate the Library Resources and Digital Access facilities, of the college?

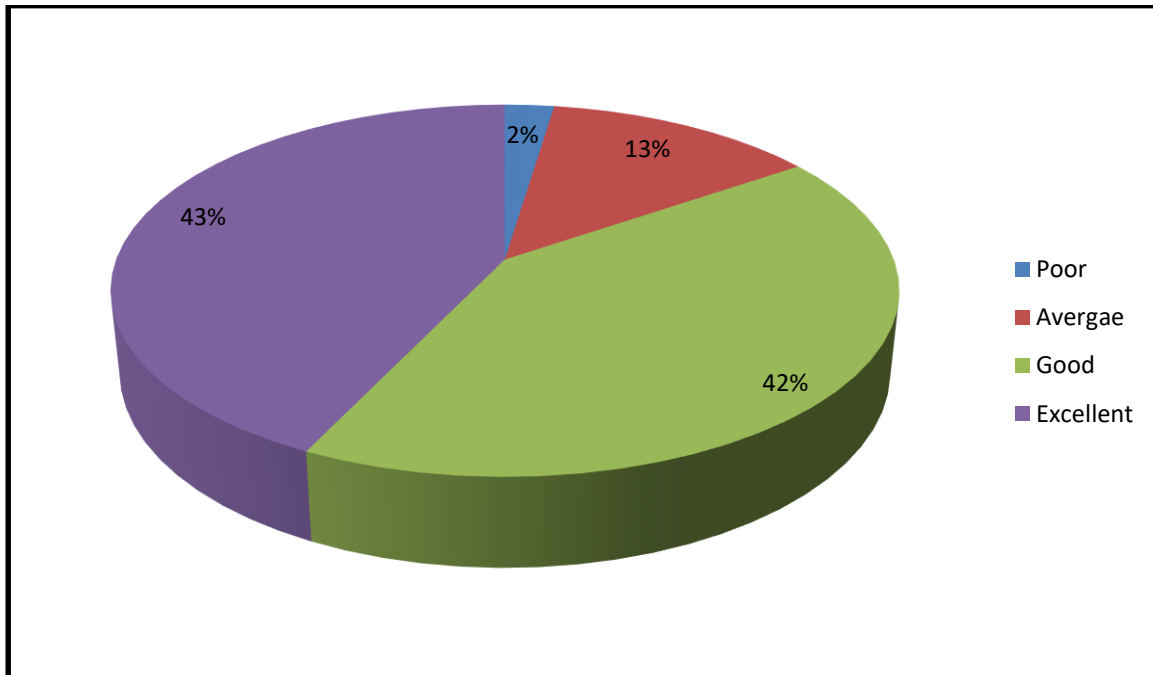


2. How would you rate the Sports and Recreational Facilities, of the college?

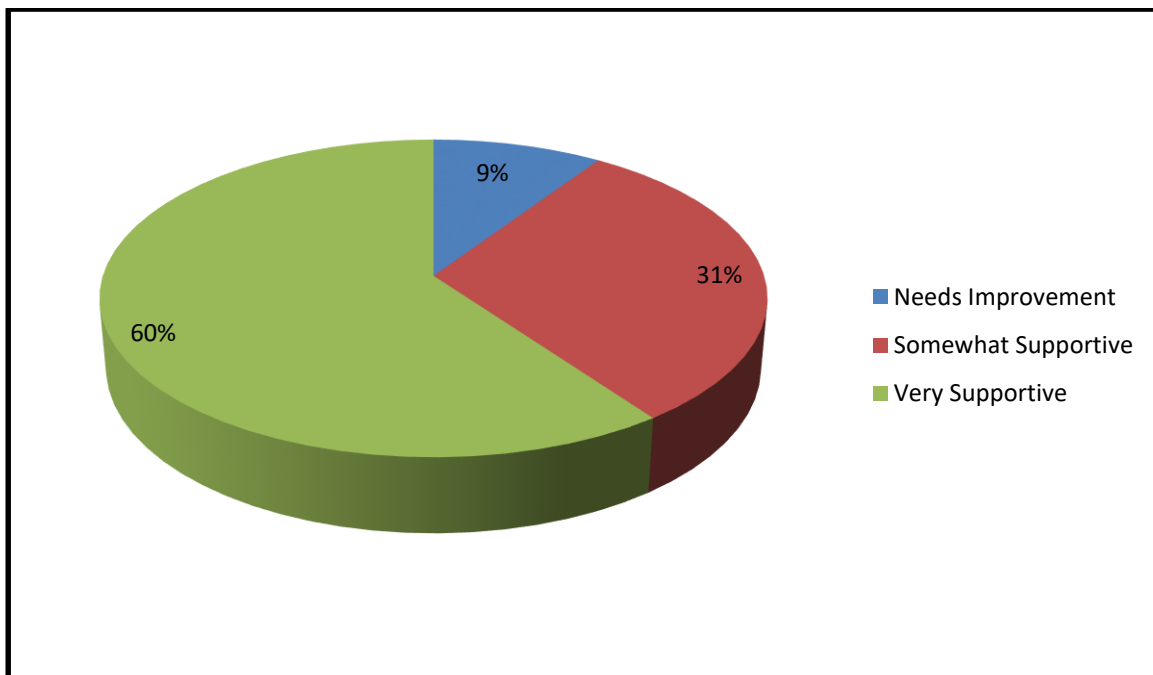




3. How would you rate the Hygiene and Cleanliness Facilities, of the college?

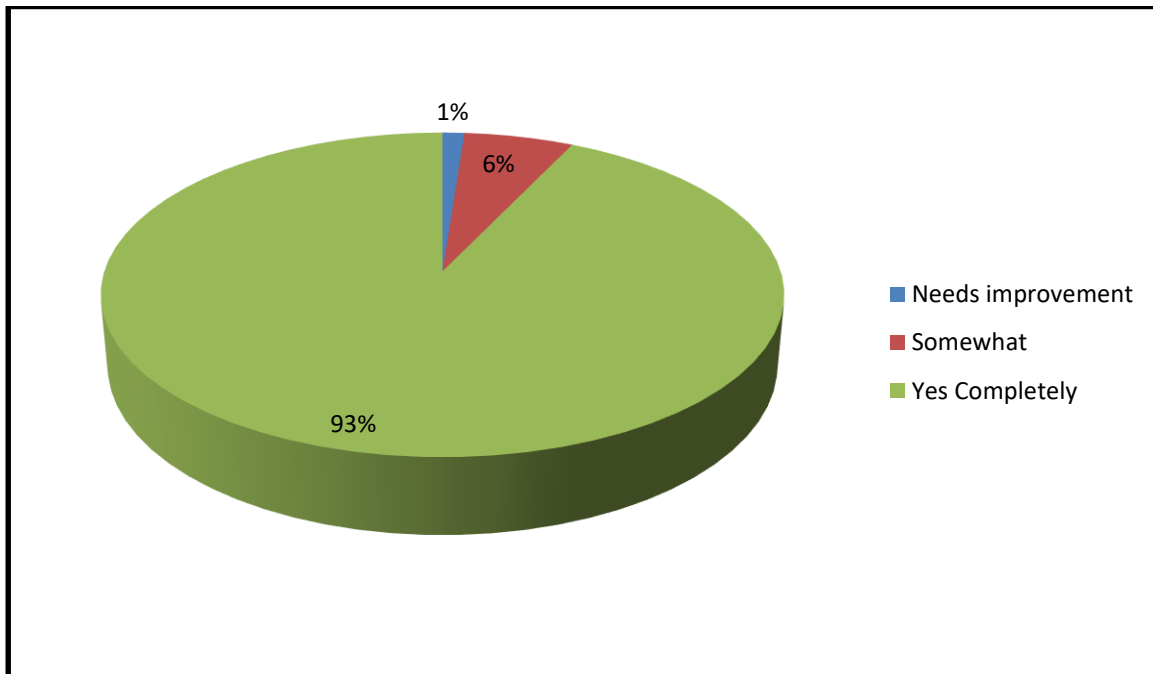


4. How accessible and helpful is the administrative staff in addressing student concerns?

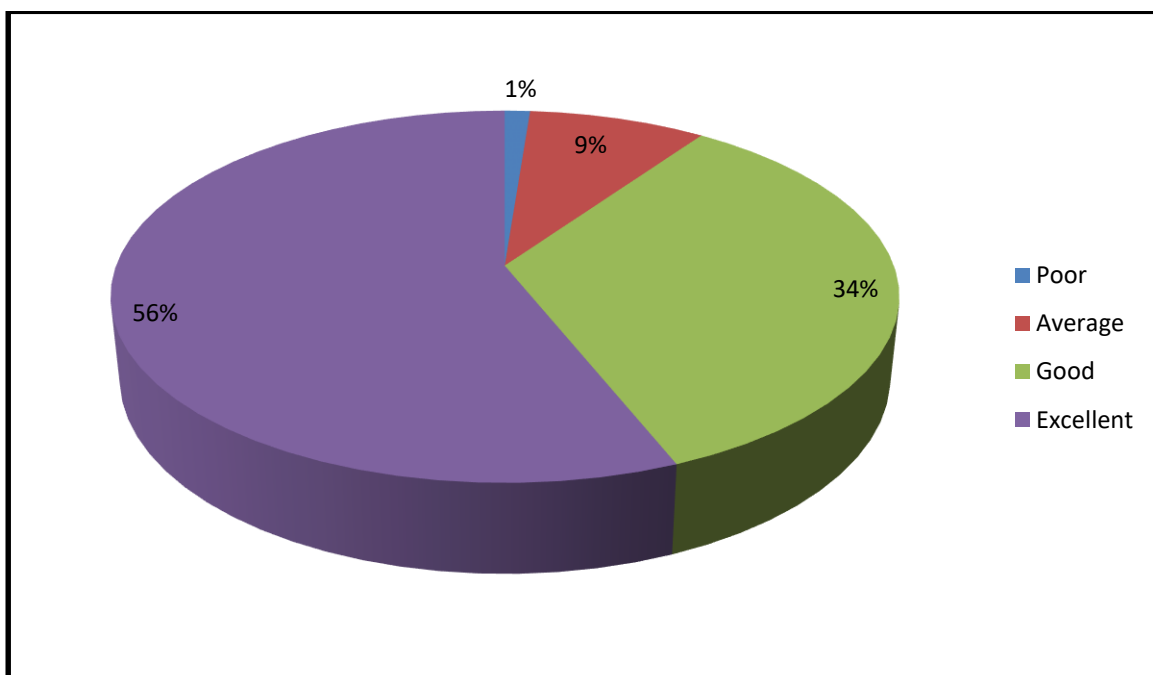




5. Does the college provide a safe and secure environment for students?

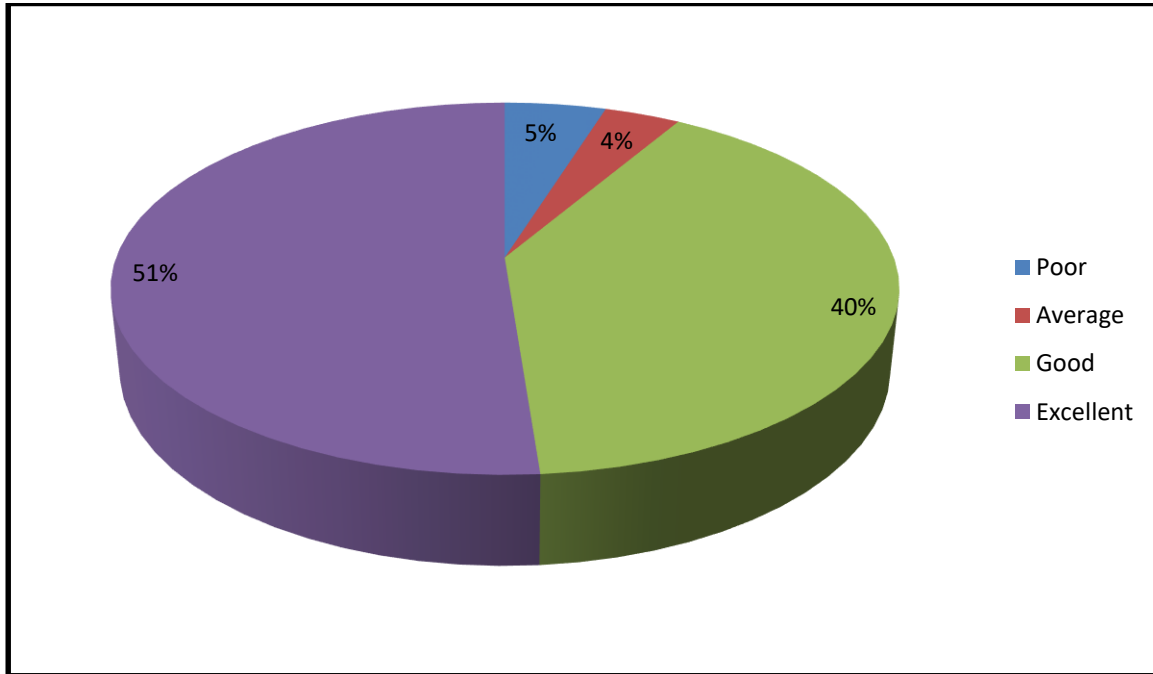


6. How would you rate the extracurricular activities and student development programs?

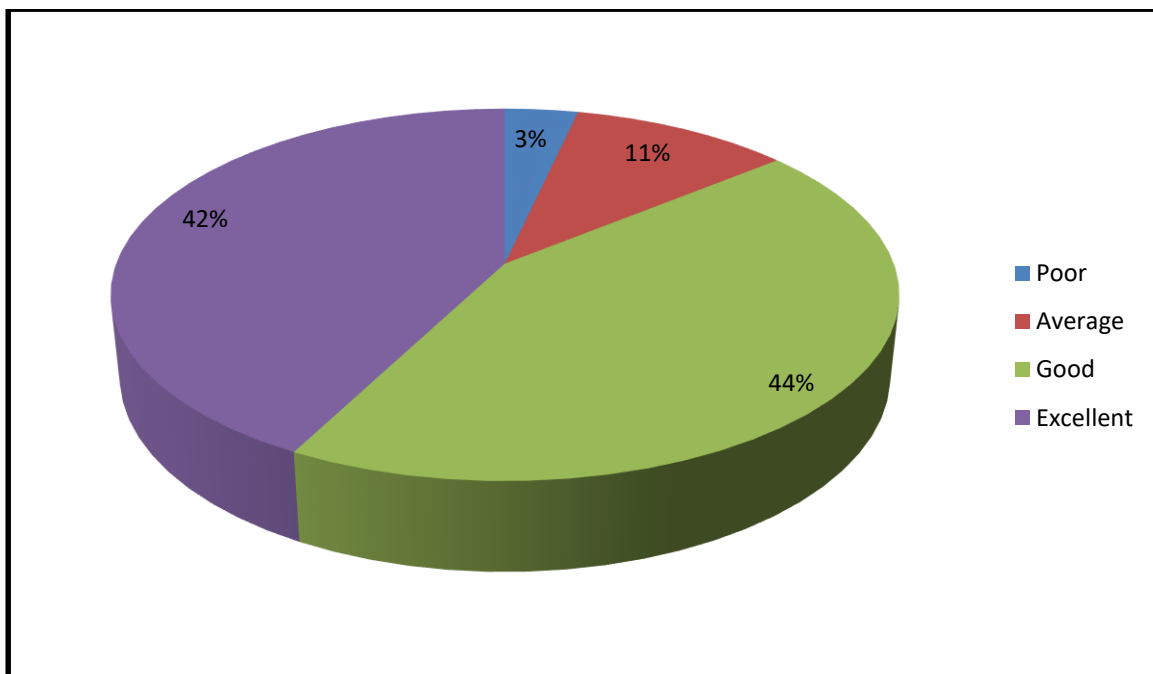




7. How would you rate the teaching quality of faculty members?

ANALYSIS OF PARENTS' FEEDBACK (2025-26)

To evaluate parents' satisfaction with the overall functioning of the institution, feedback was collected for the academic year 2025–26. The responses provided valuable insights into the quality of academic support, campus environment, student development, and institutional services, helping identify strengths and areas for continuous improvement.

1. Library Resources and Digital Access Facilities

A significant majority of parents expressed satisfaction with the library resources and digital learning facilities, with 94% rating them as Good or Excellent. This reflects the institution's effectiveness in providing students with adequate academic resources, access to digital learning platforms, and support for independent learning. The findings indicate that the library continues to serve as an important pillar in enhancing the teaching-learning process.

2. Sports and Recreational Facilities

While 75% of parents rated the sports and recreational facilities as Good or Excellent, this parameter received comparatively lower ratings than other areas. The feedback suggests that parents appreciate the opportunities available for physical fitness and recreation but also perceive scope for further strengthening infrastructure and recreational provisions to enrich students' overall campus experience.

3. Hygiene and Cleanliness Facilities

The college received highly positive feedback regarding campus hygiene and cleanliness, with 85% of respondents rating the facilities as Good or Excellent. This demonstrates the institution's commitment to maintaining a clean, healthy, and conducive learning environment, contributing positively to student well-being and campus sustainability.

4. Accessibility and Helpfulness of Administrative Staff

The administrative support system was viewed positively by parents, with 60% rating the staff as Very Supportive and an additional 31% considering them Somewhat Supportive. These findings reflect the responsiveness, accessibility, and cooperative approach of the administrative personnel in addressing student and parent concerns effectively.

5. Safety and Security of Students

Student safety emerged as one of the strongest areas of institutional performance. An overwhelming 93% of parents expressed complete confidence in the college's ability to provide a safe and secure environment. This highlights the effectiveness of the institution's safety measures and reinforces parental trust in the college's commitment to student welfare.



6. Extracurricular Activities and Student Development Programmes

The survey reveals strong parental appreciation for extracurricular activities and student development initiatives, with 90% rating them as Good or Excellent. Parents recognize the role of these programmes in fostering leadership, confidence, creativity, communication skills, and overall personality development among students.

7. Teaching Quality of Faculty Members

The teaching faculty received highly favourable feedback, with 91% of respondents rating teaching quality as Good or Excellent. Parents acknowledged the faculty's subject expertise, commitment to academic excellence, and student-centric approach, reflecting confidence in the quality of education imparted by the institution.

8. Constructive Feedback and Guidance by Teachers

A substantial majority of parents positively evaluated the guidance and mentoring provided by teachers, with 86% rating this aspect as Good or Excellent. The findings indicate that faculty members play a significant role in supporting students academically and personally through regular feedback, counselling, and mentorship.
